TODAY'S GAME: Game two of a four-game series against the Lakeland Flying Tigers (DET) from Spectrum Field (1-0)... Game two of a seven-game homestand against Lakeland and the Charlotte Stone Crabs (TB) (1-0)... The Threshers are coming off a three-game sweep against the Dunedin Blue Jays (TOR)... Second of four series (15 games) against the Detroit Tigers' affiliate, with eight contests in Clearwater... The Threshers dropped three of four against Lakeland from April 8-11 at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 22-year-old Colton Eastman makes his third start of the season for the Threshers in game two of the four-game set against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on Tuesday night... The 6-foot-3 hurler did not factor into the decision of a 4-2 loss to the Bradenton Marauders on May 7... The right-hander allowed a run on seven hit, four walks and three strikeouts through 3.2 innings of work... Tuesday will be the Cal State Fullerton product's first career start against the Detroit Tigers affiliate

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers stretched their winning streak to five games with a 7-4 victory over the Lakeland Flying Tigers on Monday night at Spectrum Field to start a seven-game homestand... Nick Maton tied the game at a run apiece with an RBI double in the first to extend his hitting streak to seven games... Alec Bohm crushed a two-run shot into the bullpens in left for his second homer in two games... Damon Jones earned his first win of the season with an unearned run allowed over six frames... The southpaw struck out nine batters and walked only one while scattering four hits.

MOTORIN' MATON: Nick Maton wasted no time in extending his hitting streak to seven games with a run-scoring two bagger in the first frame... The left-handed batter finished the night with three hits in a 3-for-5 performance for his 10th multi-hit game of the season... The 22-year-old has hit .517 by going 15-for-29 since the streak began on May 4... The Chatham, Ill. native has seen his season batting average jump 77 points from .231 to .308 during the recent hot stretch... The infielder is at the .300 mark for the first time since April 6.

MR. BOHM-BLASTIC!: Alec Bohm whacked a two-run blast in the fourth inning to extend Clearwater's lead to 5-1 on Monday night... The Philadelphia Phillies' top prospect (MLB.com) has left the yard twice in the last two games, and has collected five round trippers in 34 games in 2019.

DANGEROUS DAMON: Damon Jones earned his first win of the season on Monday night... The southpaw allowed an unearned run on four hit, a walk and nine strikeouts across six frames for his third quality start of the season... Twice before, the Idaho Falls native came within an out of qualifying for a win, but came up just shy on April 24 and April 30... The 24-year-old has allowed just six runs in 35.1 innings, but only three have been earned... The 6-foot-5 hurler lowered his ERA from 0.92 to 0.76.

STRIKEOUT KINGS: Damon Jones (9), Austin Ross (3) and Jonathan Hennigan (1) combined for 13 strikeouts in the series opener on Monday... The Threshers pitching staff has collected 361 punch outs through the first 36 games - 14 more than the Fort Myers Miracle for the top spot in the Florida State League... Damon Jones leads the league with 52 Ks - five more than Lakeland LHP Tarik Skubal.

HOME COOKING: The Clearwater Threshers are scheduled to play 13 of their first 18 games of May at home at Spectrum Field, with only two games outside the city of Clearwater in Fort Myers at the start of the month... The Threshers went 5-7 at Spectrum Field in April (one official "road" game against Dunedin), and are off to a 2-3 start in the second month of the season... After a seven-game homestand from May 13-19, Clearwater will not see their home stadium again until May 31 against the Blue Jays following a 10-game road trip... Clearwater has performed about even at the plate at home compared to on the road in 2019 (.265 average and 75 runs through 17 games compared to .246 average and 72 runs through 19 games on the road), but have pitched better away from Spectrum Field, having allowed 67 runs on the road compared to 77.

WEEKLY ACCOLADES: The Philadelphia Phillies announced their Players of the Week for the week of May 6-12, and both awards belong to Threshers players in INF Nick Maton and RHP Julian Garcia... Maton posted a .550/.609/.650 slash line by going 11-for-20 with two doubles three RBI, three runs and three walks in five games... The left-handed batter collected multiple hits in each of his five games, raising his season average from .232 to .294... Garcia earned a win after tossing six scoreless innings on May 10 at Dunedin, in which he collected seven strikeouts without handing out any walks... The right-hander lowered his ERA to 2.97 over six starts, and is averaging 10.68 SO/9.0IP.

MONTHLY RECOGNITION: The Philadelphia Phillies announced their Players of the Month for April on May 6, and INF Alec Bohm was named Player of the Month and INF Jose Gomez was named Defender of the Month... Bohm, 22, hit .373 (31-for-83) with nine doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and posted a 1.039 OPS in 22 games with single-A Lakewood and one game with Advanced-A Clearwater... He Omaha, Neb. native hit .429 with a .671 slugging percentage over his final 19 games of the month, with multi-hit performances in 11 of those contests... Gomez started 14 games for Clearwater before being promoted to Double-A Reading to start May... The 22-year-old started at three infield positions (Second - nine games; Third - three games; Shortstop - two games), and was a perfect 50-for-50 in total chances.
