**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes continue their five-game road trip as they take on the Inland Empire 66ers (Los Angeles Angels affiliate) in the fourth game of the series on Monday night. This series is the first of two straight (the only two in 2019) five-game series, with Rancho wrapping up the set on Tuesday, then opening up a five-gamer at home against Lake Elsinore on Wednesday.

**VS INLAND EMPIRE:** This is the 15th of 30 total meetings between the two clubs in 2019. The Quakes took three of four just last weekend at LoanMart Field. Now, with three straight wins in the current series, Rancho has posted a 10-4 mark over the Sixers in the first 14 games. Dating back to the 2018 season, the Quakes hold a dominating record of 32-11 versus Inland Empire.

**THIRD STRAIGHT WIN:** On Sunday afternoon, the Quakes scored their third straight win, defeating Inland Empire by a final of 5-3 at San Manuel Stadium in San Bernardino. The Rancho bullpen fired four innings of one-hit scoreless baseball, with Connor Strain, Austin Drury and Connor Mitchell (first save) combining to shut out the 66ers. Josiah Gray (3-0) was sharp through the first five innings in earning his third straight win, but an error tarnished his line a bit (5IP, 7H, 3R, 1ER, 1BB, 9K). Inland Empire starter Dean Brady (2-6) was hit with the loss, allowing four runs (one earned) on five hits over five innings. Starling Heredia went deep for Rancho (his fifth), while six different Quakes recorded one hit each for a total of six hits on the day. The win puts Rancho's record at a season-best 13 games over .500 for the first time all year at 37-24.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Quakes won their third straight game on the road last night, improving to an incredible 23-10 away from LoanMart Field in 2019. Last year, the Quakes won a franchise-record 42 games on the road, finishing at 42-28.

**JETER LEADS THE WAY:** The Quakes' shortstop propelled his squad to their 36th win of the 2019 season with a productive night at the plate on Saturday. Downs put together a 2-for-5 performance, with 4 RBI, including a three-run-homer in the second and the RBI single in the sixth. After hitting just .213 in the month of April, Downs turned it up in May, producing a .272 average at the plate. So far in June, the Colombia native is hitting .276 with three jacks and eight RBI in just seven games.

**GOODBYE LANCASTER:** With Rancho's third straight win on Sunday, coupled with Lake Elsinore's third straight win over Lancaster, the Quakes have eliminated the JetHawks from first-half playoff contention. The Quakes' lead over the second-place Lake Elsinore Storm remains at five games with just seven to play, leaving Rancho's magic number to clinch the South Division at three. Any combination of three Rancho wins or three Lake Elsinore losses over the next seven days would give the Quakes their fifth consecutive playoff appearance. The earliest they can clinch is Tuesday night in San Bernardino.

**QUAKES DIG THE LONG BALL:** With another home run on Sunday, the Quakes have blasted 13 homers in eight games in the month of June. Additionally, Starling Heredia's solo-shot on Sunday extended Rancho's homer streak to eight straight games.

**BUDDING STARS IN RANCHO:** On Friday, the California League announced All-Stars for the North and South Division, with seven Rancho Cucamonga Quakes voted to the mid-season squad. Starting will be Jeter Downs (SS) and Devin Mann (3B), while Connor Wong (C), Donovan Casey (OF), Logan Salow (RP) and Wills Montgomerie (RP) are expected to come off the bench. Edwin Uceta, who was recently promoted to AA Tulsa, was named to the team, but will not play due to the promotion. The 2019 All-Star Game will be held at San Manuel Stadium in San Bernardino on Tuesday, June 18th. Tickets are available at IE66ers.com.

**ANDRE JACKSON:** RHP Andre Jackson makes just his second Cal League start and first against Inland Empire. In his debut on June 5th, a loss against the Lancaster JetHawks, he allowed just two earned runs on four hits over six innings, with nine strikeouts and two walks. For Great Lakes of the Midwest League in 2019, Jackson went 4-1 with a 2.23 ERA with 50 strikeouts in 48.1 innings and ten starts. Was recently named to the 2019 Midwest League All-Star Team. Jackson played collegiately at Utah and was drafted by the Dodgers in the 12th round of the 2018 Draft.

**DENNY BRADY:** RHP Travis Herrin makes his ninth appearance, fifth start and second appearance against Rancho. In his only outing against the Quakes, he allowed eight runs on eight hits over just 1.2 innings in a no-decision in relief on May 30th at LoanMart Field. In his last outing overall, he allowed three runs on six hits over 4.1 innings in a no-decision versus Lake Elsinore on June 5th. In 2018, made three appearances with one start for Inland Empire, going 0-2 with an ERA of 3.00. Drafted out of Wabash College in Indiana in the 18th round of the 2015 Draft.

**BEATY BACK WITH RC:** On Sunday, Dodgers INF Matt Beaty was assigned to the Rancho roster as part of a Major League Rehab Assignment. On the shelf with a left hip flexor strain, Beaty drove in the tying run on Sunday and also scored the go-ahead run. He's not in today's lineup, but is still on the Rancho roster. All Dodgers' rehabbers are sponsored by San Manuel Casino.
