

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 22-year-old Spencer Howard makes his third start of the season in game two of the three-game series against the Florida Fire Frogs on Tuesday night at Osceola County Stadium...The 6-foot-3 hurler earned his first win of the season by tossing six shutout innings against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on April 10...The right-hander walked one and struck out five on 80 pitches - 55 strikes...Tuesday will be Howard's first career start against the Fire Frogs

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers snapped a four-game losing with a 6-0 shutout over the Florida Fire Frogs on Monday night to open a three-game series at Osceola County Stadium...Nick Maton provied five of the club's six runs thanks to a three-run homer and a two-run triple...Julian Garcia tossed six scoreless innings, and Luis Carrasco (two innings) and Connor Brogdon (one inning) worked the final three frames to preserve the shutout.

MATON'S MADNESS: Nick Maton provided just about all of the offense for the Threshers on Monday night, as the 22-year-old was responsible for five of the team's six runs...The left-handed batter whacked a three-run homer over the wall in right in the second inning to open a 4-0 cushion, and iced the match with a two-run triple to the right-center alley in the ninth...The Chatham, Ill. native topped his previous career mark of four set back on Aug. 15 against the Rome Braves.

RODOLFO'S RIFLE: Rodolfo Duran has picked up where he left off the 2018 season by throwing out just about everyone who has tried to steal a base against the Threshers...The 21-year-old has thrown out eight of 17 attempted base stealers during his fifth season, including two out of three on Monday.

JOLLY JULIAN: Julian Garcia paced the pitching staff with six scoreless innings in his second start of the season...The 2016 10th-round draft pick tied his career high with those six shutout stanzas, matching his June 28, 2017 start against the Batavia Muckdogs.

RISE AND SCHEIN: Jake Scheiner had just three hits through nine contests to start the season, but has four over his last two games...The 23-year-old singled to lead-off the second and ninth innings, and was driven home twice by Nick Maton on a long ball and a three-bagger.

TAKE A BIG WHIFF: The combination of Julian Garcia (7), Luis Carrasco (2) and Connor Broadon (3) tallied 12 strikeouts on Monday raising the hurlers' total to 143 through the first 12 games of the season (20 more than the Fort Myers Miracle for the top spot).

PHILLIES PHARM PROSPECTS: The Opening Day roster for the Clearwater Threshers features six top-30 prospects (MLB.com) in the Philadelphia Phillies organization: RHP Spencer Howard (5), OF Simon Muzziotti (12), LHP Kyle Young (17), INF Nick Maton (18), C Rodolfo Duran (19), INF Daniel Brito (20)...Muzziotti will be the youngest player on the team at just 20-years-old...RHP Austin Ross is the oldest player on the roster at 24-years-old...Three countries are represented on the Threshers roster: United States, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic...12 different states are represented on the Opening Day roster, with five players residing in California, two each in Illinois and Texas, and one each in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Tennessee.

MEET THE NEW SKIPPER ...: The Clearwater Threshers have a new manager for the 2019 season, Marty Malloy...The Trenton, Fla. native spent two years in the same role for Lakewood (A. 2017-18)... Spent the previous four years (2013-16) with the Houston Astros. including three years as the manager for their Gulf Coast League (R) team, one year as the GCL hitting coach and one year as the Florida Instructional League coordinator...Also coached at the amateur level as head coach (two years) and volunteer assistant (six years) for Trenton High School and six years as an infield instructor at Gatorball Baseball Academy in Gainesville, FL...Played 12 years (1992-2003), DUE UP: 4/16 vs. Portland Sea Dogs (645 p.m. EDT) including his first eight in the Atlanta Braves minor league system.

...AND HIS MATES: Joining Malloy from Lakewood is pitching coach Brad Bergesen...The Auburn, Ala. native pitched in the major leagues for four years for the Baltimore Orioles (2009-11) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2012), going 19-25 with four complete games and a 4.61 ERA in 102 games (59 starts).

Chris Heintz takes over as the hitting coach in 2019...The Tampa, Fla. native was previously an assistant coach for the University of South Florida for five years (2010-14)...Prior to his time with USF, spent two years in the Minnesota Twins minor league system as manager for the Gulf Coast League (R) team and coach for single-A Beloit...Appeared in 34 major league games for the Twins over three seasons (2005-07) after being selected by the Chicago White Sox in the 19th round of the 1996 draft...In 2013, was inducted into the USF Hall of Fame.

Harold Garcia is the third coach on the staff...The Kissimmee, Fla. resident originally signed by the Phillies as an amateur free agent in 2005, he is in his first year on the organization's player development staff..Played eight of his nine minor league seasons with the Phillies. In 2010 with Clearwater (A), broke a 59-year-old record by hitting safely in 37 consecutive games.
