LAST GAME:

RICHMOND, VA --- Lefty Ryan Bollinger went a season-high eight innings allowing one unearned run to lead the Thunder to a 6-4 win over the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Saturday night at The Diamond.

The Flying Squirrels managed just three hits and one walk against the Thunder starter across his eight innings. They got their only run in the eighth inning when an error by second baseman Bruce Caldwell extended the frame and allowed Ronnie Jebavy to single in a run. Bollinger had strings of eight and 11 straight batters retired during his outing.

The Thunder broke through against Richmond starter Garrett Williams with a pair of runs in the fourth inning to take the early lead in support of their starter. Taking advantage of some wildness from the Flying Squirrels starter, Trenton loaded the bases with nobody out. Chace Numata plated the game's first run with a groundout to the shortstop. After Williams' fifth walk, the Squirrels turned to the bullpen and summoned Dan Slania. With two out, Abiatal Avelino beat out an infield single to score Caldwell and give the Thunder a 2-0 lead.

In the fifth inning, Mandy Alvarez doubled to left-center off of Slania with one out in the frame. After a wild pitch allowed Alvarez to advance to third, Caldwell singled over a drawn-in infield to make it 3-0. The Thunder extended their lead to 6-0 with three runs in the top of the eighth. With the bases loaded and nobody out, Trey Amburgey doubled in a pair with a shot to left-center. Abiatal Avelino followed him with a run-scoring groundout to score Gosuke Katoh and give the Thunder the commanding advantage.

Richmond staged a late rally with the unearned run off Bollinger in the eighth and three runs off of Andrew Schwaab in the ninth. However, Kaleb Ort entered with two out in the ninth inning and struck out KC Hobson with a man on third to secure the 6-4 win.

THUNDER CLAPS:

GO WEST, YOUNG MEN: The Thunder are in the midst of a 19-game stretch in which they will face only Western Division teams. Following the series with the Flying Squirrels, Trenton will face Akron and Bowie on a seven-game homestand, followed by a two-city road trip to Akron and Erie to round out the Western tour.

BOLLIN': Lefty Ryan Bollinger tossed a season-high eight innings in his second start for the Thunder, setting a new season-high for innings pitched in a game by a Trenton starter. The southpaw limited the Flying Squirrels to one unearned run on three hits and a walk, also matching his season-best with five strikeouts.

GREATEST HITS: The Thunder rapped out 13 hits in Saturday's win, a new season-high. Of the 13 hits, four went for extra bases, all doubles. Five Trenton players recorded multi-hit games, while just one player, Chris Gittens, went hitless in the contest.

STREAK OVER: In his return to the Thunder lineup following a brief three-game stint at triple-A, Bruce Caldwell went 0-for-4 in Friday's game, ending his team-leading on-base streak at 14 games. It also saw a six-game hitting streak, his longest of the season, come to an end.

GOING NUTS: Of the four Western Division teams the Thunder have faced this season, Richmond is the only team against which Trenton has a losing record, having lost four of the seven matchups. The Thunder have lost three of their last four games against the Flying Squirrels, going back to the season-opening series in Trenton, which ended with a 3-2 loss in 10 innings on April 8.

BATTLING BACK: Yankees third baseman Brandon Drury played in six rehab games for the Thunder during the last homestand, after having his rehab assignment transferred from triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. In 14 total rehab games, Drury is batting .333, including 5-for-19 in a Thunder uniform with a home run and two RBI. Drury played in just eight games with the Yankees early this season, batting .217 before being placed on the Major League disabled list with migraines and blurred vision.

EASTERN LEAGUE ALL-STAR CLASSIC RETURNS TO TRENTON: The 25th season in franchise history will be punctuated with ARM & HAMMER Park hosting an All-Star game for the third time in franchise history. Tuesday, July 10 will feature a special baseball game between the New York and Philadelphia Police Departments and the Case's Pork Roll Home Run Derby. Wednesday, July 11 will see the East and West face-off with former Yankees star Bernie Williams performing the National Anthem and the Budweiser Clydesdales leading the teams onto the field. 
