TODAY'S GAMES: Games three and four of a four-game series against the Tampa Tarpons (NYY) from George M. Steinbrenner Field (2-0)... Clearwater is coming off a three-game sweep at the hands of the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) at Spectrum Field...Third of four sets (14 games) between the two clubs in 2019...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate split a four-game series in Tampa from April 25-28...The Threshers took two of three from the Tarpons at Spectrum Field April 18-20...Sunday will be the third twin bill for the Threshers during the 2019 campaign...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate were swept in a doubleheader against the Miracle at CenturyLink Sports Complex to start the month of May (May 2), and split two games on May 20 against the Daytona Tortugas (CIN) at Jackie Robinson Ballpark (May 20).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHERS: 22-year-old Colton Eastman makes his 11th appearance - 10th start - at the Advanced-A level in game three of the four-game series against the Tampa Tarpons (NYY) at George M. Steinbrenner Field on Saturday night...The 6-foot-3 hurler did not factor into the decision of a 5-3 victory over the St. Lucie Mets (NYM) on June 30...The right-hander allowed two runs on seven hits, two walks and three strikeouts through six frames for his third quality start of the season...Saturday will be the Fresno native's first career start against the New York Yankees affiliate.

22-year-old Alejandro Requena makes his 14th start of the season in the finale of the four-game series against the Tampa Tarpons on Sunday afternoon at George M. Steinbrenner Field...The 6-foot-2 hurler suffered his fifth loss of the season in a 6-0 defeat against the Fort Myers Miracle on July 1...The right-hander allowed just one run on three hits, two walks and four strikeouts across six innings of work for his third quality start of the season...Sunday will be the Venezuela native's third career start against the New York Yankees affiliate...Requena has allowed eight runs - seven earned - in 9.2 innings of work against the Tarpons on 2019 on 17 knocks, three free passes and nine punch outs...Requena faced off against Tampa in Tampa on April 25 and took the loss in a 6-3 defeat with five runs allowed - three earned - on a season-high 11 hits and three strikeouts in five frames.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers took a back-and-forth contest against the Tampa Tarpons, 5-4, to take a 2-0 lead in the four-game set at George M. Steinbrenner Field...The Threshers used three home runs to their advantage, with solo shots from Rodolfo Duran and Madison Stokes, and a two-run shot by Danny Mayer...Oscar Marcelino and Zach Warren combined to toss four hitless innings out of the bullpen for the visitors, and tallied five strike outs.

A LITTLE FIGHT IN YA: Matt Vierling drove an RBI double into the gap in right center in the third inning to extend the Notre Dame product's on-base streak to 11 games...The 22-year-old is hitting just .220 since June 23, but has on on-base percentage of .327 due to drawing six base on balls and being plunked once.

PERFECT HOOSIER: With a two-hit performance on Friday night, Luke Miller extended his on-base streak to 11 games...The Indiana product has reached base safely in every game he's played at the Advanced-A level, and is off to a .325 start at the dish with a 13 hits in 40 at-bats...The right-handed batter has also collected a pair of doubles and dingers, helping to post an OPS of .938 in his time with Clearwater.

ROAD WARRIORS: Friday's win over the Tarpons extended the Threshers' road winning streak to six games, setting a season-high...Over the last five road games, Clearwater has outscored its opponents, 28-14...Clearwater has managed just 10 runs during its four-game home losing streak, in which it has yielded 22 runs.

HOME SWEET HOME?: With the 0-3 start to the month of July, Clearwater has fallen below .500 with a 20-21 record at Spectrum Field in 2019...The discrepancy in stats between home and road games is not that different for the Threshers...The club has a .255 average at home compared to .246 on the road, but has scored 17 less runs (171-188)...Clearwater has a .692 OPS at Spectrum Field, but has posted a .699 on the road...On the mound, the pitching staff does have a higher ERA on the home bump (3.63-3.02), and has a higher average against (.241-.231).

SEARCHING FOR RUNS: After plating 47 runs through the first seven games of the second half, the Clearwater offense has managed just 40 runs the last 11 contests...Over the stretch, Clearwater has managed just a .212 average with a chance to drive a runner home (21-for-99)...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate has 79 hits over the 11-game stretch, with 29 going for extra bases (37 percent).

NO JUNE SWOON: Everything went the way of the Clearwater Threshers in the month of June, as the club posted a league-best, 18-7 record during the third month of the season...The offense had a dip in production in average (.246 in June to .277 in May), on-base percentage (.310 in June to .326 May) and OPS (.690 in June compared to .737 in May), but excelled in the pitching department...The arms dropped their ERA by more than a point from 3.69 in May down to 2.56 in June, and had 28 less walks with 68 in June compared to 96 in May...The bullpen took a step forward in June as well, going 9-2 and 10-for-11 in save opportunities...Relievers also posted a 1.58 ERA (17er/97.1ip), while collecting 119 strikeouts (one shy of tying April's season-high).

STRIKEOUT KINGS: Kyle Glogoski (4), Oscar Marcelino (2) and Zach Warren (3) combined for nine strikeouts on Friday night against the Tampa Tarpons, raising the Threshers' total on the mound to 814 - 42 more than the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) for the top spot in the Florida State League entering Sunday.

PHILLIES PHARM PROSPECTS: The Opening Day roster for the Clearwater Threshers features six top-30 prospects (MLB.com) in the Philadelphia Phillies organization: RHP Spencer Howard (5), OF Simon Muzziotti (12), LHP Kyle Young (17), INF Nick Maton (18), C Rodolfo Duran (19), INF Daniel Brito (20)...Muzziotti will be the youngest player on the team at just 20-years-old...RHP Austin Ross is the oldest player on the roster at 24-years-old...Three countries are represented on the Threshers roster: United States, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic...12 different states are represented on the Opening Day roster, with five players residing in California, two each in Illinois and Texas, and one each in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Tennessee...The Threshers have added two more top-30 prospects since the start of the season, with Alec Bohm (11) and Jhailyn Ortiz (11) joining the club...Bohm was promoted to Double-A Reading on 6/21.
