J-ROD HOMERS IN 5- 2 LOSS: **Julio Rodriguez** slugged his ninth home run of the season, but West Virginia fell behind early and never recovered in a 5-2 loss to the Greensboro Grasshoppers Thursday evening at Appalachian Power Park. Greensboro got on the board from the get-go, as Jonah Davis led off the ballgame with a solo homer against **Nate Fisher** to give the Grasshoppers a 1-0 lead. They would double their edge later in the frame on a Fabricio Macias RBI single. Greensboro pushed their lead to 3-0 in the second before the Power finally answered, pushing one across in the home half thanks to three consecutive singles, capped by **Mike Salvatore**'s run-scoring knock. Colin Selby held down West Virginia besides that, striking out nine and scattering just four hits over five innings of work. Meanwhile, Fisher buckled down to retire the last 10 men he faced through five frames as well. **Reid Morgan** spun a scoreless sixth and seventh frame, but ran into trouble in the eighth after Jack Herman reached on a throwing error and Bae roped an RBI double to right. **Benjamin Onyshko** relieved Morgan, but could not contain his inherited runner, serving up a double to Macias that plated Bae to make it 5-1 Grasshoppers. Julio's homer inched the Power closer in the bottom of the stanza, but Yerry De Los Santos silenced West Virginia in the ninth, setting down the side in order to pick up his ninth save.

HONEY BUNCHES OF HITS: Since the start of his season-long 18-game hitting streak July 3 (ended July 23), **Bobby Honeyman** has been one of the most consistent hitters in the South Atlantic League. He has reached base safely in 24 of his 25 games in that stretch, tied for the third-most games played by any slugger in the league (Terrin Vavra, 27, Asheville). In this span, Honeyman is averaging .371 (39-for-105), the second-highest mark in the league, with two homers, 14 RBI, 18 runs scored and just 12 strikeouts. The Stony Brook product is now in the midst of his fourth hitting streak of six games or more this year, as well as West Virginia's 15th overall. Honeyman is boasting a .500 (12-for-24) clip during his streak with one RBI and four multi-hit games. He extended his team-leading multi-hit game total to 26 last night with a 2-for-3 evening and a run scored.

SHENTON STRONG: **Austin Shenton** tallied his second straight multi-hit night with the Power Thursday, going 2-for-4 with a double. The Mariners' fifth-round selection has now reached base safely in 13 of his 15 games with West Virginia, as well as 33 of his first 36 professional games. The newly-minted 29th-best prospect in the Mariners system per *MLB.com* is boasting a .309 average with five homers and 28 RBI between Everett and the Power.

CLUTCH GENE: Julio blasted his third homer in four games Thursday night, connecting for his fifth home run at Appalachian Power Park and ninth overall this season. Five of his nine dingers have come in the seventh inning or later. The Mariners' second-best prospect per *MLB.com* possesses the second-most homers among active Power players, trailing only **Jake Anchia** and **Onil Pena**, who each have 12 long balls.

HOMER HAPPY: Julio's bomb in the eighth inning marked West Virginia's 91st home run of the season, third-most in the South Atlantic League (Greensboro, 108 and Hickory, 123). The Power has hit 50 of their 91 homers at Appalachian Power Park, the third-highest home long ball total in the league (Hickory, 76). The 2019 West Virginia squad has the sixth-most homers a Power team has posted in team history. West Virginia's highest home run total since becoming the Power is a whopping 128 dingers in 2007.

RIDICULOUS REID: Morgan had a career evening last night in his fifth appearance with West Virginia. The former Gamecock dialed up a career-high 2.2 innings and struck out a career-best four batters while only ceding one hit. The right-hander has now only allowed an earned run in three of his first 13 Minor League outings (twice with the Power). Overall, Morgan is 1-1 with a 2.45 ERA and 16 strikeouts compared to four walks over his 18.1 innings of work.

A BLURRED FOCUS: West Virginia finished the month of July with a 13-15 record, their second sub-.500 monthly mark this season (May, 10-20). The Power's monthly numbers for July present a fuzzy picture of the team, as West Virginia posted the league's fourth-worst average at .238, but scored the second-most runs per game (5.1). Additionally, the Power's pitching staff compiled the third-highest ERA at 4.39, but fanned the most batters in the month with 275. West Virginia's bullpen also locked down nine saves, tied for the second-best mark in July.

POWER POINTS: **Charlie McConnell** has not committed an error in 57 consecutive games (May 15 at Charleston)... Pena has just four hits in his last 39 at-bats (.103 average) with 22 strikeouts... West Virginia went 2-for-8 with runners in scoring position, stranding eight men on base... Salvatore committed just his second professional error in 26 games.
