TODAY'S GAME: Finale of a four-game series against the Lakeland Flying Tigers (DET) (1-2)...First of four series against the Flying Tigers in 2019...First of two series (seven games) at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium...The Threshers finished 2018 with a 7-4 record against the Detroit Tigers affiliate, including a 3-3 mark at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 24-year-old Damon Jones makes his second start of the season in the finale of the four-game series against the Lakeland Flying Tigers at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium...The 6-foot-5 hurler set a team-high with eight strikeouts against the Dunedin Blue Jays on April 5, but lasted just three innings...The Twin Falls, Idaho native allowed an unearned run no hits, but walked four on 73 pitches (37 strikes) in the no-decision...Thursday will be Jones' first career start against the Flying Tigers.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers' snapped a three-game losing streak with a 4-0 shutout over the Lakeland Flying Tigers on Wednesday night at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium...Spencer Howard led the way on the mound with six scoreless innings in his second start of the season, and the combination of Jonathan Hennigan (two innings) and Zach Warren (one inning) locked down the final three frames to secure the victory...Simón Muzzietti picked up the first hit of the game for either side with a triple in the right field corner to lead off the fourth, and scored on Nick Maton's RBI single to right for the winning run...Madison Stokes and Danny Mayer homered in the seventh to provide the insurance runs.

STREAKS STAY ALIVE: Both Simon Muzzietti and Matt Vierling stretched their hitting streaks to six games on Wednesday night, with both batters finishing with one hit...Muzzietti's triple in the fourth inning led to the first run of the game for the road team, while Vierling's line drive to center in the eighth was the second time the product of Notre Dame reached on the night...Madison Stokes extended his hitting game to five games with a two-run shot onto the berm in the seventh to push the Threshers' lead to 3-0.

MATON'S MOTOR: Nick Maton stole another base in the four-game series on Wednesday night...The Chatham, Ill. native already has four stolen bases in 2019 after picking up just five in 114 games with the Lakewood BlueClaws in 2018...The 22-year-old posted a career mark of 10 in just 58 contests with Williamsport in 2017...The Threshers are a perfect 5-for-5 in stolen base chances against the Flying Tigers this week.

FIRE THE CANNON: On the defensive side of things, Rodolfo Duran has picked up where he left off behind the plate from his 2018 season...The native of the Dominican Republic has thrown out 40 percent of attempted base stealers (4-for-10), including two more caught stealings on Wednesday night...For his career, the 21-year-old has nabbed 39.9 percent of players attempting to snag a bag against him (83-for-208).

PHILLIES PHARM PROSPECTS: The Opening Day roster for the Clearwater Threshers features six top-30 prospects (MLB.com) in the Philadelphia Phillies organization: RHP Spencer Howard (5), OF Simon Muzzietti (12), LHP Kyle Young (17), INF Nick Maton (18), C Rodolfo Duran (19), INF Daniel Brito (20)...Muzzietti will be the youngest player on the team at just 20-years-old...RHP Austin Ross is the oldest player on the roster at 24-years-old...Three countries are represented on the Threshers roster: United States, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic...12 different states are represented on the Opening Day roster, with five players residing in California, two each in Illinois and Texas, and one each in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Tennessee.

MEET THE NEW SKIPPER...: The Clearwater Threshers have a new manager for the 2019 season, Marty Malloy...The Trenton, Fla. native spent two years in the same role for Lakewood (A, 2017-18)...Spent the previous four years (2013-16) with the Houston Astros, including three years as the manager for their Gulf Coast League (R) team, one year as the GCL hitting coach and one year as the Florida Instructional League coordinator...Also coached at the amateur level as head coach (two years) and volunteer assistant (six years) for Trenton High School and six years as an infield instructor at Gatorball Baseball Academy in Gainesville, FL...Played 12 years (1992-2003), including his first eight in the Atlanta Braves minor league system.

...AND HIS MATES: Joining Malloy from Lakewood is pitching coach Brad Bergesen...The Auburn, Ala. native pitched in the major leagues for four years for the Baltimore Orioles (2009-11) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2012), going 19-25 with four complete games and a 4.61 ERA in 102 games (59 starts).

Chris Heintz takes over as the hitting coach in 2019...The Tampa, Fla. native was previously an assistant coach for the University of South Florida for five years (2010-14)...Prior to his time with USF, spent two years in the Minnesota Twins minor league system as manager for the Gulf Coast League (R) team and coach for single-A Beloit...Appeared in 34 major league games for the Twins over three seasons (2005-07) after being selected by the Chicago White Sox in the 19th round of the 1996 draft...In 2013, was inducted into the USF Hall of Fame.

Harold Garcia is the third coach on the staff...The Kissimmee, Fla. resident originally signed by the Phillies as an amateur free agent in 2005, he is in his first year on the organization's player development staff...Played eight of his nine minor league seasons with the Phillies. In 2010, with Clearwater (A), broke a 59-year-old record by hitting safely in 37 consecutive games.
