TODAY'S GAME: Game No. 100 of the 2019 season is set for a 7:10 PM first pitch against the Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics affiliate), as Rancho closes out a three-game set at Banner Island Ballpark. After Monday's ballgame, concluding a six-game road trip, the Quakes will head back home to open a six-game home stand, starting with a matchup against Inland Empire.

VS STOCKTON: This is the 10th of 16 total meetings between the Quakes and the Ports and the seventh of 10 games to be played at Banner Island Ballpark. So far in 2019, Rancho holds the advantage over Stockton, taking six out of the nine tilts. The last time these two clubs squared off from July 13th to the 15th, the Ports snatched two out of three from the Quakes at LoanMart Field. However, with back-to-back wins on Saturday and Sunday, Rancho has their first opportunity in three tries this year to sweep Stockton.

RANCHO LOVIN' LIFE IN THE 2019: For the second-straight night, the Quakes (60-39, 19-12) dominated the Ports (48-51, 15-16), winning by a final score of 10-2. Relatively new member of Rancho's roster, Hunter Feduccia produced a breakout night on Sunday, with a 3-for-4 performance and 4 RBI. Five other Quakes had at least one RBI on the evening, as they have scored 19 runs in their last two outings. Michael Grove went three scoreless, while Austin Hamilton (4-2) earned the win with two runs across four innings. Stockton SP, Xavier Altamirano (5-6) shouldered the loss, surrendering six runs (five earned) in five innings.

FIVE-STRAIGHT IN THE 209: On the 2019 season's opening night, the Quakes fell to the Ports by a final score of 4-1 at Banner Island Ballpark. Since then, thanks to taking the final three games of that opening set and with wins on Saturday and Sunday, Rancho has won five consecutive games in Stockton. In that stretch, the Boys in Blue are outscoring Stockton 32-11.

EVERY MONTH IS A WINNING MONTH: Despite their most recent 3-3 home stand and losing two out of three to the Giants coming into the series at Stockton, Rancho is still playing some of their best baseball of 2019. In the month of July, the Quakes are playing to the tune of a 15-5 record. They kicked off the month with a nine-game win streak and made it to a season-high 22 games over the .500 mark, following a win over this Stockton squad on July 13th. With still 9 games left this month and a win last night, Rancho clinched their fourth-straight winning month (April: 16-10, May: 15-12, June: 14-12).

FORE, CAL LEAGUE!: Donovan Casey has been red-hot this month, inserting himself into serious consideration of the Cal League MVP. In July, Casey is hitting .324 (23-for-71) with 16 RBI, five doubles, four jacks and two three-baggers. After last night's 1-for-5 performance against Stockton, the Stratford, NJ native is slashing .280/.346/.520 with 59 RBI, 18 doubles 17 home runs and eight triples in a team-high 354 at-bats.

FOUR RBI, ONE SWING: Jeter Downs' grand slam in Saturday night's win was his second salami of the campaign. His first slam came 12 games into the season on April 18th, serving as his first overall home run as a Dodgers farm hand. Fast forward to July 21st, where the Colombia native has 15 jacks (second most on the team) and 60 RBI (most on the team). On Saturday, Downs fell a triple shy of the cycle, going 3-for-5 with two runs scored.

GERARDO CARRILLO: The Guadalajara, Mexico native, RHP Gerardo Carrillo toes the slab for Rancho on Monday night, making his 14th start and 15th overall appearance on the year. In 2019, Carrillo has pitched to a 2-5 record with a 6.15 ERA. Carrillo's last start came on the July 17th, against San Jose, as he tossed two scoreless innings, allowing two hits, while notching two strikeouts. In an eventual 7-5 win for the Quakes, the right-hander was saddled with a no-decision. Monday evening's start against the Ports marks his second career start against the ball club, and second career start at Banner Island Ballpark. The Los Angeles Dodgers signed Carrillo as an International Free Agent on July 5, 2016.

BRYCE CONLEY: Right-hander Bryce Conley makes his third start and fourth overall appearance of the year for Stockton in game three of the series. In his last outing versus Lancaster (July 17th) he earned the win, allowing one run on three hits over six innings in a 5-1 victory over the JetHawks. Monday evening's start will be his first career outing against Rancho, as it is his first stint in the California League. The Alpharetta, GA native has a 2-0 record, accompanied by a 2.08 ERA with Stockton so far in his third professional season. Conley was drafted by Oakland out of Georgia State University in the 22nd round of the 2017 draft.

ROSTER MOVES: On Monday, the Quakes were active making a few more moves, as LHP Austin Hamilton was placed on the Injured List and C Chase Barbary was transferred back to the Arizona League Dodgers. Coming to the Rancho roster via promotion, C Tre Todd and RHP Melvin Jimenez, as Todd comes from Great Lakes while Jimenez comes from Ogden.
