TODAY'S GAME: It's not only Thirsty Thursday tonight, with \$2 Pepsi products, \$3 Domestic Drafts and \$4 Premium Drafts, Wine and Margaritas, but it's also the first of three Viva Los Temblores Nights as the Quakes will transform into Los Temblores de Rancho Cucamonga as part of MiLB's Copa de la Diversion initiative. Los Temblores are set to take on Los Cadejos de Lake Elsinore (San Diego Padres affiliate) in their 28th game of 2019, set for a 7:05 PM first pitch. The next matchup on the schedule for Rancho Cucamonga calls for their second trip up North in as many weekends as they will visit Los Gigantes de San Jose for a three-game set.

VS LOS CADEJOS: This is the seventh of 30 total meetings between Los Temblores and Los Cadejos this season and the fourth of 15 games to be played at LoanMart Field. So far this year, Rancho Cucamonga swept a three-game set at The Diamond in Lake Elsinore from April 15th to April 17th in what was the first series of the year. Los Temblores have continued their winning ways at home with three straight victories over Los Cadejos, looking for a four-game sweep on Thursday. They walked-off Lake Elsinore on Monday night, winning 3-2 in 10 innings, following that up with back-to-back 8-3 defeats of Los Cadejos on Tuesday and Wednesday. Last season, Los Temblores dominated Los Cadejos, posting a 21-10 record, going 11-6 at home and 10-4 at The Diamond.

TRES CONSECUTIVOS: For the sixth time in as many tries in 2019, Los Temblores de Rancho Cucamonga (17-10) defeated Los Cadejos de Lake Elsinore (11-16), winning by a final score of 8-3 on Wednesday evening. Drew Avans led the charge offensively as he put Los Temblores up for good in the bottom of the second inning with a line-drive, two-run shot for his first career Cal League jack. On the bump, RHP Edwin Uceta (1-0) pieced together the best line by a Temblores starting pitcher for his first career win in a Rancho Cucamonga uniform. Uceta finished six innings of one run baseball, allowing only three hits with eight strikeouts and a zero in the walks column. Los Cadejos SP Luis Patino (1-3) was saddled with the defeat, allowing three runs (two earned) across four innings.

MUY CALIENTE: In their last 16 contests, Los Temblores are 12-4 to put them at a season-high seven games above the .500 mark. Rancho Cucamonga now has a three-game lead in the Cal League South Division standings over the Lancaster JetHawks.

DEVIN HOMBRE: With his first three-hit showing of the season on Wednesday night, Devin Mann is filling the stat sheet so far in this three-game set with Lake Elsinore. Mann is 5-for-12 overall with four runs scored, two RBI, two walks and a double.

BRYAN WARZEK: The southpaw, LHP Bryan Warzek, will start for a sixth time this season and his second time against Los Cadejos. So far in 2019, Warzek has recorded a bloated 5.82 ERA, allowing 11 earned runs across 17 innings with 23 strikeouts and a team-high 19 base-on-balls. The Clifton Park, NY native's last appearance was against the Modesto Nuts on April 27th, where Los Temblores were victorious in a 4-3 final score. Warzek hurled four scoreless innings, surrendering three hits, three walks, with five strikeouts in what was one of his better starts on the 2019 campaign. His last start against Lake Elsinore came in an 8-3 win on April 16th, where he tossed five hitless and scoreless innings, with four free-passes and a career-high eight punchouts. The Dodgers drafted Warzek out of the University of New Orleans in the sixth round of the 2018 draft.

RONALD BOLAÑOS: RHP Ronald Bolaños gets the call for Los Cadejos as the starting pitcher in Thursday night's contest, making his fifth start of the year and his first start against Rancho Cucamonga in 2019. Bolaños is a familiar foe of this Rancho Cucamonga ballclub, tallying his sixth career start against Los Temblores. The Cuba native's last appearance resulted in a no-decision on April 26th in an eventual 2-1 victory over the Inland Empire 66ers. Bolaños chucked six strong innings of one run baseball on three hits, tacking on six strikeouts and just one walk. The start was Bolaños' second straight quality start as tossed a season-high 7.1 innings two starts ago with just two earned runs. Three out of the right-hander's four starts have come against Inland Empire in 2019. Bolaños was signed as an International Free Agent by the Friars of San Diego on August 11, 2016.

TEMBLORES WATCH: According to MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Prospects for the Dodgers, Los Temblores have seven Top 30 Prospects on their roster. The list includes INF Jeter Downs (No. 7), C Connor Wong (No. 13), RHP Michael Grove (No. 14), OF Jeren Kendall (No. 15), RHP Gerardo Carrillo (No. 18), RHP Edwin Uceta (No. 20) and OF Carlos Rincon (No. 30).

CADEJOS WATCH: According to MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Prospects for the Padres, Los Cadejos have seven Top 30 Prospects on their roster. The list includes LHP MacKenzie Gore (No. 2), RHP Luis Patino (No. 6), OF Tiroso Ornelas (No. 16), C Luis Campusano (No. 18), OF Jeisson Rosario (No. 22), INF Gabriel Arias (No. 25) and INF Esteury Ruiz (No. 27).

ROSTER MOVES: On Wednesday, May 1st, Los Temblores sent C Tre Todd to Extended Spring Training in Arizona and brought back C Stevie Berman to the Rancho Cucamonga roster from the Tulsa Drillers (AA). On Thursday, May 2nd, Rancho Cucamonga sent LHP Austin Hamilton to Extended Spring Training, promoting RHP Kevin Malisheski from the Great Lakes Loons (A).
