Tonight's Game: The San Jose Giants conclude their three-game series against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Dodgers affiliate) this evening. Sean Hjelle (3-5, 2.78 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound. Rancho Cucamonga posted a 7-5, 11-inning victory in the series opener on Wednesday before the Giants bounced back with a 6-1 win last night.

The Giants: San Jose is looking to win back-to-back series' for the first time since they won three straight series from May 13-23 (vs. Inland Empire, vs. Lake Elsinore, at Modesto). The Giants are 6-10 in their last 16 games overall. San Jose has not won a series at home since taking two of three against Modesto from June 24-26.

At The Plate: Over their last five games, the Giants are batting .323 as a team and averaging 7.6 runs per contest (3-2 record).

Hector Borg At The Helm: Hector Borg was named manager of the San Jose Giants prior to Wednesday's homestand opener. Borg replaced Bill Hayes, who resigned last Saturday. Borg, 34, had been serving as the fundamentals coach for the Giants' Dominican Summer League team this season prior to his appointment in San Jose. Last year, Borg was the manager for the Salem-Keizer Volcanoes (Giants Short-Season affiliate). He also managed the Giants' Arizona Rookie League team in 2017. Borg played three seasons in the San Francisco farm system from 2004-06. See page 6 for more info on Borg.

Ramos Surging: Heliot Ramos is 5-for-7 with two doubles over the first two games of the current series to raise his season batting average to .314. Ramos is fourth in the California League in hitting, second in slugging (.537) and second in OPS (.934). Ramos has hit a team-leading 12 home runs in 61 games with San Jose this season (229 at-bats) after hitting 11 home runs in 124 games with Class-A Augusta in 2018 (485 at-bats). Over his last 18 games, Ramos is batting .403 (31-for-77) with four home runs and 14 RBI's.

Trouble With The Quakes: Over the last three seasons (2017-19), the Giants are only 14-33 against Rancho Cucamonga, including a 8-18 mark at Excite Ballpark. San Jose has lost all three of their previous' series versus the Quakes this season (4-7 record). Tonight marks the 12th and final meeting of the year between the two clubs.

Bart Breaks Out: Joey Bart is 12-for-25 (.480) with four doubles and three home runs in his last five games following a 3-for-27 slump. The former first round draft pick has raised his season batting average 37 points from .234 to .271 over the last five games. Bart went deep twice in last night's victory for his second multi-homer game of the season (June 8 at Stockton).

On Deck: The Giants continue their homestand with a three-game series against the Lancaster JetHawks (Rockies affiliate) tomorrow through Monday. San Jose is 4-2 versus the JetHawks this season.

Tonight's Start: 22-year old right-hander is scheduled to make his 11th start with San Jose this season in tonight's game against Rancho Cucamonga.

Top Prospect: Currently ranked the #5 prospect in the San Francisco Giants organization by *MLB.com* ... Is the second-highest rated pitcher on the list.

6'11" Tall: At 6'11", would tie a record for the tallest player in major league history (Jon Rauch).

San Jose Notes: Is 3-5 with a 2.78 ERA in 10 starts for San Jose ... Has 54 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 55 innings ... Has allowed two or fewer earned runs in eight of his ten starts... Owns a .255 opponents batting average (.221 vs. left, .282 vs. right) ... Giants are only 3-7 in his starts ... Joined the Giants on May 20.

Last Time Out: Pitched six innings with two runs (both earned) allowed in his most recent start on July 13 at Lancaster ... Gave up six hits, walked none and struck out seven ... Threw 85 pitches ... Picked-up the win (Giants won game 17-5).

Cal League Success: Allowed two runs or fewer in six straight starts from June 5-July 3 ... Fashioned a 1.27 ERA (5 ER/35.1 IP) during the six-start stretch.

With Augusta: Began this season with the Class-A Augusta GreenJackets prior to earning a promotion to San Jose ... Made nine starts for Augusta and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA ... Struck out 44 batters compared to just nine walks in 40 2/3 innings ... Allowed two earned runs or fewer in seven out of his nine starts.

Draft Day: Was selected in the second round by the San Francisco Giants in the 2018 draft (45th overall pick).

At Kentucky: Pitched three years at the University of Kentucky from 2016-18 ... Ranks fifth in school history in career wins (22) and ninth in strikeouts (222) ... Had a career ERA of 3.68 over 54 appearances (31 starts).

SEC Pitcher Of The Year: Was the 2017 SEC Pitcher of the Year during his sophomore season ... Fashioned an 11-4 record with a 3.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) ... 11 wins were tied for fourth on Kentucky's single-season list ... Went 7-1 with a 1.90 ERA in conference play ... Became the first player in Kentucky history to win SEC Pitcher of the Year ... Was also a Second Team All-American during the season.

Other College Notes: Was on the SEC Academic Honor Roll ... Served as Kentucky's closer as a freshman in 2016 ... Collected eight saves, a Kentucky freshman record and tied for third on the school's single-season list ... Earned Mr. Wildcat honors in 2018, the highest award given to a male student-athlete at Kentucky.

High School: Attended Mahtomedi High School ... Earned three letters in baseball and four in basketball.

In The Family: Older sister, Mara, played basketball at Wayne State and professionally in Finland and Germany.
