**TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves are on a three-game winning streak and begin their sixth road series of the season today with game one of a five-game set at Biloxi (MIL). The M-Braves are coming off a 3-2 series win over Jacksonville at Trustmark Park. After the series, the M-Braves will go home for a ten-game homestand vs. Montgomery (5) and Pensacola (5).

**LAST TIME OUT:** The M-Braves matched a season-high with 10 runs scored during the 10-2 thrashing of Jacksonville in the rubber match of the five-game series on Sunday afternoon at Trustmark Park. The Braves scored six of the ten runs in the fifth inning setting a season-high for runs in a single inning. Five different M-Braves collected multiple hits in the game. LF **Travis Demeritte** led the offense by going 2-for-4 with a home run, double and three RBI. 3B **Daniel Lockhart**, 2B **Alay Lago**, SS **Luis Valenzuela** and CF **Connor Lien** also had two hits each. RF **Tyler Neslony** had three RBI. RHP **Elian Leyva** made the spot start and tossed 4.0 shutout innings on two hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. LHP **Adam McCreery** tossed two 0.0 shutout innings of relief and earned the win.

**M-BRAVES AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** RHP **Touki Toussaint** ranks 2nd in the Southern League in strikeouts (66), is 2nd among SL starters with an 11.80 SO/9IP ratio and 3rd in opponents batting average (.214). OF **Michael Reed** is 2nd in walks drawn (30), 3rd in the SL with a .446 OBP, T-4th in runs scored (33) and is 7th in batting average (.314). RHP **Jacob Webb** is T-3rd in appearances (18) and 3rd in saves (7). RHP **Josh Graham** is T-2nd in appearances with 20.

**M-BRAVES VS. SHUCKERS:** The Magnolia State rivalry enters its fourth season in 2018 with the Shuckers holding a 36-34 all-time series advantage. The M-Braves went 14-9 against Biloxi in 2017 with two games being canceled by rain. The in-state rivals are scheduled to play 24 games this season during the regular season with 15 games being played at MGM Park and nine at Trustmark Park. The first meeting took place on May 6, 2015 with Biloxi serving as the home team at Trustmark Park. The Shuckers won the first ever meeting 8-7, but the M-Braves won the "road" series 3-2.

**MARLETTE RIDING 11-GAME HITTING STREAK:** C/INF **Tyler Marlette** hit a walk-off home run on Friday and has a 11-game hitting streak, batting .457 (17-for-39) with 9 runs, 4 doubles, 3 home runs and 8 RBI and .500 OBP. The streak is currently the longest active streak in the Southern League and one shy of Michael Reed's season high for an M-Braves player.

**THE ON-BASE MACHINE:** OF **Michael Reed** has reached base safely in 12 straight games and 38 of 44 games played this season. Reed has already logged a 12-game hitting streak (4/6-4/23) and 18-game on-base streak (4/5-4/27) this season.

**THREE-GAME WINNING STREAK BY THE NUMBERS:** The M-Braves are currently on their second three-game winning streak of the season and have scored 26 runs over those contests. The club is batting .330 (37-for-112) with 8 doubles, a triple, 3 home runs and 10 walks.

**TOUKI TOUSSAINT CLIMBING MILB STRIKEOUT LEADERBOARD:** RHP **Touki Toussaint** ranks 3rd in Double-A baseball with 66 strikeouts on the season in 50.1 innings. The 21-year-old has a 2.45 ERA over his last 6 starts (4 quality) with 40 strikeouts and 10 walks over 33.0 innings.

**THIS DAY IN BRAVES HISTORY:** On May 29, 1976, in a pitching matchup that features the Niekro brothers facing one another, Astro Joe beat the Braves and Phil, 4-1. Adding insult to injury, Joe hits his first and only home run in his 22-year career off his older sibling.

**FROM PEARL TO ATLANTA:** RHP **Mike Soroka** became the third M-Brave alum to make his MLB debut in 2018 on May 1 in New York. The Calgary, Canada native joins OF **Ronald Acuña Jr.** (April 25) and LHP **Jesse Biddle** (April 21) to have debuted this season. In total, 132 players have gone on to make their MLB debuts after playing in Pearl since 2005.

**HAMMER TIME:** Jackson, MS native **Chris Maloney** enters his first season as the M-Braves manager and is the seventh skipper in franchise history.

- Maloney attended Jackson's St. Joseph High School and graduated from Mississippi State University in 1983.
- Maloney spent the previous six years on the St. Louis Cardinals Major League coaching staff as the team's third base coach (2016-July 2017) and first base coach (2012-15).
- Prior to joining the Cardinals, Maloney was the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) manager for five seasons (2007-11), leading the team to winning records in four of his five seasons.
- Maloney ranks ninth among active minor league managers in wins with 1,350 entering the 2018 season.

### TODAY'S GAME

• MLB.com's No. 30 overall prospect, Atlanta Braves No. 2 prospect and M-Braves Opening Day starter Kyle Wright makes his team-leading 11th start of the 2018 season in tonight's series opener at Jacksonville. Wright is 2-1 with a 2.20 ERA (7 ER/28.2 IP) in 5 road starts with 23 strikeouts and 9 walks and .192 average against as opposed to 0-4 with a 9.00 (17 ER/17.0 IP) in 5 home starts with 21 strikeouts and 13 walks and a .366 average against.

### LAST TIME OUT

• Wright's 10th start of 2018 was cut short due to rain after 2.0 innings last Wednesday vs. Jacksonville, allowing 2 runs on 3 hits with 2 walks and 2 strikeouts on 46 pitches. The game was suspended until Thursday and picked up in the top of the 3rd inning. Jacksonville went on to win the series opener 8-1. Both runs Wright allowed was in the 2nd inning.

### ACQUIRED

• Selected by the Atlanta Braves in the first round (5th overall) of the 2017 draft out of Vanderbilt.

### 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

- Ranked as the No. 30 overall prospect in MLB.com's Top 100 ranking. In the Atlanta Braves organization ranked No. 4 according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus and No. 2 by MLB.com.
- Wright earned the first win of his Mississippi Braves and professional career on April 21 against the Mobile BayBears. Wright tossed a season and career-high 6.0 innings of shutout baseball. The right-hander allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out four.
- Wright turned in the best performance of his pro career in the series opener at Jackson on May 12. He tossed a career-high 7.0 shutout innings on 5 hits while striking out 5 and walking just 1. After the game: "It's a good feeling knowing I can still pitch that late into a game," Wright said. "I guess it's just like any other time I've ever gone back to pitch. I'm just happy to give my team a chance to win and hopefully save the bullpen arms a bit."

### AMATEUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Pitched three years for Vanderbilt University, and in 61 career games, 35 starts, went 19-11 with a 2.78 ERA (79 ER/255.1 IP) and 290 strikeouts.
- Named first team All-SEC by the league's coaches and a Second Team All-America by Baseball America after going 5-6 with a 3.40 ERA (39 ER/103.1 IP) over 16 starts for the Commodores in 2017.
- Became the fifth Vanderbilt pitcher drafted in the first round over the last four years, while at least one Vanderbilt pitcher has been selected in the draft's first two rounds for seven consecutive seasons...Is the second Vanderbilt pitcher drafted by the Braves in the first round, joining LHP Mike Minor, who the club chose seventh overall in 2009.

### 2017 NOTES

- Made his professional debut with rookie-level GCL Braves and Single-A Florida, going a combined 0-1 with a 2.65 ERA in nine games, all starts...Fanned 18 while walking six.
- Started his organizational debut on 7/17 vs. GCL Yankees West, going 1.2 innings and allowing one run while striking out three...Pitched twice more for the GCL club, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings each time.
- Made his Single-A debut on 8/1 at Dunedin, retiring all six batters he faced in the start.
- Finished his first season on 9/1 at Daytona...Tossed 2.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with three strikeouts.

### MISCELLANEOUS

- Played high school baseball for his dad, Roger, at Buckhorn HS in Huntsville. Has two brothers, Mitchell and Trey... Mitchell is a senior pitcher at Alabama-Huntsville... Favorites while at Vanderbilt included: Miguel Cabrera (baseball player), Atlanta Braves (team), Division 3 Football's Finest and Billy Madison (movies), The Walking Dead and Family Guy (TV shows), Adam Sandler (actor), burrito bowl from Chipotle (favorite meal), Kid Cudi, Gucci and Billy Currington (music)... Says Channing Tatum would play him in a movie... Uses friendly as the one word to describe himself... Roommates with Jason Delay and Bryan Reynolds... Lists winning the WWBA National Championship as his most memorable athletic moment... Recipient of the Hendrix Athletic Scholarship... Chose Vanderbilt for "the combination of athletics and academics."
