TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series on Saturday night in Jacksonville, FL. The M-Braves and Jumbo Shrimp meet 21 times in 2019 with the final meeting coming in Jacksonville, Aug. 7-11.

M: All-time the M-Braves are 98-94 against Jacksonville and 50-48 in games played at The Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. The M-Braves are 8-3 against Jacksonville this season, including a five-game sweep of the Shrimp, May 1-5, at Trustmark Park and 19-12 the past two seasons.

DAVIDSON DEALING: LHP Tucker Davidson leads the league and is 2nd in Double-A baseball with a 2.04 ERA through 16 starts. He also ranks among the league leaders in strikeouts (94, 6th), opponents' batting average (.221, 7-7th), and WHIP (1.22, T-8th).

LAST TIME OUT: The M-Braves and Jumbo Shrimp were rained out on Friday night, but on Thursday, rehabbing Atlanta Braves RHP Kevin Gausman allowed just one unearned run on three hits over 6.0 innings with no walks and three strikeouts in the 3-1, 10-inning win at Jacksonville. The series-opening victory improved the M-Braves to 7-3 in extra-inning games. CF Drew Waters was 3-for-5, recording his 34th multi-hit game of the season. RF Greyson Jenista was 1-for-5 with a run and stole home in the 10th inning.

LEADING DOUBLE-A BASEBALL IN HITS: OF Drew Waters became the first player in the Southern League and Double-A baseball to the 100-hit mark in 2019 on June 30 and is currently 2nd in MiLB with 118 hits this season. Waters is on pace for 184 hits this season which would blow past the M-Braves record of 148 set by Ernesto Mejia in 2011 and Dustin Peterson in 2016. He has four four-hit games this season and a league-best 32 multi-hit games.

M: Waters leads Double-A Baseball in hits (118) (next closest with 99), 180 total bases, 29 doubles 43 extra-base hits and is 2nd with a .338 batting average. Waters leads the league in seven categories, AVG (.338, by .32 points), hits (118), doubles (29), triples (9), XBH (43), TB (180) and runs (55). He ranks 3rd in OPS (.896), 5th in OBP (.380) and 7th in slugging (.516). Waters is batting .459 (17-for-37) in July with three doubles, a triple, four RBI and three walks.

ANDERSON AND PACHE AT THE FUTURES GAME: RHP Ian Anderson and OF Cristian Pache both started the SiriusXM Futures Game on Sunday in Cleveland. Anderson tossed a 1-2-3 bottom of the first inning for the NL squad, striking out MLB's top prospect, Wander Franco to start the game. Pache led off and played centerfield, finishing 0-for-4 at the plate.

ANOTHER BIG LEAGUER ON THE ROSTER: RHP Kevin Gausman made a rehab start for the M-Braves on July 11 allowing one unearned run on three hits over 6.0 innings with no walks and three strikeouts. OF Ender Inciarte was with the M-Braves Monday and Tuesday, going 2-for-5 with a run and stolen base. LHP Dallas Keuchel started for the M-Braves on June 15, tossing 7.0 innings of three-run baseball, striking out four and walking one in a no-decision against Mobile.

LEADING DOUBLE-A BASEBALL IN STRIKEOUTS: Atlanta Braves No. 3 overall prospect RHP Ian Anderson leads the Southern League, Double-A baseball and is T-7th in all of MiLB with 113 strikeouts over 17 starts. He is averaging 11.6 SO/9 IP. The New York native and 3rd overall pick in 2016 ranks 2nd in the league in opponents' AVG (.200), is T-6th in wins (6), 8th in ERA (2.91) and 9th in WHIP (1.22).

THE ATLANTA BRAVES TOP PROSPECT: OF Cristian Pache ranks among the Southern League in 11 different offensive categories: AVG (.294, 7th), hits (92, 3rd), doubles (25, 2nd), triples (6, T-3rd), XBH (42, 2nd), TB (162, 2nd), slugging (.518, 5th), OPS (.873, 6th), HR (11, T-9th), runs (44, T-8th) and RBI (48, 7th) Pache finished June batting .295 with eight doubles, a triple, seven home runs, 24 RBI, 10 walks and .370 OBP.

CASTEL CLEANING UP: 28-year-old 1B Ryan Casteel has found a home in the cleanup spot and leads the club and ranks 4th in the league with 14 home runs His three-homer game on July 3 was the first in M-Braves history. He ranks among the league leaders in slugging (.520, 4th), OPS (.877, 4th), AVG (.288, 8th), HR (15, 4th), RBI (49, T-5th), XBH (28, T-9th) and TB (130, T-8th).

RECORD SETTING 14-13 LOSS ON JULY 3: The M-Braves tied a Southern League record with 13 extra-base hits on July 3 at Pensacola. The 20 combined extra-base hits and 75 total bases set a new league record. Ryan Casteel became the first M-Brave to record three home runs in one game while the team's five total home runs, combined nine home runs, 39 total bases, 13 extra-base hits, 20 combined extra-base hits and 36 combined hits all set new M-Braves records.

HISTORY MADE ON JUNE 28: Ian Anderson and Jeremy Walker's combined nine-inning no-hitter on Friday, June 28 vs. Jackson was the third no-hitter in team history. The last was a combined no-hitter from Julio Teheran and Tyrelle Harris on Aug. 2, 2010 vs. Mobile. The first, and only individual no-hitter came from the late Tommy Hanson on June 25, 2008, vs. Birmingham. Anderson's 14 strikeouts over 7.0 innings in the game matched Hanson's single-game team record set in the same game.

MULLER TIME: LHP Kyle Muller became was the second Southern League pitcher and third in Double-A baseball to reach 100 strikeouts on July 4. Muller ranks 3rd in the league with 105 strikeouts on the season, is 4th and leads the club in IP (95.0) and 3rd in opponents' batting average (.211).

11 ATL TOP 30 PROSPECTS ON THE ACTIVE ROSTER: In the June 23 MLB Pipeline ranking update, OF Cristian Pache is the No. 1 prospect for the Braves and #14 prospect in their top 100. There are 12 total top 30 prospects on the M-Braves active roster: RHP Ian Anderson (3, #26 overall), OF Drew Waters (4, #44 overall), C William Contreras (6), LHP Joey Wentz (9), LHP Kyle Muller (10), OF Greyson Jenista (12), LHP Tucker Davidson (18), INF C.J. Alexander (IL - 19) RHP Jasseel De La Cruz (22), and INF Ray-Patrick Didier (26).

TODAY'S GAME

- Atlanta's No. 18 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and Southern League All-Star, Tucker Davidson makes his 17th start of 2019 and third start against the Jumbo Shrimp.
- vs. Jacksonville: In two starts against Jacksonville, Davidson is 0-1 with a 2.67 ERA with 13 strikeouts and five walks. He suffered the loss on May 23 in Jacksonville's 5-2 victory.
- Among the SL Leaders: Davidson leads the league and is 3rd in AA baseball with a 2.00 ERA, is T-7th in opponents' batting average at .221, 6th in strikeouts (94 and 7th in WHIP (1.22).

LAST TIME OUT

- Despite nine strikeouts and 7.0 innings of two-run baseball, Davidson suffered the loss in the 3-0 shutout loss to Biloxi. He walked none and scattered seven hits over the 93 pitch performance.

- Earned the win in big league spring training on 2/28 at STL pitching a scoreless 7th inning in Atlanta's 4-0 shutout of the Cardinals in Jupiter.
- Enters the 2019 season as the No. 22 prospect in the organization according to MLB.com and No. 21 prospect according to Baseball America.
- Matched a career high with eight strikeouts on May 3 vs. Jacksonville.
- Recorded the best start of his career on Saturday, May 18 at Birmingham, logging a career-high 8.0 innings of shutout baseball with five hits, two walks and four strikeouts.
- Didn't allow an earned run over 16.2 innings from June 13-30.

2018 SEASON

- Spent the full season with High-A Florida, and went 7-10 with a 4.18 ERA (55 ER/118.1 IP) in 24 starts.
- Went 6-6 with a 2.99 ERA over his final 17 starts, after opening the season 1-4 with an 8.04 ERA in his first seven turns.
- Named by the Braves as Florida's Pitcher of the Month for May after a perfect 3-0 record and a 3.22 ERA over four starts.

- Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning of the same game before the bid was broken up by a Tyler Stephenson single.
