- TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves and Tennessee Smokies open the 2019 regular season with five-game series at Smokies Stadium. Atlanta Braves No. 3 overall prospect RHP lan Anderson faces off against Chicago Cubs' No. 17 prospect RHP Thomas Hatch.
- MThis marks the second-straight season that the M-Braves and Smokies have faced each other to open the year. The M-Braves won last year's series opener 3-0 at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves are 1-2 against the Smokies in series openers.
- MiThis is the first road series to begin a season since 2008. The M-Braves dropped the Opening Day contest against the Huntsville Stars at Joe Davis Stadium, 8-2, on 4/3/08. This is just the fourth time in 15 seasons that Mississippi has opened away from Trustmark Park
- MAII-time, the M-Brayes are 5-9 in season openers dating back to 2005 and 0-3 on the road.
- LAST TIME OUT: The M-Braves closed the second-half of the 2018 season playing its best baseball, narrowly missing out on the playoffs by one game with a 38-30 record. The club finished the year 34-24 from July 1 to the end of the season following a 17-12 July and 16-11 August. Those 34 wins were third-most in the Southern League over that period of time. Montgomery had 38 wins and Biloxi had
- OPENING DAY ROSTER: The M-Braves Opening Day roster has 25 active players and three on the injured list to begin the season
- MOverall the initial roster has 14 players returning to Mississippi from 2018, 13 that were drafted by the Braves, four minor league free agents, four non-drafted free agents, three acquired via trade and one selected in the Rule 5 draft.
- MeThe roster contains three with MLB experience (Jason Hursh, Ben Rowen, Andy Wilkins), seven countries represented (United States, Dominican Republic, Venezuela, Aruba, Columbia, México and the U.S. territory of Puerto Rico)
- M Nine top 30 prospects according to MLB.com (Ian Anderson (3), Cristian Pache (4), Drew Waters (8), Joey Wentz (12), Kyle Muller (13), Patrick Weigel (19), Tucker Davidson (22), C.J Alexander (23) and Ray-Patrick Didder (30)...three top 100 prospects in baseball according to MLB.com (Anderson (32), Pache (36) and Waters (84)).
- M:The roster contains five players that are 21-years-old, or younger to begin the season. OF **Drew Waters** is the youngest (20, 12/30/98), followed by OF **Cristian Pache** (20, 11/19/98), RHP **Ian Anderson** (20, 5/2/98), LHP **Joey Wentz** (21, 10/6/97) and LHP **Kyle Muller** (21, 10/7/97).
- **HAMMER TIME:** Jackson, MS native Chris Maloney "Hammer" returns for his second season as M-Braves manager. Maloney, 57, the seventh skipper in franchise history attended Jackson's St. Joseph High School and went on to play collegiate baseball at Mississippi State University, graduating in 1983.
- MoDuring his first season in 2018, Maloney guided the M-Braves to a 67-71 record, boasting a 38-30 mark in the second half of the season, missing out on the playoffs by just one game in the standings. Maloney enters 2019 ranked eighth among active minor league managers with 1,417 wins (1,417-1,321 overall record, .518 winning percentage) and has guided his clubs to winning records in 11 of 21 seasons and league championships in 1993 (Savannah Cardinals, South Atlantic League) and 2009 (Memphis Redbirds, Pacific Coast League).
- 11 M-BRAVES ALUMS MADE MLB DEBUTS IN 2018: RHP Bryse Wilson became the 140th M-Brayes alum and 11th in 2018 to move on and make their MLB debut on August 21. Wilson joined RHP Touki Toussaint (August 13) RHP Chad Sobotka (August 11), RHP Wes Parsons (August 9), LHP Adam McCreery (August 9), LHP Kolby Allard (July 31) C Willians Astudillo (June 30, Twins) OF Dustin Peterson (May 28), RHP Mike Soroka (May 1), OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (April 25) and LHP Jesse Biddle (April 21) to have debuted this season. In total, 139 players, have gone on to make their MLB debuts after playing in Pearl since 2005. OF **Michael Reed** had previously made his MLB debut for Milwaukee, but made his debut with Atlanta after opening the 2018 season in Mississippi on July 23.

TODAY'S GAME

 Atlanta's No. 3 prospect and the No. 32 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com gets the start in the series opener at Tennessee to begin the 2019 season. This is Anderson's first Opening Day assignment.

LAST TIME OUT

Anderson worked 3.0 innings in two games during big league spring training, giving
up three hits, two runs, one earned with one walk and two strikeouts. Anderson is
coming off of a dominant 2018 season that saw him rise to the ranks of one of the
top pitching prospects in all of baseball, tossing 100 innings in High-A with a 2.52
ERA and 28.5% strikeout rate before earning a late season promotion to Mississippi.
In 19 ½ innings in Mississippi he lowered his ERA to 2.33 and bumped his strikeout
rate to 30%.

ACQUIRED

• Braves' first-round pick (3rd overall) in 2016.

*Atlanta's highest draft selection since 1991, when it took Mike Kelly second overall. No. 3 overall picks have gone on to accomplish great things in baseball, from Hall of Famers Robin Yount and Paul Molitor to All-Star arms like Trevor Bauer and Steve Avery. The Braves took Avery in that spot back in 1988.

2018 SEASON

- Split the season between High-A Florida and Double-A Mississippi and combined to go 4-7 with a 2.49 ERA (33 ER/119.1 IP) across 24 starts.
- Ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta's starting farmhands (min. 75.0 IP) in hits per 9.0 innings (1st, 6.6), strikeouts per 9.0 innings (2nd, 10.7), strikeouts (3rd, 142), ERA (4th, 2.49), and innings (9th, 119.1).
- Named by the organization as Florida's Pitcher of the Year after going 2-6 with a 2.52 ERA in 20 starts for the Fire Frogs, and earned Florida's Pitcher of the Month honors for July after going 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (2 ER/22.0 IP) over four starts.
- Was twice named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, first from 7/2-8 (11.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 18 SO) and again from 7/30-8/5 (7.2 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 5 SO).

2017 SEASON

- Played his first full professional season with Single-A Rome, and went 4-5 with a 3.14 ERA (29 ER/83.0 IP) and 101 strikeouts over 20 starts.
- Led all Atlanta farmhands (min. 75.0 IP) by averaging 11.0 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched...Pitched to a 6.15 ERA over six starts in May, but logged a 1.75 ERA (11 ER/56.2 IP) over 14 starts in the other five months of the season, including an 0.83 ERA (2 ER/21.2 IP) in seven starts after the All-Star break.
- Rated as the 12th-best prospect by Baseball America in the 2016 draft class, and also earned the distinction by the publication as having the "Best Delivery" by a prep pitcher. ESPN ranked him as the seventh-best player and the third-best prep pitcher in the 2016 class.

Split his first pro season between the GCL Braves and rookie-level Danville, combining to go 1-2 with a 2.04 ERA (9 ER/39.2 IP) over 10 starts...Allowed five earned runs over 4.0 innings on 8/22 vs. Bluefield, but pitched to a 0.99 ERA (4 ER/35.2 IP) in his other nine appearances.

- A 2016 preseason High School All-America selection by Baseball America and Rawlings-Perfect Game, he was limited during his senior year at Shenendehowa High School in Clifton Park, NY due to pneumonia.
- Went 6-1 with two saves and a 0.66 ERA (5 ER/53.1 IP) over 11 appearances during
 his junior season at...Allowed just 21 hits while striking out 91 in 53.1 innings
 pitched en route to being tabbed as the 2015 Pitcher of the Year by both Baseball
 America and Louisville Slugger.
- In the fall of 2015, helped Team USA (U18) win its third consecutive Gold Medal at the World Cup Championship in Osaka, Japan.
