## RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (27-19) AT Lancaster JetHawks (25-21)

RHP Edwin Uceta (2-0, 1.85 ERA) vs. RHP Garrett Schilling (2-2, 5.40 ERA)



**TODAY'S GAME:** Today is the second game of a three-game road series between the Quakes and the Colorado Rockies Cal League affiliate, the Lancaster JetHawks. Following an off-day on Monday, May 27th, the Quakes will continue their road trip, opening a three-game set with a doubleheader matchup on Tuesday versus the Lake Elsinore Storm at The Diamond.

**VS LANCASTER:** This is the tenth of 28 total meetings between the Quakes and the JetHawks this season and the sixth of 14 games to be played at The Hangar. Despite winning three out of four in their last series (5/13-5/16), the Quakes are just 3-6 against Lancaster this year, as the JetHawks swept a four-game series at LoanMart Field in early-April. In the regular season last year, Rancho posted a 17-11 record against the JetHawks, going 11-2 on their home turf and 6-9 at Lancaster.

**THE ONE THAT GOT AWAY:** For the first time since Tuesday night, the Quakes (27-19) played a baseball game, in which they dropped game one of an important three-game series by a final score of 8-6 to the JetHawks (25-21). Rancho seized their first lead in the top of the sixth inning, after tying the game on two separate occasions earlier in Friday night's contest. Carrying that two-run lead into the bottom of the eighth inning, the Quakes called upon Sven Schueller (2-2) to maintain the slim cushion. Unfortunately, the potent Lancaster offense roughed up Schueller for his second loss of the year with four earned runs, as he was only able to record one out. The win went to JetHawks' RP Austin Moore (3-0) as he walked two, but struck out two in a scoreless inning in the eighth. Salvador Justo tallied his sixth save of the year, locking things down in the top of the ninth with a 1-2-3 frame. An offensive bright spot for Rancho last night was Donovan Casey, who went 2-for-4 with a single and RBI double on the night.

**CUT DOWN TO TWO:** The late-inning victory for the JetHawks slimmed down the Quakes lead in the South to just two games. Lancaster has been hovering in second place for quite some time now, never holding a share of first place at any point in 2019.

Rancho moved into a first-place tie on April 17th and has been alone in first since they were 10-8 on April 18th. Following this three-game set, the Quakes will welcome the JetHawks to LoanMart Field from June 4th to June 6th for another pivotal three-gamer just prior to the end of the first half. Also within striking distance is Lake Elsinore, who are just 3.5 games back of first, having won three games in a row and seven of their last 10 games. The Quakes' next opponent just so happens to be the Storm, starting on Tuesday.

**SOLID STARTERS:** Over their last nine games, the Rancho starting pitching staff has recorded a 3.02 ERA (15 ER in 44.2 innings). During this stretch, not one Quakes' starter has allowed more than three earned runs in an outing.

**BLAST OFF:** The Quakes have smashed 51 homers in 46 games this season, the best mark in all of the Cal League by 12. Next on that list is Lancaster (39), who leads the league in hitting at .271. Despite a homerless effort in game one on Friday night, the Quakes have blasted seven home runs in their last four games at The Hangar. They clubbed a franchise-best 202 last season.

**.500 BASEBALL:** After posting a 16-10 record in the month of April, the Quakes are playing to a 11-9 record so far in May, winning no more than two games in a row. Furthermore, Rancho is just 8-8 in their last sixteen games.

**RAIN RAIN GO AWAY:** The Cal League scheduling committee has been busy the past week as rare, late-May rain has postponed at least one game throughout the league in four out of the last six game days. In that span, a total of 14 games were postponed or suspended. Yesterday marked just the second day in the last six days in which all Cal League teams were in action.

**EDWIN UCETA:** The Dominican Republic native, RHP Edwin Uceta, will take the ball for Rancho in game two of the series for his ninth start of 2019. Uceta has posted a 2-0 record accompanied by a stellar 1.85 ERA so far in his fourth professional season. The last appearance for Uceta, on May 17th, resulted in a no-decision, as he surrendered three runs (one earned) in 5.2 innings in an eventual 10-3 loss to Modesto. In his last three starts, Uceta has tossed a combined 17.2 innings, allowing eight hits and four runs (two earned) with 23 strikeouts and just one walk. The right-hander has yet to face the JetHawks' Cal League-leading offense this season. The Dodgers inked Uceta as an International Free Agent on July 2, 2016.

**GARRETT SCHILLING:** The Clawson, MI native, RHP Garrett Schilling takes the ball for Lancaster for his seventh start of the year. Schilling has recorded a 5.40 ERA with a 2-2 record in 26.2 innings, giving up 18 runs (16 earned) on 33 hits. The right-hander's last start came on May 15th against the Quakes, where he posted a final line of three innings that featured four runs (three earned) on six hits, including two homers. The JetHawks were blown out by the Quakes in that contest by a final score of 18-8 and Schilling shouldered his second loss of 2019. The Colorado Rockies used their 18th round pick on Schilling in 2017.

**ROSTER MOVES:** On Friday, May 24th, C Jordan Procyshen was activated off the Injured List, with C Ramon Rodriguez sent back to XST in AZ. On Thursday, May 23rd, RHP Ryan Moseley was promoted to AA Tulsa as OF Jeren Kendall was activated from the IL. On Wednesday, May 22nd, INF Brandon Montgomery was placed on the IL as INF Deacon Liput was activated from the IL.
