- Spent all of 2017 with High-A Palm Beach, leading the Florida State League with a 3.10 ERA
- Helped Palm Beach to a 2017 FSL Co-Championship, making one postseason start on 9/5 at Fort Myers with just one run through 6.0 frames
- In 2016 with Low-A Peoria, went 5-5, 3.31 ERA in 21 starts, earning a Midwest League Midseason All-Star Selection
- Named the Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May, 2016, going 3-0, 0.87 ERA in five starts, striking out 26 in 31.0 innings
- While with Peoria, struck out a career-best nine batters in 7.0 innings at Quad Cities on 7/27/16
- Selected by St. Louis in the supplemental 1st round (39th overall) of the 2015 June Draft out of Plant High School in Tampa, FL
- Was High School teammate of Astros prospect and former Hooks OF Kyle Tucker

Cardinals' Chirps...

- **Last game...** The Missions wrapped up the series win with a 6-0 victory in the rubber match of the three-game set on Sunday evening. Missions RHP Cal Quantrill cooled the Cardinals bats with 7.0 scoreless frames, striking out a season-high 10 batters while allowing just three hits and one walk. Meanwhile, the San Antonio sticks swung onto the board with a 3B Ty France sac fly in the 5th before adding a grand slam from SS Matt Batten in the 8th and an unearned run in the 9th. RHP Matt Pearce made his season debut for Springfield with 4.0 scoreless frames to start.
- **1st-Place Birds...** The Cards hold a 0.5-game lead over Arkansas for 1st place in the North Division First Half Standings. With just 14 games left in the half, all four North Division teams are within 1.5 games of one another. The First Half Champs in both divisions earn a guaranteed playoff berth.
- **Tommy's turnaround...** Despite the first portion of May being a cool stretch, INF Tommy Edman enjoyed a torrid final stretch of the month that has continued into June. The San Diego native has hit in 10 of his last 11 games, hitting .333 (16x48), 2 HR, 7 RBI, 3 2B, 11 R during that stretch. Currently on a six-game hitting streak with hits in every game during the past homestand, Edman has actually fared better on the road this year, hitting .275 with two homers, six doubles, two triples, 14 RBIs and 20 runs in 27 games away from Hammons Field.
- **Edmundo's mundo...** It has been INF Edmundo Sosa's world of late, as the 22 year old Panama City native caught fire to close May and open June. He has hit safely in 10 of his last 13G, batting .400 (20x50) with two home runs, four doubles, 12 RBIs and seven multi-hit performances during that stretch, increasing his season average from .230 to .275 since 5/18. Sosa closed the month of May hitting .307 (31x101) with three homers, six doubles, 16 RBIs and 14 runs in 28 games.
- **Trosclair's career night...** INF Stefan Trosclair tied a Springfield Cardinals all-time record with five hits on Saturday, going 5x5 with five singles while adding an RBI and two runs. It marks his first-career five-hit game as he becomes the seventh all-time Springfield Cardinal to accomplish that feat, last done by the late OF Oscar Taveras on 6/4/12 vs. Corpus Christi.
- **Lane launches a pair...** OF Lane Thomas's two blasts on Saturday, followed by a base hit on Sunday, continue a red-hot trend for the Knoxville, TN native, who has hit safely in eight of his last nine. During that stretch, he is hitting .316 (12x38) with two homers, two doubles and 11 RBIs.
- **Northwest's nightmare...** OF Victor Roache has clobbered the Naturals this year, hitting .341 (15x44) with six homers and 10 RBIs in 12 games.
- **Swinging at the start...** With two more home runs to start innings on Saturday, the Cardinals have now hit a remarkable 19 homers to open frames this year. Leading off innings in general, Springfield is hitting .270 with 24 doubles and five triples to go along with the 19 jacks.
- **Four or more...** The Cardinals are a lopsided 25-9 when scoring 4+ runs this year. However, they have gone just 3-19 when scoring three or fewer.

CHRIS CHINEA – Hits in 7 of last 11 G (8x45, 2 HR, 6 RBI, 5 R)... At Home - .246 (15x61), 3 HR, 9 RBI, 5 2B, 18 G... 5G hit streak from 5/7-5/11 (6x17, 4 2B, 2 RBI)... Has reached base in 27 of his 37G this season... Hit first-career Double-A home run (solo) in first at-bat of the year on 4/7/18 in MID... .260, 6 HR, 48 RBIs, 24 2B in High-A Palm Beach in 2017... ranked among Cardinals Minor Leaguers in hits (8th, 121) and doubles (7th, 24) last year... 17th round pick in 2015 out of Louisiana State

BLAKE DRAKE – Hits in 5 of last 7G – .280 (7x25), 2 HR, 2 2B, 5 RBI, 4R... May - .254 (16x63), 2 HR, 7 2B, 11 RBI, 6 R, 22 G... Joined SPR from extended spring training on 4/26/18... Started 2017 season with SPR (.220, 2 HR, 4 RBI, 12G) before spending majority of season with High-A Palm Beach (.245, 7 HR, 27 RBI, 15 2B, 82G)... Led Florida State League in 2017 with 13 outfield assists... Rated as having the “Best Outfield Arm” in the FSL last year by *Baseball America*... Double-A debut on 6/7/16 and hit .254, 5 HR, 8 2B, 26 RBI, 27 R in 58G with SPR that year... 18th rounder in 2014 out of Concordia (OR) Univ... Native of Ramona, CA

LUKE DYKSTRA – At Home - .320 (8x25), 1 RBI, 8 G... Had 4G hitting streak from 4/28-5/2 (6x15, 1 2B, 1 RBI)... Has hit in 13 of 23G so far with 4 multi-hit games... Spent 2017 with High-A Palm Beach - .250, 2 HR, 27 RBI, 9 2B, 81G... Acquired by STL from Atlanta with RHP John Gant and RHP Chris Ellis in exchange for LHP Jaime Garcia on 12/1/16... 7th round pick in 2014 by Braves out of Westlake (CA) HS... Son of former Major League outfielder Lenny Dykstra (Mets, Phillies)... has a brother, Cutter, who was drafted by the Brewers in 2008 and also played in the Nationals system

TOMMY EDMAN – Hits in 10 of last 11G – .333 (16x48), 2 HR, 7 RBI, 3 2B, 11 R... On base in last 11G... On base in 43 of 52 games this season (.328 OBP)... Tied Springfield single game record with 4 BB on 5/1 @ NWA, his 2nd-career 4 BB game (8/25/16 vs. Batavia with Short-A State College)... Has 14 multi-hit games this year... Split 2017 between Low-A Peoria (38 G), High-A Palm Beach (18 G) and Springfield (63 G)... .247, 2 HR, 26 RBI, 12 2B with SPR last year... Ranked among STL Minor Leaguers in hits (9th, 116), doubles (t-10th, 22), triples (t-2nd, 8), RBIs (t-10th, 55) and steals (10th, 13)... Across three levels in 2017, hit .330 (38x115) with RISP... 6th rounder in 2016 from Stanford

GRANDEN GOETZMAN – Leads the club with three triples... RBIs in 6 of last 11G (8 RBI)... Had 7G hit streak from 5/20-5/25 (9x25, 2 2B, 2 RBI, 3R)... Hits in 14 of 20G since returning to SPR on 5/14 - .294 (20x68), 3 HR, 5 2B, 1 3B, 12 RBI, 8 R... First-career multi-HR game on 5/15 vs. TUL (2 HR, 4 RBI)... Signed by STL on 1/16/18... veteran OF hit .245, 24 HR, 201 RBI, 83 2B, 21 3B in 457 G in Rays system... Reached AAA in 2017, playing 17 G with Durham - .314, 1 HR, 13 RBI... Played a career-high 110 games in 2014 but has battled injuries throughout his career... 2nd round pick in 2011 by Tampa out of Palmetto (FL) High School

JEREMY MARTINEZ – Returned to SPR on 5/29 after 6 G with AAA-Memphis from 5/12-5/23 - .235 (4x17), 2 2B, 2 RBI, 6G... Has reached base in 10 of 15 G with SPR (.340 OBP)... Hit first-career Double-A HR (2R) on 5/8 vs. TUL... Hit .189, 0 HR, 15 RBIs, in 60 G in High-A Palm Beach in 2017 after .325, 1 HR, 32 RBI, in 57 G in Short-A State College in 2016... 4th round pick in 2016 out of Southern California... Moved from 1B to C after his sophomore season at USC

EVAN MENDOZA – Had 6G hit streak from 5/26 – 6/2 – .450 (9x20), 4 RBI, 4 R, 8 BB... Leads STL farmhands with .335 average between PB (.349) and SPR (.296)... Went 3x4 in Double-A debut on 5/18 vs. NWA after joining SPR from High-A Palm Beach... With PB this year - .349, 3 HR, 16 RBI, 7 2B, 37G... Finished PB stint on 10G hit streak (18x42, 2 HR, 3 2B, 5 RBI)... Started season with 12G hit streak (17x48, 4 2B, 5 RBI)... Led all 2017 Cardinals Minor Leaguers with .339 combined batting average (Short-A and Low-A)... Won NY-Penn League Batting Title with .370 clip with State College... Ranked by MLB.com as Cardinals #30 prospect... 11th round pick in 2017 out of NC State

VICTOR ROACHE – First 3-hit game of season on 6/1 vs. SA (3x4), 14th multi-hit game... Leads league and t-4th in MiLB with 15 HRs... 3rd in TL with 41 RBIs (most in STL org.)... TL Player of the Week for 4/30-5/6 (.379, 11x29, 6 HR, 15 RBI, 7G)... 8G hit streak from 4/30-5/7 (12x32, 6 HR, 15 RBI)... Had 3G HR streak from 5/5-5/7 (3HRs, 10 RBIs)... Hit two 2R-HRs on 4/30 vs. ARK, his 6th career multi-HR game... Had 16G on-base streak from 4/8 – 4/27/18... Signed by STL on 1/31/18... 1st round pick in 2012 by Milwaukee out of Georgia Southern... Led NCAA D-1 and set Georgia Southern record with 30 HR in 2011

THOMAS SPITZ – On base in 4 of last 6G – 5x17, 1 HR, 1 2B, 2 RBI, 6 R, 4 BB... Tallied a season-high 3 hits (3x4) with first-career Double-A HR on 4/15 vs. FRI... 11 G with SPR in 2017 from 5/7-6/4... Hit .253, 5 HR, 27 RBI, 16 2B in 101 G with High-A Palm Beach last year... Made Double-A debut with SPR with 4 G from 8/16 – 8/20/16... 32nd round pick in 2015 out of Wingate (NC) University where he was an All-American

EDMUNDO SOSA – Hits in 10 of last 13G - .400 (20x50), 2 HR, 4 2B, 12 RBI... May - .307 (31x101), 3 HR, 6 2B, 16 RBI, 14 R, 28G... 15 multi-hit games this season... At Home: .304, 5 HR, 6 2B, 1 3B, 15 RBIs, 25G... Has hit safely in 33 of 50G overall... Debuted with SPR on 6/16/17, only game in Double-A last season... Hit .305, 0 HR, 7 RBI, 18 H in 17 G with Surprise in 2017 Arizona Fall League... Played for Team Panama during 2016 qualifying round of the 2017 World Baseball Classic... Still ranked #16 for STL by MLB.com, was Top 5 ranked prospect as recently as 2015

LANE THOMAS – Hits in 8 of last 9G – .316 (12x38), 2 HR, 2 2B, 11 RBI, 5 R... First-career multi-HR game (2 HRs) on 6/2 vs. SA... On base in 20 of 27 games in May with 18 BB... 14G on-base streak from Opening Day 4/5 – 4/20/18... Hit safely in first 10G to start season (.421, 4 HR, 6 2B during streak)... Collected an XBH in first 7G of the season (2HR, 6 2B during streak)... Acquired from TOR on 7/2/17 for international cap space... Spent most of 2017 with High-A Dunedin (TOR) - .252, 4 HR, 12 2B, 6 3B in 73 G... Hit in 6 of 9 games with Palm Beach last year, including 3x4, 1 3B, 1 RBI on 7/16/17... Originally picked by TOR in 5th round in 2014 out of Bearden HS in Knoxville, TN

STEFAN TROSCLAIR – Has scored a run in 8 of last 10G (12 R)... RBI in 5 of last 9G (6 RBI)... Tied SPR all-time record with career-high five hits (5x5, 1 RBI, 2R) on 6/2 vs. SA... First-career Double-A HR on 5/21 vs. NWA (2R, 2nd inn.)... Hits in 8 of first 12G with SPR (.326, 14x53, 1 HR, 7 RBI, 12 R)... Went 2x4, 1 RBI in Double-A debut on 5/18 vs. NWA after joining SPR from High-A Palm Beach... With PB this year - .226, 3 HR, 13 RBI, 6 2B, 33G... Spent 2017 with Low-A Peoria - .272, 15 HR, 18 2B, 6 3B, 59 RBI, 111G... 2017 Midwest League Midseason All-Star and went 1x2, 2 SB, 1R in the All-Star Game... Rated as the 2017 Best Defensive First Baseman in the Midwest League by *Baseball America*... 20th round pick in 2016 out of Univ. of Louisiana-Lafayette
