DRILLERS CLAIM HISTORIC GAME 2 WIN – Since professional baseball began in Tulsa in 1905, the Drillers/Oilers had hit seven home runs in a game only four times. On Wednesday night in downtown Amarillo, the Drillers shattered the long-standing record, crushing nine home runs in an 18-9 win in Game 2 of the TLCS. Jeter Downs hit three of the nine which tied the Tulsa all-time record and set the all-time Tulsa playoff record. The 18 runs and 18 hits were both season-highs for the Drillers. The victory evened the best-of-five series at 1-1.

Not to be overshadowed by the excessive offense in Game 2, was the fantastic work of the Drillers bullpen. After the Drillers regained the lead in the top of the second, Luis Vasquez did not allow a run over the next two innings. Michael Boyle followed with three strong innings, allowing only a solo home run. Shea Spitzbarth followed by striking out three and Nolan Long finished off the win by striking out three in the bottom of the ninth.

Tulsa Starting Pitcher #40 RHP Markus Solbach (1-0, 1.69 ERA)

- The 22-year-old is a native of Germany and signed a minor league contract with the Los Angeles Dodgers in January of this year
- Pitched in the Twins (2011-13) and Diamondbacks (2014-16) systems. Has also pitched professionally in Australia and Germany
- Began the year with the Dodgers Rookie Lg. teams (0-2, 4.57 ERA in 6 G) before joining Tulsa and making his 1st appearance on July 29
- Won his final two starts of the regular season while not allowing an earned run to win TL Pitcher of the Week Award
- Picked up the win in Game 3 of the TL North Division Series after allowing one run on five hits while striking out four

TL CHAMPIONSHIPS – A second consecutive Texas League Championship for the Drillers would be the 10th TL title for the city of Tulsa. The Drillers franchise has won four TL crowns, in 1982, 1988, 1998 and 2018, while the old Tulsa Oilers franchise win five titles, in 1936, 1949, 1960, 1962 and 1963. A title for the Sod Poodles would be the second for the city of Amarillo. The old Amarillo Gold Sox franchise defeated Shreveport for the 1976 Texas League Championship, also playing as a San Diego Padres affiliate.

TIED AT ONE – Since 2005, when the Texas League began using five games for all playoff series, the Drillers have on six occasions been in situations where the series was tied 1-1 after two games. The Drillers went on to win four of those series, including this year's division series with Arkansas. Three of the four series wins occurred with the Drillers hosting games 3-5.

HODGETOWN LAUNCHING PAD – The Drillers have hit a total of 38 home runs in 16 games against Amarillo this season. Of those 38, 33 have come in HODGETOWN in downtown Amarillo. Tulsa hit 20 homers in 7 regular season games in Amarillo, and 13 in the 2 postseason games.

DOWNS WITH AMARILLO – Jeter Downs has hit 8 home runs in 19 games with the Drillers (including postseason) and they have all come against Amarillo. In 8 games against the Sod Poodles, Downs is 15-34 (.441) with 8 homers and 11 RBI.

SEVEN AND COUNTING? – Connor Wong and Donovan Casey are the only two Tulsa players to hit safely in all seven playoff games. Wong is 12-27 (.444) with 2 HR and 9 RBI, while Casey is 12-28 (.429) with 3 HR and 6 RBI so far in the postseason. Dating back to the regular season, Wong is riding a 10-game hitting streak (19-38, 4 HR, 18 RBI) while Casey has hit in 8 straight games (14-37, 4 HR, 9 RBI).

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE – Pitchers Michael Boyle, Nolan Long, Shea Spitzbarth and infielder Eric Peterson are the only four remaining Drillers on the active roster who were members of last season's championship winning team.

NEXT LEVEL – The Drillers have 13 players who were on Rancho Cucamonga's active roster last season when the Quakes won the California League Championship (Casey, Crawford, Curry, Estevez, Moseley, Rincon, Salow, Santana, Sheffield, Thomas, Uceta, Walker, Wong).

LOTS OF WINNING – The Drillers 78 regular season wins were tied for the most in franchise history (78 wins in 1998).
