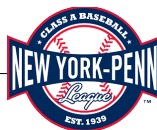

Right-handed starter **Carlos Guzman** (1-1, 3.60) will throw the first pitch at 7:05 p.m. Fans can enjoy Thirsty Thursday beer specials with select domestic drafts starting at just two dollars each.

Last Night - Tigers 3, Batavia 1: Right-handed starter **Chance Kirby** (Win, 1-0) struck out 12 batters in his New York-Penn League debut with six scoreless innings to pick up his first professional win as a starter for the Connecticut Tigers (12-13) in a 3-1 victory over the Batavia Muckdogs (11-13) on Wednesday. In his second game with the Tigers, first baseman **Nick Ames** recorded his first Connecticut hit on a solo home run to right field in the second inning against Humberto Mejia (Loss, 1-3). Ames added a double in the third and scored his second run on a two-out, two-run double by **Darwin Alvarado**.

TIGER TALES

Dazzling Debuts: 2018 Detroit Tigers draftees are dazzling in their debuts with the CT Tigers this season. On July 11, RHP **Chance Kirby** struck out 12 batters in his first New York-Penn League game during six scoreless innings against the Batavia Muckdogs to pick up his first pro win (3-1 final score). The 25th-round pick faced one more batter than the minimum through six innings and left in line for the win after throwing 77 pitches. The 22-year-old University of Texas at San Antonio alum eclipsed the previous Tigers season high of 12 K in seven innings by RHP **Gio Arriera** in a July 4 home loss to Lowell.

On July 5, OF **Eric De La Rosa** went a perfect 4-for-4 at the plate with two runs batted in during his debut for the Connecticut Tigers in a 5-2 win over the Lowell Spinners. The 21-year-old Grossmont JC (CA) alum became the second Connecticut hitter this season to finish 4-for-4 in a single game after Israel De La Cruz achieved the feat on June 23 in an 8-4 home loss to the Brooklyn Cyclones. The seventh-round pick is boasting an on-base percentage of .480 through six games this season.

In his first home game with the Tigers and just his second game in the New York-Penn League, 1B **Nick Ames** recorded his first Connecticut hit on a solo home run to right field against Batavia. Ames finished 2-for-4 with two runs scored and two extra-base hits.

Super Saver: 2018 Detroit Tigers 36th-round draft pick RHP **Yaya Chentouf** is a perfect 4-for-4 in save opportunities to begin his professional baseball career. The University of Pittsburgh all-time saves leader was assigned to Connecticut after the draft and made his first appearance on June 26 at Hudson Valley in a non-save situation before rattling off 4 straight saves with just 1 earned run, 3 hits, and no walks in 4.1 IP during save opps.

One Win Away from .500: After opening the 2018 season with a 2-10 record, marked by a franchise-record, 10-game losing streak, the Connecticut Tigers bounced back by winning 10 of their last 13 games which is the best mark in the 14-team New York-Penn League during that span. The Tigers are now 12-13 and one win away from a .500 winning percentage since they were 2-2 on June 19.

Norwich Navigators: On June 3, 1994, the Yankees announced they would move their Double-A franchise from Albany, NY to Norwich, CT. The Norwich Navigators reached the Eastern League playoffs four times in six years and on September 14, 2002, won their first and only Eastern League championship with a five-game series victory at home over Harrisburg, under the direction of rookie manager Luis Sojo. In 2005, a group led by boxing promoter Lou DiBella bought the team and changed the name to the Connecticut Defenders before the 2006 season began.

Arvicient Again: 2015 CT Tiger and former Double-A catcher **Arvicient Perez** is off to a near-perfect start as a converted relief pitcher. The 24-year-old Venezuelan, now in his seventh professional season, tossed a hitless eighth inning with a walk and a strikeout in his debut and again blanked Vermont on Tuesday with one perfect relief inning.

Steady Stalsberg: LHP **Mitchell Stalsberg** has been one of the top relievers out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season. The southpaw boasts a team-leading 0.77 ERA in 11 2/3 innings pitched. He also brings a 15:4 strikeout to walk ratio to the rubber during the 2018 campaign. Hitters are batting just .190 against the Winona State product at Dodd Stadium. On the road the average is even better with a .143 batting average against.

Wild Finish in Vermont: Trailing 10-2 in the top of the ninth on Monday in Vermont, the Tigers rallied for seven runs and placed the go-ahead run on base before the Lake Monsters escaped with a 10-9 victory to avoid a sweep and snap a season-best, four-game win streak by the Tigers. The Tigers sent 12 batters to the plate against three different Vermont relievers who nearly blew an eight-run lead. **Dayton Dugas** drew a bases-loaded walk, **Nick Ames** scored in his Connecticut debut on an **Alexis Garcia** RBI single, **Ulrich Bojarski** tallied a sac fly RBI, **Israel De La Cruz** and **Luke Sherley** each singled in a run, and **Sam McMillan** floated a two-out, RBI single to make it 10-9.

Youth Movement: The current Tigers roster features six teenagers including 19-year-old shortstop **Jose King**, who was included in a 2017 trade with the Diamondbacks for outfielder J.D. Martinez.

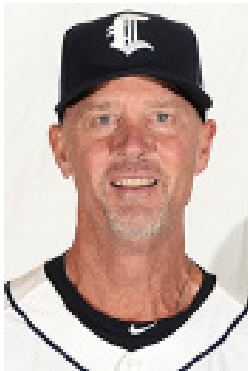
