LAST GAME:

Despite building an early lead and fighting back from a two-run deficit, the Thunder dropped the final game of the four-game series to the Bowie Baysox, 10-5, on Sunday afternoon at ARM & HAMMER Park.

Gosuke Katoh homered off Bowie starter Hunter Harvey in the first inning, and the Thunder added two runs in the fourth on a Ben Ruta RBI-single and a delayed steal of home by Jhalan Jackson. But after four scoreless innings by Trenton starter Michael King in his double-A debut, the Baysox sent 10 men to the plate in the fifth inning, rallying ahead for five runs on six hits against the right-hander.

Trailing 5-3, the Thunder got a leadoff walk from Ryan Lidge, and two batters later, Chris Gittens launched a game-tying two-run home run to left field off right-hander Branden Kline. After both teams failed to score in the sixth and seventh, however, the Baysox broke the 5-5 tie in the eighth, as Andrew Schwaab issued a leadoff walk to Bowie's Ryan Mountcastle, who scored on a double by Ademar Rifaela. Four more runs crossed the plate in the inning on a pair of doubles and a sacrifice fly.

Kline, Luis Gonzalez and Tanner Chleborad combined to hold the Thunder scoreless over their final four innings at the plate, as Trenton managed just one hit during the span.

The loss ended a four-game winning streak for the Thunder, and allowed Bowie to avoid a series sweep.

2018 EASTERN LEAGUE STANDINGS

THUNDER CLAPS:

GO WEST, YOUNG MEN: The Thunder are amid a 19-game stretch in which they face only Western Division teams. Following a road series with Richmond and a seven-game homestand against Akron and Bowie, Trenton now faces the RubberDucks on the first leg of a two-city road trip, which finishes Monday in the closing game of a four-game set in Erie.

WHEN THE LEVEE BREAKS: The Thunder pitching staff allowed season-highs in multiple categories in Sunday's loss to Bowie, including total hits (14), extra-base hits (6), hits in a single inning (6 in the 5th), and hits allowed by a starting pitcher (10). The run-scoring damage, however, was concentrated in just two innings; the Baysox plated five runs in the fifth and five in the eighth, allowing relievers Stephen Tarpley and Matt Frawley to escape with scoreless final lines.

A NEW ERA: Despite surrendering 10 runs Sunday against Bowie—one shy of the team's season-high in runs allowed—the Thunder passed Akron for the Eastern League's best team ERA. The RubberDucks' numbers were skewed by a 13-10 loss to Hartford on Sunday, but Akron's staff ERA of 2.84 is still the league's second-lowest.

YOU AGAIN? Just six days after their last matchup with Akron, the Thunder meet the RubberDucks again to kick off a new series. Trenton has gotten the best of the season series so far, winning four of the five previous games. This is the second and final time that the Thunder are visiting Akron this season.

QUALITY INN AND SUITES: Since May 4, Thunder starting pitching has recorded a quality start (6 IP, 3 ER or less) in 11-of-their-last-17 starts. Overall this season, Thunder starting pitching has had 16 quality starts total out of 42 games played.

MAY FLOWERS: The Thunder are 15-6 in the month of May, surpassing their April win total with still 11 games remaining in May. Four of the six May losses have come by final margins of two or fewer runs. Trenton has not lost a series this month, and through the season's first 42 games, the Thunder have never lost more than two games in a row. The 2017 Thunder went 19-9 in the month of May on their way to a 92-win campaign.

EASTERN LEAGUE ALL-STAR CLASSIC RETURNS TO TRENTON: The 25th season in franchise history will be punctuated with ARM & HAMMER Park hosting an All-Star game for the third time in franchise history. Tuesday, July 10 will feature a special baseball game between the New York and Philadelphia Police Departments and the Case's Pork Roll Home Run Derby. Wednesday, July 11 will see the East and West face-off with former Yankees star Bernie Williams performing the National Anthem and the Budweiser Clydesdales leading the teams onto the field. 
