- After being drafted in June, 2017, joined Low-A Peoria for the rest of the season - 4-3, 3.41 ERA, 14G/13S, 68.2 IP, 70 H, 27 R, 15 BB, 55 K
- Made his professional debut on 6/27/17 vs. Beloit with 4.0 perfect innings, not allowing a single baserunner and striking out two
- Posted a fantastic month with Peoria in August, 2017 – 3-1, 1.93, 6 GS, 32.2 IP, 30 H, 7 R, 9 BB, 28 K
- Selected by St. Louis in the 9th round (274th overall) of the June, 2017 draft out of East Carolina University
- Ace on Pirates pitching staff went 20-8, 3.00 ERA in 46 career games (43 starts)
- Sustained a broken leg from a line drive to the mound in the third game of the 2017 college season but returned more than a month later
- First pitcher in ECU program history to when a Super Regional game when he led the Pirates past Texas Tech, 8-6, in Game 1 on 6/10/16
- Named First-Team All-American Athletic Conference and Third-Team All-America after his junior season in 2016

Cardinals' Chirps...

- **Last game...** The Naturals topped the Cardinals in game two of the set, 6-3, on Friday night. Springfield swung ahead first with a solo shot from CF Shane Billings in the 3rd, but the Naturals tied it right away with an RBI sac fly from C Nick Dini in the bottom of the inning. A two-run homer from 3B Kelvin Gutierrez in the 4th lifted Northwest Arkansas ahead, 3-1. The Cardinals battled it back even with a run on an error and a game-tying RBI single from C Andrew Knizner in the 6th, but again the Naturals countered in the bottom of the inning with a go-ahead RBI base hit by Gutierrez, making it 4-3. Northwest Arkansas tacked on two insurance tallies in the 8th, including a fourth RBI from Gutierrez, accounting for the 6-3 final.
- **Cardiac Cards...** The Cardinals 10-inning walk-off on Wednesday marked the club's fourth walk-off winner in their last 27 games after they did not record a single one through the first 85 games of the season. During the previous seven-game homestand alone, the Cardinals authored a pair of walk-off wins, with OF Randy Arozarena providing a walk-off solo shot in the 9th on Sunday, before Nogowski's game-winning single on Wednesday. The Cards first two walk-offs of the year were on 7/7 with a 10th-inning single from C Jeremy Martinez and on 7/16 with a 10th-inning grand slam from OF Johan Mieses.
- **Diggin' the long-ball...** One of the top home run hitting teams in the league all year, the Cardinals have swatted 21 homers in their last 12 games, including a season-high six in the 16-5 blowout win in Tulsa on 7/24, one shy of matching the club's all-time record (7 HRs, 7/8/16 vs. CC). The Cards set a monthly team high this year with 41 homers in July and are up to 128 on the year, 2nd in the league and in all of Double-A only to Tulsa's 151 round-trippers.
- **Oh to be Young...** The reigning Texas League Player of the Week for 7/23-7/29, INF Andy Young followed up a 3x5 night on Wednesday, including a three-run blast, with a base hit on Thursday, extending his current hitting streak to five games. The West Fargo, ND native has hit in 10 of his first 12 games this year with Springfield, batting .396 (19x48) with six home runs, 16 RBIs and 10 runs in just 12 games, which already includes a pair of four-hit, two-homer performances.
- **Tommy back at the top...** With multi-hit performances in four of his seven games back from the Disabled List, INF Tommy Edman has hit safely in each of his last 15 games overall, batting .379 (25x66) with one homer and six doubles during that stretch. In 49 games since June 1, Edman leads the league with a .355 (72x203) average, adding two homers, 13 doubles, 14 RBIs and 33 runs. With a team-high 121 hits on the year, he currently needs 38 more to match OF Charlie Tilson's all-time Springfield Cardinals single season record of 159 hits from the 2015 season.
- **Knizner connecting...** C Andrew Knizner extended his 10-game hitting streak with an RBI single on Friday, hitting .436 (17x39) with three homers and nine RBIs while notching at least one RBI in six of those 10 games. The Richmond, VA native closed a terrific month of July, in which he hit .314 with three home runs and 12 RBIs, hitting safely in 16 of his 19 games last month.

Split 2017 between Low-A Peoria (.310, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 14 SB, 46 G) and High-A Palm Beach (.281, 11 2B, 12 RBI, 59 G)... At Wingate University in 2016, ranked 4th in NCAA Division II with 96 hits and 74 runs, while also ranking 9th with .444 average... 13th round pick in 2016 out of Wingate (NC) University

CHRIS CHINEA – Current 3x19 stretch in 9G since 7/24... Hits in 14 of last 23G since 6/28 – .274 (20x73), 4 HR, 3 2B, 8 RBI, 10 R ... Named TL Player of Week for 6/25-7/1 – 7x15, 3 HR, 4 RBI, 4 R, 4 G... Led the team with 5 HRs in June - .269 (21x78), 5 HR, 11 RBI, 14 R, 22 G... Hit first-career Double-A home run (solo) in first at-bat of the year on 4/7/18 in MID... .260, 6 HR, 48 RBIs, 24 2B in High-A Palm Beach in 2017... 17th round pick in 2015 out of Louisiana State

BLAKE DRAKE – Current 4x23 stretch in last 7G since 7/27... Had 7G hit streak from 7/17-7/27 – .370 (10x27), 1 2B, 7 RBI, 4 R... 17G on-base streak with hits in 13 of those games from 7/4-7/27 - .345 (20x58), 1 HR, 5 2B, 12 RBI, 14 R... Joined SPR from extended spring training on 4/26/18... Led Florida State League in 2017 with 13 outfield assists... Rated as having the “Best Outfield Arm” in the FSL last year by *Baseball America*... Double-A debut on 6/7/16 and hit .254, 5 HR, 8 2B, 26 RBI, 27 R in 58G with SPR that year... 18th rounder in 2014 out of Concordia (OR) Univ... Native of Ramona, CA

TOMMY EDMAN – Since June 1, leads TL with .355 average (72x203), 30 points higher than next best AVG during that time (ARK 1B Joey Curletta, .325)... Current 15G hit streak since 7/12 – .379 (25x66), 1 HR, 6 2B, 7 RBI... On base in 54 of last 57G with hits in 50 of those games - .349 (82x235), 4 HR, 20 RBI, 15 2B, 41 R... Broke SPR all-time record with 32G on-base streak from 5/21-6/29, hitting safely in 29 of those games - .343 (46x134), 3 HR, 11 RBI, 6 2B, 24 R... Had 10G hit streak from 5/29 – 6/8 - .364 (16x44), 7 R... On base in 86 of 98 games this season (.355 OBP)... Tied Springfield single game record with 4 BB on 5/1 @ NWA, his 2nd-career 4 BB game (8/25/16 vs. Batavia with Short-A State College)... Has team-best 33 multi-hit games this year... Split 2017 between Low-A Peoria (38 G), High-A Palm Beach (18 G) and Springfield (63 G) ... 6th rounder in 2016 from Stanford

ANDREW KNIZNER – Current 10G hit streak – .436 (17x39), 3 HR, 1 2B, 10 RBI, 9 R... Hits in 25 of last 30G – .342 (38x111), 4 HR, 4 2B, 18 RBI, 18 R... Went season-high 4x4, 1 2B, 1 RBI on 6/23 vs. ARK... Was with AAA-Memphis from 5/17 - 6/8 - .333 (15x45), 5 2B, 4 RBI, 14G... With SPR - 21 multi-hit games with 6 in a row from 4/15-4/23 (13x24)... 2 HRs in 2018 MLB Spring Training with STL (Non-Roster Invitee)... promoted from Low-A Peoria to SPR on 6/14/17 and hit .324, 4 HR, 22 RBI, 13 2B in 51 Double-A games... Hit .358, 3 HR, 12 RBI in 17 G in 2017 Arizona Fall League, named to Rising Stars All-Star Game... Shifted from 3B to C after sophomore season at NC State

JEREMY MARTINEZ – Hits in 9 of last 13G – .295 (13x44), 2 HR, 2 2B, 8 RBI, 6 R... On the road - .304 (17x56), 1 HR, 2 2B, 6 RBI, 19G... Matched a career-high with 3BB on 6/5 @ NWA (first done on 6/29/16 with Short-A State College)... Returned to SPR on 5/29 after 6 G with AAA-Memphis from 5/12-5/23 - .235 (4x17), 2 2B, 2 RBI, 6G... Hit first-career Double-A HR (2R) on 5/8 vs. TUL... Hit .189, 0 HR, 15 RBIs, in 60 G in High-A Palm Beach in 2017 after .325, 1 HR, 32 RBI, in 57 G in Short-A State College in 2016... 4th round pick in 2016 out of Southern California... Moved from 1B to C after his sophomore season at USC

EVAN MENDOZA – Hits in 17 of last 24G since 7/11, including 8 multi-hit games - .295 (28x95), 2 HR, 2 2B, 1 3B, 8 RBI... Had 10G hit streak from 6/17-6/29 – .310 (13x42), 4 2B, 5 RBI... Named STL Minor League Player of the Month for May - .369, 2 HR, 10 RBI, .895 OPS, 28G between SPR and PB... Went 3x4 in Double-A debut on 5/18 vs. NWA after joining SPR from High-A Palm Beach... Started season with PB with 12G hit streak (17x48, 4 2B, 5 RBI)... Led all 2017 Cardinals Minor Leaguers with .339 combined batting average (Short-A and Low-A)... Won NY-Penn League Batting Title with .370 clip with State College... Ranked by MLB.com as Cardinals #30 prospect... 11th round pick in 2017 out of NC State

When placed on DL on 5/7, was t-3rd in TL with .364 average and t-3rd with 25 RBIs... 11G hitting streak from 4/17-4/30 (18x41, 3HR, 17 RBIs)... 7G RBI streak (14 RBIs) from 4/17-4/26/18... First career grand slam on 4/19/18 in ARK... 18 multi-hit games overall this year with 6 3H games... Signed by STL on 6/27/17 out of Independent American Association... hit .295, 2 HR, 21 RBI, 12 2B in 59 G with SPR through 2nd half last year... Prior to signing, was hitting .402, 4 HR, 28 RBI in 34 G with Sioux City last year... Originally drafted by Oakland in 34th round in 2014 out of Florida State

Has 3 4H games with SPR, including 4x4 with two doubles in SPR debut on 4/22/18 in ARK... Signed by STL on 1/4/18 after 5 years in Mexican League (2013-17)... 2017 Mexican League All-Star hitting .340, 19 HR, 79 RBI, 29 2B and league-best 91 R for Mexico City... 32-game on-base streak from 5/12-6/21/17... Older brother of Padres farmhand and former Missions INF Luis Urias... originally signed by Texas in 2011 before being sold to Mexico City in 2013
