RHP SPENCER HOWARD (0-1, 6.23) vs LHP Tarik Skubal (0-0, 2.25)

TODAY'S GAME: Game three of a four-game series against the Lakeland Flying Tigers (DET) (0-2)...First of four series against the Flying Tigers in 2019...The Threshers finished 2018 with a 7-4 record against the Detroit Tigers affiliate, including a 3-3 mark at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 22-year-old Spencer Howard makes his second start of the season in game three of the four-game set against the Lakeland Flying Tigers at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium...The 6-foot-3 hurler suffered the loss on Opening Night, allowing three runs on five hits, a walk and seven strikeouts across 4.1 innings against the Dunedin Blue Jays on April 4...Wednesday will be Howard's first career start against the Flying Tigers.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers' losing skid reached three games with a 3-1 loss to the Lakeland Flying Tigers at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate grabbed an early lead against Casey Mize with a two-out rally in the second...Daniel Britz was hit by a pitch in a 1-2 count, stole second and scored on Madison Stokes' RBI single...Julian Garcia suffered the loss with three runs allowed on five hits, two walks and six strikeouts through 3.2 innings in his first start of 2019.

STREAKS STAY ALIVE: Both Simon Muzzietti and Matt Vierling stretched their hitting streaks to five games on Tuesday night, with both batters finishing 1-for-4...Muzzietti singled in his second at-bat in the third inning, and Vierling extended his streak with a single in the sixth.

GETTING THEIR SWIPES IN: The Threshers ran all over Joey Morgan on Tuesday night, going 3-for-3 in stolen base opportunities...Simon Muzzietti stole second after his single in the third, giving the 20-year-old three swipes in two games during the series...Vierling took second after his single in the sixth, and Daniel Brito stole second after being hit by a pitch with two outs in the second to set up Madison Stokes' RBI single.

EARNING YOUR GRANT: Grant Dyer struck out three over 2.1 scoreless innings on Tuesday night...The product of UCLA has been on a tear out of the bullpen since August of 2018, holding the opposition scoreless over his last 10 appearances (16.1 innings)...The 23-year-old has not allowed a run since surrendering two tallies against the Tampa Tarpons on Aug. 1.

PHILLIES PHARM PROSPECTS: The Opening Day roster for the Clearwater Threshers features six top-30 prospects (MLB.com) in the Philadelphia Phillies organization: RHP Spencer Howard (5), OF Simon Muzzietti (12), LHP Kyle Young (17), INF Nick Maton (18), C Rodolfo Duran (19), INF Daniel Brito (20)...Muzzietti will be the youngest player on the team at just 20-years-old...RHP Austin Ross is the oldest player on the roster at 24-years-old...Three countries are represented on the Threshers roster: United States, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic...12 different states are represented on the Opening Day roster, with five players residing in California, two each in Illinois and Texas, and one each in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Tennessee.

MEET THE NEW SKIPPER....: The Clearwater Threshers have a new manager for the 2019 season, Marty Malloy...The Trenton, Fla. native spent two years in the same role for Lakewood (A, 2017-18)...Spent the previous four years (2013-16) with the Houston Astros, including three years as the manager for their Gulf Coast League (R) team, one year as the GCL hitting coach and one year as the Florida Instructional League coordinator...Also coached at the amateur level as head coach (two years) and volunteer assistant (six years) for Trenton High School and six years as an infield instructor at Gatorball Baseball Academy in Gainesville, FL...Played 12 years (1992-2003), including his first eight in the Atlanta Braves minor league system.

...AND HIS MATES: Joining Malloy from Lakewood is pitching coach Brad Bergesen...The Auburn, Ala. native pitched in the major leagues for four years for the Baltimore Orioles (2009-11) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2012), going 19-25 with four complete games and a 4.61 ERA in 102 games (59 starts).

Chris Heintz takes over as the hitting coach in 2019...The Tampa, Fla. native was previously an assistant coach for the University of South Florida for five years (2010-14)...Prior to his time with USF, spent two years in the Minnesota Twins minor league system as manager for the Gulf Coast League (R) team and coach for single-A Beloit...Appeared in 34 major league games for the Twins over three seasons (2005-07) after being selected by the Chicago White Sox in the 19th round of the 1996 draft...In 2013, was inducted into the USF Hall of Fame.

Harold Garcia is the third coach on the staff...The Kissimmee, Fla. resident originally signed by the Phillies as an amateur free agent in 2005, he is in his first year on the organization's player development staff...Played eight of his nine minor league seasons with the Phillies. In 2010, with Clearwater (A), broke a 59-year-old record by hitting safely in 37 consecutive games.
