**RHP Tony Gonsolin (0-1, 6.14 ERA) vs. RHP Brandon Gold (3-1, 4.70 ERA)**

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes continue a three-game road series with the Lancaster JetHawks (Colorado Rockies affiliate) tonight at The Hangar. After this three-game series, the Quakes return to LoanMart Field on Monday, facing Modesto for four straight games.

**VS LANCASTER:** This is the sixth of 28 overall meetings between the two clubs and the sixth of 15 match-ups at The Hangar. The Quakes have taken three of the first five meetings in Lancaster this year, including two of three just last week in their first series of the year. Last season, Lancaster won the season series (15-14) and also knocked Rancho out of the playoffs in the South Division Finals.

**LAST TIME OUT:** A three-run sixth inning for Lancaster proved the difference maker, as the Quakes fell to the JetHawks by a score of 6-5 on Friday night at The Hangar. Gavin Lux had three hits and Cristian Santana along with Logan Landon homered in the game. Landon's second home run of the season gave the Quakes a 5-3 lead in the top of the sixth. Reliever Ryan Moseley (1-1) was hit with the loss after surrendering the lead in the home sixth, allowing three runs (two earned) over 1.2 innings out of the bullpen for Rancho. JetHawks' reliever Alexander Guillen (1-0) pitched a perfect 1.1 innings in relief of starting pitcher Logan Longwith and was credited with the win.

**BANNON CAN FLY AT THE HANGAR:** Third baseman Rylan Bannon homered again on Friday night, giving him four home runs in his last three games at The Hangar. On April 18th, Bannon smashed a franchise record-tying three homers against the JetHawks. Bannon, who finished Friday night with two RBIs, now has the second most in the California League (20) only trailing fellow teammate Cristian Santana (21). His eight home runs are also tied with teammate Connor Wong at the top of the Cal League.

**D-LUX:** Gavin Lux recorded his fourth three-hit game of the year in last night's loss to Lancaster. Lux has now raised his average to .305, a season-best, after hitting safely in nine of his last ten games. Last season, Lux hit just .244 with seven bombs and 39 RBIs in 111 games for Great Lakes.

**JOIN THE HIT PARADE:** The Quakes rallied for 14 hits on Thursday night against Stockton and socked a season-high 16 on Friday against Lancaster. Rancho has now raised their season-long batting average to .271, second in the league behind only Lancaster (.276).

**CURRENT STREAKS:** Cristian Santana homered last night to push his current hit streak to nine games (11-for-35), a team-high for Rancho this year. Other Quakes on streaks include Rylan Bannon, who's hit in six straight (6-for-24) and has homered in four of his last six games overall. Donovan Casey saw a seven-game hit streak come to a close on Saturday going 0-for-4.

**12 ROSTER MOVES IN TWO DAYS:** RHP Walker Buehler was assigned to the Rancho roster in a paper move on Friday, but has been transferred back to the Dodgers Saturday. Buehler is the top prospect in the Dodgers system and made the start in game one of the double-header at San Francisco on Saturday. James Carter and Jeremiah Muhammad were both transferred to Rancho Cucamonga from Extended Spring Training in Arizona on Friday, but have also been returned to the Extended Spring roster after pitching Friday in Lancaster. Parker Curry and Sven Schueller were sent to the Extended Spring Training roster from Rancho Cucamonga on Friday, but Schueller returned to the Rancho roster Saturday. Joining Schueller on the active roster is RHP Evy Ruibal, who earned a one-out save for the Quakes in their opening home stand against Inland Empire for his only appearance so far this year. Also joining the Quakes Saturday was LHP Justin Hoyt. Both join Rancho from Extended Spring. In addition, Saige Jenco went on the temporarily inactive list on Friday.

**GONSOLIN GOES:** Tony Gonsolin looks for his first win of the year today, as he makes his fifth start of the year and second against the JetHawks. In his only start against Lancaster, he allowed two runs on three hits over 3.1 innings in a no-decision on 4/18. In his last outing overall, Gonsolin allowed five runs (four earned) on eight hits over 4.1 innings in a loss to Stockton on 4/24. Gonsolin has given up 10 runs over 14.2 innings this year, but has yet to surrender a home-run to opposing hitters. Last season, he split time between Great Lakes of the Midwest League (0-1, 3.38 ERA, 3G) and Rancho Cucamonga (7-5, 3.92 ERA, 19). A former seventh-round pick in the 2016 draft, he played collegiately at the University of Saint Mary's in the West Coast Conference.

**OPPOSING PITCHER:** Brandon Gold will make his fifth start of the year for the JetHawks and his second against Rancho. In his last outing overall, allowed no runs on four hits over seven innings in a win at Visalia on 4/24. Gold's only loss this season was against Rancho on 4/18 where he allowed five runs on eight hits over five innings. Last season, split time between Asheville of the South Atlantic League (4-5, 4.33 ERA, 13 GS) and Lancaster (4-3, 4.40 ERA, 12 G, 12 GS). Drafted by Colorado in 12th round of 2016 draft out of Georgia Tech.
