#### Cardinals' Chirps...

- Last game... The Naturals struck with a three-run blast from 2B Gabriel Cancel in the top of the 9<sup>th</sup> to swing out of a late 4-4 tie and claim the 7-4 win before a packed house of 6,819 fans at Hammons Field on Friday. Northwest Arkansas took an early 1-0 lead in the 2<sup>nd</sup>, but the Cardinals swung in front in the bottom of the frame with an RBI single from DH Johan Mieses and a two-run shot from LF Conner Capel. The Naturals battled it even with two runs in the 5<sup>th</sup> and took a momentary 4-3 lead on an RBI single from RF Khalil Lee in the 7<sup>th</sup>. The Cardinals capitalized on a two-out error in the bottom of the 7<sup>th</sup> to again square the score at 4-4, but Cancel dealt the final blow in the 9<sup>th</sup> to propel the Naturals to the 7-4 win.
- Into the swing... OF Randy Arozarena has continued to find a rhythm through his first 18 games of the season, collecting hits in eight of his last 10 contests with a .306 (11x36) average during that stretch. The 24 year old made his season debut on 5/11 after sustaining a preseason hand injury when he was hit by a pitch in a Major League Spring Training game. A pivotal piece to the Memphis Redbirds PCL and Triple-A Championship run last year, he hit in 20 of his 24 Double-A games in 2018, batting an incredible .396 (36x91) with seven homers and 21 RBIs.
- Flying high... With hits in 15 of his last 19 games, OF Dylan Carlson has continued to torch Texas League pitching with a .338 (24x71), four home runs, four triples, three doubles, 16 RBIs and 13 runs during that stretch. Carlson ranks among league leaders in 10 categories, including total bases (2<sup>nd</sup>, 105), extra-base hits (2<sup>nd</sup>, 25), home runs (t-9<sup>th</sup>, 8), hits (5<sup>th</sup>, 58), runs (1<sup>st</sup>, 38), triples (1<sup>st</sup>, 6), RBIs (6<sup>th</sup>, 35), batting average (8<sup>th</sup>, .296), slugging pct. (4<sup>th</sup>, .536) and on-base-plus-slugging (5<sup>th</sup>, .905).
- Robertson returns... INF Kramer Robertson has gone 3x7 with an RBI in two games back with Springfield after a three-week stint with AAA-Memphis, where he hit .200 (6x30) with one homer and three RBIs in 15 games from 5/9-5/28. Robertson was out to a terrific start to his first Double-A season prior to his call-up and is hitting .255 with six homers, four doubles, 18 RBIs, 25 walks and a .417 on-base percentage.
- Not Miesing around... OF Johan Mieses has been excellent throwing out runners, leading all Texas League outfielders with seven outfield assists this year. With a league-high 18 outfield assists as a team, OF Conner Capel is t-2<sup>nd</sup> in the circuit with five, while OF Dylan Carlson has added three.
- Power game... The Cardinals have continued collecting extra-base hits at an elite pace with 157 of them through their first 54 games, 2<sup>nd</sup> most in the league and all of Double-A only to Corpus Christi's 160. Springfield ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league with 91 doubles, 3<sup>rd</sup> with 56 home runs and 4<sup>th</sup> with a .395 slugging pct.

RANDY AROZARENA –Hits in 8 of last 10G – .306 (11x36), 1 HR, 1 3B, 2 2B, 4 RBI, 4R... 7G on-base streak, 5/15-5/22 – 8x25, 1 HR, 2 2B, 2 RBI, 6 R, 5 BB... Played 89G with Memphis in 2018 - .232, 5 HR, 28 RBI, 16 2B, 17 SB... Hit 2 HR w/5 RBI in PCL-Title clinching game for Memphis vs. Fresno on 9/15/18, hitting .407 (11x27), 2 HR, 9 RBI, 3 2B in 8 total playoff games... Hit in 20 of 24G with SPR in 2018 - .396 (36x91), 7 HR, 21 RBI, 5 2B... In SPR season debut on 5/5/18 vs. TUL, went 2x4 with a grand slam and career-high 5 RBIs... Earned 2017 Florida State League Midseason All-Star honors and tied for FSL Home Run Derby Title... Currently ranked by MLB.com as Cardinals #14 prospect... Signed by St. Louis out of the Mexican League on July 26, 2016

RAYDER ASCANIO – Hit first Double-A HR (3R) in Game 2 on 5/30 vs. TUL... With PB this year - .259, 4 2B, 9 RBI, 31 G... Spent 2018 with Low-A Peoria - .246, 4 HR, 18 RBI, 6 2B, 27 R, 66G... Acquired by STL from Seattle in exchange for RHP Mike Leake, cash considerations and international cap space on 8/30/17... In 2017, played 42G for Clinton (Low-A), 3G for Tacoma (AAA) and 66G Modesto (High-A) in Seattle's system, before finishing year with 3G in Palm Beach... Spent 2016 with Low-A Clinton and recorded 32 multi-hit games, including nine 3H games... Originally signed as a non-drafted free agent with Seattle on 12/16/12 out of Mariara, Carabobo, Venezuela

CONNER CAPEL – RBIs in 5 of last 7G (6 RBI)... Hits in 11 of last 15G - .218 (12x55), 2HR, 10RBI... 6G hit streak, 5/11-17 – .280 (7x25), 1 HR, 4 RBI... Currently ranked by MLB.com as STL #17 prospect... First Double-A hit and RBI on 4/5 in NWA – 2x3, 2B, RBI, BB... Acquired by STL from Cleveland with OF Jhon Torres for former SPR OF Oscar Mercado on 7/31/18... In 2017 with Low-A Lake County, ranked among Midwest League leaders in HR (22, 3<sup>rd</sup>), runs (73, t-9<sup>th</sup>) and triples (7, t-6<sup>th</sup>)... Has two career 2-HR games, both in 2017 with Lake County... Son of former MLB pitcher Mike Capel, who appeared in 49 games for Cubs (1988), Brewers (1990) and Astros (1991)... Godson of Roger Clemens... 5<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2016 out of Seven Lakes HS (TX)

Ranked by MLB.com as Cardinals #6 prospect... Started 2018 with 13G in Low-A Peoria before High-A Palm Beach debut on 4/25/18... With PB - .247, 9 HR, 53 RBI, 19 2B, 99G... Ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in FSL last year with 52 BB in just 99G...
