**Tonight's Game:** The San Jose Giants continue their road trip with the opener of a three-game series against the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres affiliate) tonight at The Diamond. This evening marks the first 16 meetings this season between the Giants and the Storm.

**On The Mound:** Casey Meisner is scheduled to get the ball for the Giants in tonight's game. Meisner will be making his San Jose Giants debut after signing with San Francisco as a free agent yesterday. The 23-year old right-hander was released by the St. Louis Cardinals on May 4 after going 0-2 with a 9.78 ERA in 19 1/3 innings for Double-A Springfield. Meisner was a 2017 California League All-Star with the Stockton Ports while in the Oakland A's organization.

**The Giants:** San Jose has won three out of their last four games following a stretch of 10 losses in 12 contests. The Giants opened their current road trip by taking two of three in Modesto. It was San Jose's first series win since sweeping a three-game set at Stockton from April 8-10. Last night's 2-0 victory was the Giants' second shutout of the year. San Jose held Modesto to just one hit.

**Road Success:** The Giants are 9-8 on the road this season compared to a 4-13 mark at Excite Ballpark. San Jose owns a 3.63 team ERA on the road (4.88 at home).

**First Half Midpoint:** The Giants (13-21) reach the midpoint of the first half tonight. San Jose was 21-14 after 35 games last season before finishing with the worst record in the league at 59-81.

**Close Losses:** The Giants are only 1-7 in one-run games this season.

**First Blown Save:** The Giants suffered their first blown save of the season in Wednesday's 7-6 loss to Modesto. San Jose had been the only team in the California League without a blown save this season. Giants relievers own a combined 3.79 ERA this year (starters ERA: 4.97). San Jose is still 12-0 this season when leading after seven innings.

**Injured List:** Five players from San Jose's opening night roster are currently on the injured list: catcher Joey Bart, outfielder Heliot Ramos, third baseman David Villar and pitchers Jose Marte and John Russell. Bart and Ramos are ranked the #1 and #2 prospects in the San Francisco organization respectively by *MLB.com*. Bart last played on April 15 while Ramos' most recent action came on April 24. Marte is the #26 prospect on the list and was San Jose's opening night starter on the mound.

Allowed 10 home runs in 19 1/3 innings pitched ... Gave up 33 hits, walked six and struck out 20 ... Had a .367 opponents batting average.

**Double-A Stints:** Has spent parts of the last three seasons (2017-19) in Double-A ... Has made 22 career starts (25 appearances) in Double-A.

**Cal League Experience:** Has previously pitched in the California League with the Stockton Ports (A's affiliate) during the 2015, 2016 and 2017 seasons ... Made 51 appearances (38 starts) with Stockton combining for a 10-20 record and a 4.26 ERA ... Struck out 204 batters in 224 innings.

**Two-Time All-Star:** Has made two All-Star teams during his professional career ... Was a 2015 South Atlantic League All-Star with the Savannah Sand Gnats ... Also earned midseason California League All-Star honors with Stockton in 2017.

**Traded Twice:** Has been traded twice in his career ... Was traded from the Mets to the Athletics on July 27, 2015 in exchange for pitcher Tyler Clippard ... Was traded again on March 31, 2018 from the Athletics to the Cardinals in exchange for pitcher Josh Lucas.

**Draft Day:** Originally a third round selection of the Mets (84th overall pick) in 2013 out of Cypress Woods High School (Cypress, TX).

#### Current Hit Streak: 4 games

- \* Outfielder is in his seventh professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2012 at age 17.
- \* Spent his third consecutive season with Augusta (A) in 2018 ... Played only 22 games last season (.254, 0 HR, 13 RBI).
- \* Suffered a concussion on May 4 last year while playing LF – collided with CF Heliot Ramos and missed remainder of season.
- \* Batted .292 with one home run and 22 RBI's in 70 games for Augusta in 2017.
- \* Has hit only four home runs during seven-year professional career ... Has never struck out more than 42 times in a season.
