Last Night: The Revs returned to the field for the first time since 9/28/19 with a 5-2 win on Opening Night, 2021. York scored all 5 in the first inning, setting a club Opening Day record and tying the home opener record (2017). It marks the start of the 14th season of play in franchise history, and the 23rd season in Atlantic League history.

Been a Minute: Last night marked the Revs' first game in 609 days (20 months, 1 day). The Revs were forced to wait one day longer as Friday's scheduled opener was rained out, the first ever Revs Opening Day impacted by rain. The win was the first in 613 days (9/24/19 at SL) and the first at home in 615 days (9/22/19 vs. LAN).

Save the Dates: May 29 and Oct. 10 mark the latest opening and closing dates to a season in Revs history. The previous latest dates were May 4 for an opener (2007) and Sept. 23 for a closer (2012). The latest date the Revs have played any game had been Oct. 2 (2010/2011 championship clinchers).

Opening Act: The Revs are 9-5 all-time on Opening Night, having won 9 of 12 since 2009 and 4 of the last 5. York is 5-3 at home on Opening Night. The Revs open at home for the third straight year and for the 8th time overall. York is 7-7 all-time in home openers. York opens vs. HP for the first time ever as the Rockers enter their second season as a franchise.

I Made the Rooster: The Revs' Opening Night roster features 26 players (14 pitchers, 12 position players)... 8 have previously played for York (Dotel, Franco, Mesa, Nicely, Paredes, Steinfort, von Schamann, Welch)... 7 were on the 2019 club (excludes Paredes who returns for the first time since 2015 after MLB time in 2017-18 with LAD)... 3 have been on a Revs' Opening Day roster in the past (Dotel, Mesa, Paredes)... Mesa and Dotel made their second Opening Day starts (also 2019)... 13 have ALPB experience (also Fry, Fuller, A.Rodriguez, Sandford, Vitters)... 4 have been ALPB All-Stars (Dotel, Fuller, Mesa, Sandford)... 4 have MLB time (Mesa, Paredes, Sanabia, Vitters) while 10 have played at Triple-A or higher.

More Moves: INF Justin Twine's contract was purchased by Miami yesterday. It marks the third Revs player to have his contract purchased prior to the start of the season, all heading to Triple-A. Twine will make his AAA debut when he reports to Jacksonville. He had been projected to start at 2B, and after Orlando Calixte's contract was purchased by the Mets, had been projected to start at SS. The ALPB has now had the contracts of 30 players purchased since the start of the MLB season.

On the Horizon: The Revs need 2 wins for 900 all-time (6th team in league history to reach 900), 3 home wins for 500 at PeoplesBank Park, and 4 road wins for 400 all-time. Mark Mason, the longest tenured (8th season) and winningest active manager in the Atlantic League, needs 5 wins to become the 7th in league history to win #500. Mason, along with 3B/Hitting Coach Enohel Polanco on staff since 2010, have been part of 715 wins in York entering the 2021 season. Looking down the road a bit further, the 25th game this season will be the 1,800th in franchise history, and the 35th game will be Mason's 1,000th as manager. Including his time in the Frontier League, the 31st win will be Mason's 700th of his managerial career and the 52nd game will be his 1,400th.

New Year, New Look: The Atlantic League features realignment with "North" and "South" divisions for the first time since 2007. York remains in the same division as rivals Lancaster & Southern Maryland while Long Island joins York's division for the first time. The South division features three new clubs in Gastonia, Lexington, and West Virginia joining second-year franchise High Point. It marks the first time in league history that three new clubs have joined the league in one year; the only other time multiple teams joined in one season was 2000 when Long Island and Aberdeen entered. It marks the first time since 2007-08 (York/SMD) that there has been expansion in consecutive seasons. The 2021 season is also the Atlantic League's first as the first official "Partner League" of Major League Baseball.

The Schedule: The Revs will play a 120-game schedule in 2021. York will play 4 home and 4 road series against each North Division opponent, while playing 2 home and 2 road series vs each South Division opponent with the exception of High Point who is making their only visit to York on Opening Weekend. The unbalanced breakdown: LAN (13 home, 12 road), LI (12 home, 12 road), SMD (13 home, 12 road), GAS (6 home, 6 road), HP (4 home, 6 road), LEX (6 home, 6 road), WV (6 home, 6 road).

Rock On: The Rockers make their only visit of the season to PeoplesBank Park this weekend. The Revs will travel to High Point for a pair of 3-game series, June 29-July 1 and Sept. 28-30. The Rockers roster features former Revs Mitch Atkins, Luke Westphal, and Jared Mitchell.

- Enters 9th pro season, 2nd with York... had also signed with York in 2020.
- 2019 w/ York: 10-7, 3.51, 22GS... was his 3rd career season of 10+ wins (11 in 2013, 10 in 2014) and his first with one club... finished 2nd on team in wins and joined Mitch Atkins to form the league's only duo with 10+ victories... marked 6th time in Revs history and 3rd straight year boasting two 10-game winners... acquired in May via trade from Gary SouthShore for player to be named later.
- Had club record 42.0-inning walkless streak, Aug. 16-Sept. 16, 2019; went 6 full starts without a walk, smashing previous club records of 29.2 IP (Jason Kershner, 2009) and 27.2 IP by a starter (Victor Mateo, 2017)... set club season record issuing just 1.1 BB/9... has issued just 1.87 BB/9 over his career (1.2 in 2018, 1.1 in 2019).
- Originally drafted by LAD (15th rd, 2012) out of Texas Tech University... reached Double-A Chattanooga in each of first three pro seasons
- Traded to CLE 4/6/14 in exchange for fellow Texas Tech product Colt Hynes... reached AAA Columbus for 2 starts that season; also went 8-8 with a 4.20 ERA at Double-A Akron... returned to Akron for 5 starts in 2015... twice named his league's pitcher of the week at Double-A.
