- Tossed at least 5.0 innings in all 8 GS with Palm Beach, not allowing more than three earned runs in any of them
- Made his High-A debut on 4/8 vs. Daytona with 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out six

Cardinals' Chirps...

- **Last game...** The Drillers jumped ahead in the opening inning and never looked back as they took the opening game from the Cardinals, 6-2, on Monday night. Rehabbing Dodger and former Cardinal Jedd Gyorko slugged the two-run shot in the 1st, which was followed in the 3rd by a two-run homer from 2B Angelo Mora. The Cardinals got two runs back on a two-run single to right field by SS Rayder Ascanio, cutting the deficit to 4-2. An RBI single from 3B Cristian Santana in the 5th and a solo home run from SS Omar Estevez in the 7th padded the lead back to four runs for the Drillers and accounted for the eventual final score of 6-2.
- **Battle for 1st...** With 27 games remaining in the regular season, the Cardinals find themselves in 3rd place in the North Division 2nd Half Standings, just 3.0 games behind 1st-place Arkansas and 2.0 games back of 2nd-place Tulsa. The Cardinals are 14-11 in their last 25 games and just closed a 16-12 month of July. Springfield has won four of their last seven series overall and six of their first 10 series since the All-Star Break. The Cardinals have the 2nd-best home record in the league at 33-22, and have gone 9-7 in their last 16 road games.
- **Make it eight...** 2B Irving Lopez extended his hitting streak to eight games with a base hit on Monday and is batting .300 (9x30) during that stretch. Look back a bit further, Lopez has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games, tallying a .279 (16x58) average, two triples, two doubles and eight runs during that stretch.
- **Clean living...** The Cardinals have committed just four miscues in their last 15 games and strung together nine straight games without an error from 7/20-7/29. Springfield has been one of the top fielding teams in the league all season and is currently 2nd with a .984 fielding pct., just one point behind Arkansas (.985). The Cardinals led the Texas League last season with a .982 fielding pct. in 2018.
- **Powering up...** OF Dylan Carlson is back into the league lead with a career-high 18 home runs. The 20 year old also leads the league in runs (78), extra-base hits (46) and total bases (198), while ranking among league leaders in 13 total categories.
- **Scorching start to summer...** INF Yariel Gonzalez was on fire in July, clobbering the ball at a clip of .353 (36x102) with seven home runs, four doubles and a remarkable 30 RBIs in 27 games, the top RBI total in July of any hitter in Minor League Baseball (not counting the Mexican League). He and Carlson tied for 2nd-most home runs in the league during July, just two behind the circuit-leader, former Hooks 1B Seth Beer (9).
- **Tulsa Turnaround...** After going just 4-11 against the Drillers in the 1st half, Springfield is 4-3 against Tulsa in the 2nd half, including an even 2-2 this half at ONEOK Field. The Cardinals have won each of the first two series against the Drillers in the 2nd half, taking a three-game set at home from 7/1-7/3 before winning a three-game series in Tulsa from 7/8-7/10.

Hit safely in all 8G with AAA-Memphis from 6/14-6/23 - .433 (13x30), 2 HR, 7 RBI, 5 2B... Currently ranked by MLB.com as STL #25 prospect... Acquired by STL from Cleveland with OF Jhon Torres for former SPR OF Oscar Mercado on 7/31/18... In 2017 with Low-A Lake County, ranked among Midwest League leaders in HR (22, 3rd), runs (73, t-9th) and triples (7, t-6th)... Has two career 2-HR games, both in 2017 with Lake County... Son of former MLB pitcher Mike Capel, who appeared in 49 games for Cubs (1988), Brewers (1990) and Astros (1991)... Godson of Roger Clemens... 5th round pick in 2016 out of Seven Lakes HS (TX)
