Tonight's Game: The San Jose Giants begin their final series of the regular season tonight when they open a four-game set against the Stockton Ports (A's affiliate) at Excite Ballpark. Matt Frisbee (9-8, 3.34 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound. The Giants are 12-14 versus the Ports this season, including a 3-7 mark in the South Bay. San Jose has won the last five head-to-head meetings between the teams.

Eight Wins In A Row: The Giants enter tonight's contest riding a season-high eight-game winning streak. San Jose owns a +35 run differential during the win streak (51-16). It's the Giants' longest win streak since claiming eight in a row from May 19-27, 2015. The longest win streak in San Jose Giants team history is 12 games (accomplished twice during the 2011 season).

Back-To-Back Sweeps: San Jose has posted back-to-back series sweeps. The Giants swept a four-game set in Stockton to complete their most recent road trip. It marked San Jose's first four-game road sweep of the season. The Giants then returned home and swept a three-game set from first-place Visalia. It was the first time this season the Rawhide had been swept in a series.

Pitching Shines: The Giants pitching staff has fashioned a 1.88 ERA during their current eight-game winning streak. San Jose relievers have pitched 30 2/3 innings and allowed only two runs (0.59 ERA) during the eight-game stretch.

Wild Card Race: The Giants (64-71) are 1 1/2 games ahead of Modesto (63-73) in the North Division wild card race with four games remaining in the regular season. San Jose's magic number (combination of Giants wins & Nuts losses) to clinch a playoff spot is three. The Giants last reached the playoffs in 2016. San Jose has never missed the postseason three straight years in their team history (1988-2019). The Giants (34-32) are also still alive in the second half race as they currently sit three games behind Visalia (37-29) for the top spot in the North Division.

Homer Happy: The Giants have hit 13 home runs over their last seven games. San Jose's 111 home runs this season rank fourth in the California League. Individually, Courtney Hawkins has five home runs over his last five games. Hawkins matched a San Jose Giants single-game record when he homered three times last Sunday in Stockton.

Matheny Mashing: Shane Matheny had three more hits yesterday and is now 14-for-23 (.609 AVG) with three home runs and nine RBI's in his last five games (after starting 2-for-18 with San Jose). Matheny hit the Giants' first grand slam of the season in last Sunday's game at Stockton and then hit the club's first leadoff homer of the year yesterday against Visalia.

Arizona Fall League Rosters Announced: Major League Baseball announced rosters for the Arizona Fall League earlier this week. Current San Jose pitchers Tristan Beck and Frank Rubio will play in the AFL beginning next month. Former San Jose players Joey Bart, Jacob Heyward, Jalen Miller and Heliot Ramos are also among the SF Giants minor leaguers who will participate. The Arizona Fall League season runs from September 18-October 26.

Hector Borg At The Helm: Hector Borg was named manager of the San Jose Giants on July 17 replacing Bill Hayes, who resigned four days earlier. Borg, 34, had been serving as the fundamentals coach for the Giants' Dominican Summer League team this season prior to his appointment in San Jose. Last year, Borg was the manager for the Salem-Keizer Volcanoes (Giants Short-Season affiliate). He also managed the Giants' Arizona Rookie League team in 2017. Borg played three seasons in the San Francisco farm system from 2004-06. San Jose is 23-17 since Borg took over as manager (41-54 before). See page 6 for more info on Borg.

Tonight's Start: 22-year old right-hander is slated to make his 20th start and 22nd overall appearance with San Jose this season in tonight's game against Stockton ... Is 2-2 with a 3.60 ERA in four starts against the Ports.

San Jose Notes: Is 9-8 with a 3.34 ERA for San Jose ... Has 125 strikeouts and only 20 walks in 110 1/3 innings pitched ... Nine wins leads the team ... Also tops on the staff in strikeouts ... Has a .235 opponents batting average (.218 vs. right, .265 vs. left) ... Has not walked more than two batters in any start.

Cal League Ranks: Is third in the California League in ERA (3.34), tied for fifth in wins (9) and sixth in strikeouts (125) ... 1.08 WHIP is lowest in the league among qualified pitchers.

Trending Up: Is 4-1 with a 1.47 ERA (6 ER/36.2 IP) over his last six starts.

Last Time Out: Faced Stockton in his most recent start on August 25 at Banner Island Ballpark ... Pitched five innings with one run allowed ... Scattered six hits, walked one and struck out seven ... Picked-up the win (Giants won game 15-1).

Scoreless Inning Streak: Had a 25-inning scoreless streak that spanned five starts earlier this season (July 21-August 14) ... Is the longest scoreless inning streak by a Giants pitcher this season (team record is 36) ... Also had a 17-inning scoreless streak in May.

Strikeouts: Has had three starts with double-digit strikeout totals this season (11 SO – August 7 at Lake Elsinore, 10 SO – May 26 at Visalia, 10 SO – May 31 at Lake Elsinore).

Pitcher Of The Week X2: Has twice been named California League Pitcher of the Week ... Won the award on May 13 after tossing six scoreless innings with one hit allowed on May 9 at Modesto (retired 18 of 19 batters) ... Won the award a second time August 12 after striking out a career-high 11 over seven scoreless innings on August 7 at Lake Elsinore.

Early-Season Promotion: Began the year with the Class-A Augusta GreenJackets before joining San Jose on April 28 ... Made four appearances (two starts) with Augusta and was 0-1 with a 2.81 ERA over 16 innings.

Season Stats: Has struck out 148 batters compared to 26 walks in 126 1/3 innings pitched between San Jose and Augusta this year (3.28 ERA).

Draft Day: Was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 15th round of the 2018 draft.

UNC Greensboro: Played three seasons at UNC Greensboro (2016-18) ... Was 23-9 with a 4.14 ERA in 47 games (46 starts) during collegiate career.

Awards: Was the 2018 Southern Conference Pitcher of the Year during his junior season ... Was 10-2 with a 3.45 ERA in 15 starts ... Became the fifth pitcher in UNCG history to record 100 strikeouts in a season (116 SO in 91 1/3 innings) ... Was named to the Southern Conference All-Freshman Team in 2016.
