- Spent all of 2017 with High-A Palm Beach, leading the Florida State League with a 3.10 ERA
- Helped Palm Beach to a 2017 FSL Co-Championship, making one postseason start on 9/5 at Fort Myers with just one run through 6.0 frames
- In 2016 with Low-A Peoria, went 5-5, 3.31 ERA in 21 starts, earning a Midwest League Midseason All-Star Selection
- Named the Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May, 2016, going 3-0, 0.87 ERA in five starts, striking out 26 in 31.0 innings
- While with Peoria, struck out a career-best nine batters in 7.0 innings at Quad Cities on 7/27/16
- Selected by St. Louis in the supplemental 1st round (39th overall) of the 2015 June Draft out of Plant High School in Tampa, FL

Cardinals' Chirps...

- **Last game...** The Cardinals rallied for five runs in the 1st and never looked back, cruising to the 7-1 win in the series opener against the Naturals before 8,059 fans at Hammons Field on Sunday. An RBI sac fly from 1B John Nogowski and an RBI single by CF Lane Thomas started the scoring in the 1st, before RF Blake Drake blew it open with a three-run double to make it 5-0. 2B Ramon Urias added to it with a solo blast in the 4th, while RHP Mike O'Reilly stifled the Naturals bats across his 7.0 shutout innings. Both sides traded a run in the 8th and the Cards took the opener, 7-1.
- **Back from the future...** C Andrew Knizner returns today after suiting up in the MLB All-Star Futures Game on Sunday at Nationals Park. Knizner went 0x2 but caught a scoreless inning for former Springfield and current AAA-Memphis RHP Dakota Hudson. OF Randy Arozarena, also currently with Memphis, checked in in the 7th and reached on a fielding error.
- **A fortnight's streak (not that Fortnite)...** INF Ramon Urias extended his hitting streak to a team-best 14 games with a solo blast on Sunday, his eighth straight game with at least one extra-base hit. With at least one double in nine of the 14 games during his streak, Urias is batting .375 (21x56) with five homers, 10 doubles, 11 RBIs and 11 runs during that stretch. He has also tallied an RBI in 11 of his 18 games since returning from AAA-Memphis on 6/24.
- **More multi-hit games from Mendoza...** 3B Evan Mendoza collected two more singles on Sunday for his fourth-straight multi-hit performance. On a current five-game hitting streak overall, he is 11x22 with a pair of RBIs and has increased his average from .240 to .269 in just the five games.
- **Blake on base...** OF Blake Drake continued a great month of July with two more hits on Sunday, including his 12th and 13th doubles of the year. Drake has reached base safely in each of his last nine games with a plate appearance, hitting safely in seven of them and batting .333 (10x30) with a homer, four doubles and five RBIs. He's also worked six walks during his on-base streak, including a free pass in four of his last five games. Overall this season against the Naturals, he is hitting .348 (16x46) with two home runs and a team-leading 15 RBIs in 14 games.
- **Two is better than one...** After turning a season-high four double plays in back-to-back games on Friday and Saturday, the Cardinals doubled up the Naturals once on Sunday to increase their total to nine double plays in their last three games. Springfield's all-time record for most double plays turned in one game is six, set on 4/11/14 in San Antonio. Interestingly, they set that record one day after committing a team-record six errors on 4/10/14 in San Antonio. On the campaign, the Cardinals are 3rd in the Texas League with 93 double plays turned.
- **Love the glove...** In addition to all the double plays, the Cardinals have been one of the top fielding teams in the Texas League all season, currently tied with Corpus Christi for the top fielding percentage in the circuit at .980. Through 93 games this year, the Cardinals have recorded the 2nd-most assists in the league with 906 while recording the fewest amount of errors with 66. The Cardinals only have six errors through 14 games in July.

Bird Seed...

BLAKE DRAKE – Current 9G on-base streak with hits in seven of those games since 7/4 - .333 (10x30), 1 HR, 4 2B, 5 RBI, 9 R... His 2x3, 1 HR, 2 RBI night on 7/4 snapped a 1x25 stretch from 6/9-7/3... Joined SPR from extended spring training on 4/26/18... Started 2017 season with SPR (.220, 2 HR, 4 RBI, 12G) before spending majority of season with High-A Palm Beach (.245, 7 HR, 27 RBI, 15 2B, 82G)... Led Florida State League in 2017 with 13 outfield assists... Rated as having the “Best Outfield Arm” in the FSL last year by *Baseball America*... Double-A debut on 6/7/16 and hit .254, 5 HR, 8 2B, 26 RBI, 27 R in 58G with SPR that year... 18th rounder in 2014 out of Concordia (OR) Univ... Native of Ramona, CA

LUKE DYKSTRA – Hits in 6 of last 11G – .265 (9x34), 1 2B, 2 RBI... At home - .278 (15x54), 1 2B, 3 RBI, 18 G... Spent 2017 with High-A Palm Beach - .250, 2 HR, 27 RBI, 9 2B, 81G... Acquired by STL from Atlanta with RHP John Gant and RHP Chris Ellis in exchange for LHP Jaime Garcia on 12/1/16... 7th round pick in 2014 by Braves out of Westlake (CA) HS... Son of former Major League outfielder Lenny Dykstra (Mets, Phillies)... has a brother, Cutter, who was drafted by the Brewers in 2008 and also played in the Nationals system

TOMMY EDMAN – On base in 43 of last 46G with hits in 39 of those games - .333 (62x186), 3 HR, 13 RBI, 10 2B, 29 R... Broke SPR all-time record with 32G on-base streak from 5/21-6/29, hitting safely in 29 of those games - .343 (46x134), 3 HR, 11 RBI, 6 2B, 24 R... Had 10G hit streak from 5/29 – 6/8 - .364 (16x44), 7 R... On base in 75 of 87 games this season (.345 OBP)... Tied Springfield single game record with 4 BB on 5/1 @ NWA, his 2nd-career 4 BB game (8/25/16 vs. Batavia with Short-A State College)... Has team-best 28 multi-hit games this year... Split 2017 between Low-A Peoria (38 G), High-A Palm Beach (18 G) and Springfield (63 G) ... 6th rounder in 2016 from Stanford

JOSE GODOY – Returned to SPR from High-A PB on 7/12... First stint with SPR from 5/18-5/27 - hit in 6 of 8G (.222, 6x27)... With PB this year - .303 (40x132), 2 HR, 5 2B, 1 3B, 14 RBI, 44 G... Had 9G hit streak with PB from 4/24-5/11/18 (11x30, 1 HR, 2 RBI, 4R)... Spent 2017 with PB - .265, 4 HR, 41 RBI, 14 2B, 69 G... Double-A debut with SPR on 7/7/16, going 1x1 with PH single before returning to Low-A Peoria... Has caught 44% (133x301) of attempted base stealers throughout his career... Native of Maracaibo, Venezuela signed with STL as non-drafted free agent in 2011

ANDREW KNIZNER – Had 6G hit streak from 7/2-7/9 – .273 (6x22), 1 2B, 3 RBI... Hits in 13 of last 16G – .328 (19x58), 1 HR, 3 2B, 8 RBI, 7 R... Went season-high 4x4, 1 2B, 1 RBI on 6/23 vs. ARK... Was with AAA-Memphis from 5/17 - 6/8 - .333 (15x45), 5 2B, 4 RBI, 14G... With SPR - 15 multi-hit games with 6 in a row from 4/15-4/23 (13x24)... 2 HRs in 2018 MLB Spring Training with STL (Non-Roster Invitee)... promoted from Low-A Peoria to SPR on 6/14/17 and hit .324, 4 HR, 22 RBI, 13 2B in 51 Double-A games... Hit .358, 3 HR, 12 RBI in 17 G in 2017 Arizona Fall League, named to Rising Stars All-Star Game... Shifted from 3B to C after sophomore season at NC State

JEREMY MARTINEZ – Hits in 5 of last 6G – 8x19, 1 HR, 2 2B, 4 RBI, 3 R... On the road - .350 (14x40), 1 HR, 2 2B, 5 RBI, 14G... Matched a career-high with 3BB on 6/5 @ NWA (first done on 6/29/16 with Short-A State College)... Returned to SPR on 5/29 after 6 G with AAA-Memphis from 5/12-5/23 - .235 (4x17), 2 2B, 2 RBI, 6G... Hit first-career Double-A HR (2R) on 5/8 vs. TUL... Hit .189, 0 HR, 15 RBIs, in 60 G in High-A Palm Beach in 2017 after .325, 1 HR, 32 RBI, in 57 G in Short-A State College in 2016... 4th round pick in 2016 out of Southern California... Moved from 1B to C after his sophomore season at USC

EVAN MENDOZA – Current 5G hit streak with multiple hits in last 4G (11x22, 2 RBI) after going 4x47 from 6/29-7/11... Had 10G hit streak from 6/17-6/29 – .310 (13x42), 4 2B, 5 RBI... Named STL Minor League Player of the Month for May - .369, 2 HR, 10 RBI, .895 OPS, 28G between SPR and PB... Went 3x4 in Double-A debut on 5/18 vs. NWA after joining SPR from High-A Palm Beach... Started season with PB with 12G hit streak (17x48, 4 2B, 5 RBI)... Led all 2017 Cardinals Minor Leaguers with .339 combined batting average (Short-A and Low-A)... Won NY-Penn League Batting Title with .370 clip with State College... Ranked by MLB.com as Cardinals #30 prospect... 11th round pick in 2017 out of NC State

JOHAN MIESES... In a current 2x20 stretch since his go-ahead 2R HR in 8th on 7/6 vs. FRI... Joined SPR on 6/28 after starting season with High-A Palm Beach - .251, 10 HR, 8 2B, 2 3B, 40 RBI, 33 R, 65 G... Earned 2018 Florida State League All-Star honors... Had 13G hit streak with PB from 6/3-6/19 – .353 (18x51), 3 HR, 9 RBI, 2 2B... Had 7G RBI streak with PB from 6/3-6/9 (8 RBI)... Acquired by STL from Dodgers for INF Breyvic Valera on April 1, 2018... Split 2017 between High-A Rancho Cucamonga (.353, 8 HR, 27 RBI, 17 2B, 28G) and AA-Tulsa (.160, 16 HR, 36 RBI, 7 2B, 90G)... In 2016, led California League with 28 HR - .247, 28 HR, 78 RBI, 31 2B, 122G... Was ranked by MLB.com among Dodgers Top 30 prospects as recently as 2016 (#21)... Signed by Dodgers as non-drafted free agent on 8/3/13

JOHN NOGOWSKI – Hits in 3 of last 4G – 5x16, 1 2B, 2 RBI... Hits in 24 of last 31 G since 4/17 - .305 (36x118), 4 HR, 4 2B, 24 RBI... When placed on DL on 5/7, was t-3rd in TL with .364 average and t-3rd with 25 RBIs... 11G hitting streak from 4/17-4/30 (18x41, 3HR, 17 RBIs)... 7G RBI streak (14 RBIs) from 4/17-4/26/18... First career grand slam on 4/19/18 in ARK... 12 multi-hit games overall this year with 5 3H games... Signed by STL on 6/27/17 out of Independent American Association... hit .295, 2 HR, 21 RBI, 12 2B in 59 G with SPR through 2nd half last year... Prior to signing, was hitting .402, 4 HR, 28 RBI in 34 G with Sioux City last year... Originally drafted by Oakland in 34th round in 2014 out of Florida State

VICTOR ROACHE – Current 1x22 stretch in last 6G since 7/9... At Home - .264 (39x148), 12 HR, 3 2B, 1 3B, 29 RBI, 45 G... Had 9G hit streak from 6/5-6/13 – .333 (11x33), 3 RBI, 4R... TL Player of the Week for 4/30-5/6 (.379, 11x29, 6 HR, 15 RBI, 7G)... Had 3G HR streak from 5/5-5/7 (3HRs, 10 RBIs)... Hit two 2R-HRs on 4/30 vs. ARK, his 6th career multi-HR game... Had 16G on-base streak from 4/8 – 4/27/18... Signed by STL on 1/31/18... 1st round pick in 2012 by Milwaukee out of Georgia Southern... Led NCAA D-I and set Georgia Southern record with 30 HR in 2011

LANE THOMAS – Hits 14 of last 19G – .284 (21x74), 3 HR, 2 2B, 1 3B, 13 RBI... Hits in 33 of last 45G – .278 (49x176), 7 HR, 6 2B, 1 3B, 33 RBI, 25 R... Had 12G hit streak from 5/31-6/13 – .367 (18x49), 4 HR, 14 RBI, 9R... 17G on-base streak from 5/24 – 6/13... First two career multi-HR games on 6/2 vs. SA (2 HR) and 6/5 @ NWA (2 HR)... t-4th in TL and t-2nd in STL Org. with 16 HRs... t-4th in TL and 1st in STL Org. with 57 RBIs... 24 multi-hit games this year... 14G on-base streak from Opening Day 4/5 – 4/20/18... Hit safely in first 10G to start season (.421, 4 HR, 6 2B during streak)... Collected an XBH in first 7G of the season (2HR, 6 2B during streak)... Acquired from TOR on 7/2/17 for international cap space... Spent most of 2017 with High-A Dunedin (TOR) - .252, 4 HR, 12 2B, 6 3B in 73 G... Originally picked by TOR in 5th round in 2014 out of Bearden HS in Knoxville, TN

RAMON URIAS – Current 14G hit streak with XBH in 8G in a row (4HR, 6 2B) – .375 (21x56), 5 HR, 10 2B, 11 RBI, 11 R... With Memphis this year - .221 (15x68), 3 HR, 5 2B, 8 RBI, 28 G... Hits in 29 of first 35G with SPR with 12 multi-hit games... Went 4x4 with two doubles in SPR debut on 4/22/18 in ARK after opening season with 6G with AAA-Memphis... Signed by STL on 1/4/18 after 5 years in Mexican League (2013-17)... 2017 Mexican League All-Star hitting .340, 19 HR, 79 RBI, 29 2B and league-best 91 R for Mexico City... 32-game on-base streak from 5/12-6/21/17... Older brother of Padres farmhand and former Missions INF Luis Urias... originally signed by Texas in 2011 before being sold to Mexico City in 2013
