**TODAY'S GAME:** Game two of a three-game series against the St. Lucie Mets (NYM) at First Data Field (0-1)...Clearwater is coming off a rain-shortened, two-game sweep at the hands of the Bradenton Marauders (PIT)...The Threshers suffered their third sweep of the month after being swept only one time leading into July...Third of four series (13 games) between the two clubs in 2019...The Threshers swept the Mets at First Data Field from June 28-30, which included two come-from-behind victories.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** 22-year-old Spencer Howard makes his eighth start of the season - seventh with Clearwater - in game two of the three-game series against the St. Lucie Mets at First Data Field...The 6-foot-3 hurler did not factor into the decision of a 4-0 loss to the Florida Fire Frogs on July 14...The right-hander did not allow a hit while walking a batter and striking out seven across five innings of work...Saturday will be the Templeton, Calif. native's first career start against the New York Mets affiliate.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Clearwater Threshers had a late lead slip away in a 4-2 loss to the St. Lucie Mets on Friday night to open a three-game series at First Data Field...Matt Vierling and Madison Stokes picked up two-out RBI singles in the third to give the visitors a 2-0 lead, but Austin Ross allowed four runs in the seventh to finish the scoring for the contest...Simón Muzziotti collected three of the Threshers' eight hits, with Stokes picking up two knocks in the losing effort...Kyle Glogoski gave up just one hit through his five innings of work in the no-decision.

**SIMÓN SAYS:** Simón Muzziotti extended his on-base and hitting streaks with a 3-for-5 performance at the dish on Friday night...The 20-year-old has picked up nine hits in 27 at-bats during his seven-game hitting streak...The native of Venezuela is in the middle of the third longest on-base streak for the Threshers this season at 12 games, in which the left-handed batter is hitting .279 by going 12-for-43 at the plate.

**GLOGOSKI'S GRIND:** After allowing two earned runs in each of his last three starts, Kyle Glogoski held the Mets off the scoreboard through his five innings of work in the series opener...The 20-year-old did tie a season-high with four walks, but gave up just one hit in the no-decision...The New Zealand native has held opponents to a .144 average in his five starts with Clearwater, and has posted a WHIP of 0.80.

**PILING ON THE PUNCH OUTS:** Kyle Glogoski (5), Austin Ross (3) and Tyler Carr (1) combined for six strikeouts on the mound on Friday night, raising the Threshers' staff total to 909 on the season...The Threshers lead the Florida State League by 41 over the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN), making them the only team with at least 900 punch outs in 2019.

**HOWARD'S HYPE:** Spencer Howard continued his dominance of the Florida Fire Frogs on Sunday afternoon...The Philadelphia Phillies fifth-ranked prospect tossed five hitless innings against the Atlanta Braves affiliate, and struck out seven across five innings of work...The only base runner against the right-hander was off a two-out walk to CJ Alexander in the fourth inning...The 22-year-old has started three games against the Fire Frogs in 2019, and has allowed only two runs through 14.2 stanzas, while setting down 25 men on strikes compared to just three walks...The performances earned the Cal Poly San Luis Obispo product pitcher of the week for the week of July 8-14.

**HOME SWEET HOME?:** With the 2-8 start to the month of July, Clearwater continues to stay below .500 with a 22-26 record at Spectrum Field in 2019...The discrepancy in stats between home and road games is not that different for the Threshers...The club has a .258 average at home compared to .237 on the road, and has scored three more runs (197-194)...Clearwater has a .704 OPS at Spectrum Field, but has posted a .673 on the road...On the mound, the pitching staff does have a higher ERA on the home bump (3.88-3.23), and has a higher average against (.238-.233)...The Threshers have been swept four times this season, with three coming at home...Clearwater is currently in the midst of a four-game losing streak at Spectrum Field, the second streak of at least four games in the second half in 14 contests.

**LEAVING MEN ON BASE:** After plating 47 runs through the first seven games of the second half (6.7 runs/game) to lead to a 5-2 start, the Clearwater offense has managed 72 runs the last 23 contests (3.1 runs/game) to go 9-14 ever since...Over the stretch, Clearwater has managed just a .213 average with a chance to drive a runner home (37-for-174)...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate has 157 hits over the 23-game stretch, with 50 going for extra bases (32 percent).

**NO JUNE SWOON:** Everything went the way of the Clearwater Threshers in the month of June, as the club posted a league-best, 18-7 record during the third month of the season...The offense had a dip in production in average (.246 in June to .277 in May), on-base percentage (.310 in June to .326 May) and OPS (.690 in June compared to .737 in May), but excelled in the pitching department...The arms dropped their ERA by more than a point from 3.69 in May down to 2.56 in June, and had 28 less walks with 68 in June compared to 96 in May...The bullpen took a step forward in June as well, going 9-2 and 10-for-11 in save opportunities...Relievers also posted a 1.58 ERA (17er/97.1ip), while collecting 119 strikeouts (one shy of tying April's season-high).

**2018:** Led all Phillies minor league pitchers with 147 SO... Ranked T-1st in the South Atlantic League in SO, T-5th in wins and T-7th in starts & CG... Led all qualifying SAL starting pitchers with an 11.81 SO/9.0 IP ratio... Spent entire season with Lakewood (A)... Named Phillies Minor League Co-Pitcher of the Month for April... Twice selected as SAL Pitcher of the Week (4/23-29 & 6/25-7/1)... Named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Week, 6/25-7/1...
