LAST TIME OUT: Daytona avoided a sweep on Thursday night, as the Tortugas knocked off the Jupiter Hammerheads, 4-2, in front of 3,069 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...DH Andy Sugilio (2-4, R, HR, RBI) led off the game with a solo home run to right in the bottom of the first...2B Alejo López (2-3, BB, SO) added a multi-hit performance, while LF Drew Mount's (1-4, 2 RBI, SO) 2-run single in the 4th turned out to be the difference in the game...C Adrián Nieto (3-3, R, BB) reached base 4 times and collected a game-high 3 hits for Jupiter...1B Harrison Dinicola (2-4, SO) added a multiple-knock performance, too...RHP Austin Orewiler (5.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, BB, 3 SO) went 5.0 sagrarer his team-leading 7th wim...RHP Diomar López (1.0 IP, 2 H, SO) stranded the tying runs in scoring position in the 9th to collect his 2nd save...Hammerheads' RHP Jordan Holloway (4.2 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 8 BB, 4 SO) did not make it out of the 5th and suffered his 7th-straight defeat and his 8th overall.

TONIGHT'S FLYING TIGERS STARTER: For the 2nd time in less than a week, Daytona is set to square off against RHP Garrett Hill...The 23-year-old hurled a complete game in his last start in game two of a doubleheader at Daytona on Saturday night, but suffered his 2nd-consecutive loss (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 4 SO)...Hill also took the loss against the Tortugas in Lakeland on June 12 (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 5 SO)...Has pitched better away from home since joining the Florida State League...Holds a 2-2 mark with a 2.08 ERA (7 ER in 30.1 IP) in 5 road starts, as opposed to an 0-2 clip and a 3.20 ERA (7 ER in 19.2 IP) in 4 starts at home...Has limited right-handed batters to just 8 hits (8-for-85: .094 AVG) since joining the FSL... Transferred from Low-A West Michigan on May 23...Accumulated a 2-1 record with a 1.41 ERA (6 ER in 38.1 IP) and 42 strikeouts in 7 starts for the Whitecaps...Selected by the Detroit Tigers in the 26th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of San Diego State University... Signed for \$100,000...Named to the All-Mountain West First Team and chosen as the Mountain West Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2018...Had Tommy John surgery while at Santa Rosa (Calif.) J.C. in 2016.

NO YELLING ON THE BUSI: The Tortugas will be spending a lot of time on the bus over the next 2 weeks...Starting on Friday, Daytona will embark on a 13-game 14-day road trip, their longest of the season...The Tugas will play 3 games in Lakeland (July 19-21), 3 contests in Tampa (July 22-24), 4 affairs in Kissimmee against Florida (July 25-28), and finish with 3 ballgames in Jupiter (July 30-August 1)...There will also be an off day on Monday, July 29... Daytona has faired well on the road so far this season, tallying a 23-21 mark in official road games...In contests played in visiting ballparks, the Tortugas clip moves to 22-19...Prior to this run, Daytona's longest road trip this season was 8 scheduled contests from July 5-11 at St. Lucie and Fort Myers...The Tortugas went 2-5 on that trip, as the final game of the Fort Myers series was cancelled due to rain...Since Minor League Baseball's stats portal began in 2005, this is the longest road trip the Daytona franchise has embarked on...The previous long was a 10-game road swing from April 25-May 4, 2017, at Jupiter, Tampa, and Fort Myers...The Tortugas went 5-5 on that trip...Daytona's next home game will not be until Friday, August 2, against the St. Lucie Mets.

THE TORTUGA TANGO: The Daytona Tortugas made a quarter of roster moves prior to Wednesday's game and another two prior to Friday's contest... RHP Aaron Fossas was transferred to the Tortugas from Double-A Chattanooga, while LHP Connor Curlis was returned to Low-A Dayton...Daytona also added OF Michael Beltré from Double-A Chattanooga and activated C Ernesto Liberatore from the 7-day injured list on Wednesday...Additionally, OF Stuart Fairchild was transferred back to Double-A Chattanooga and C Hendrik Clementina was placed on the 7-day In Livit a left hamstring strain...Fossas tallied a 4-3 mark with a 6.70 ERA (34 ER in 45.2 IP) in 28 appearances with the Lookouts...Last season with Daytona, the 26-year-old hoisted a 5-2 clip with a 5.40 ERA (35 ER in 58.1 IP) and 2 saves in 42 relief outings...Curlis made 2 starts with the Tortugas, going 1-0 with an impressive 0.96 ERA (1 ER in 9.1 IP)...Beltré began the season with the Lookouts in early May and tallied a .220 average (29-132) with 14 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, 2 home runs, and 17 RBI in 53 games... The 24-year-old appeared in 58 games with the Tugas in 2018, tallying a .261 mark (49-188) with 28 runs scored, 12 extra-base knocks, a home run, and 18 driven in...Liberatore appeared in 3 games for Daytona sesson and went 1-for-8 with a double and an RBI...The 23-year-old has not been active with the 'Tugas since June 6...Fairchild will make his second stint in Double-A after going 6-for-14 with the Lookouts in late June...The 23-year-old hoisted a .258 average (64-248) with 32 runs tallied, 27 extra-base knocks, 8 home runs, and 37 RBI in 67 games for Daytona.

THE COMPASS POINTS NORTH: The Tortugas have seen vastly different results depending on which division they go up against...Against fellow North Division squads, Daytona enters Friday with an impressive 32-20 record...They are 13-4 in true road games against North Division opponents, excluding the 3-game series against Dunedin that was moved to Daytona due to ballpark renovations at Dunedin Stadium...However, against the South Division, the Tortugas hold a 16-26 clip...Daytona has hit much better against in-division pitching, tallying a .257 average (441-1713) against the North and just a .228 clip (326-1427) vs. the South...The Tortugas average 4.73 runs, 8.48 hits, 3.02 walks, and 8.55 strikeouts per contest (52 G) against their division rivals... Versus the South, Daytona's averages dip to 3.26 runs, 7.80 hits, 2.81 walks, and 8.21 strikeouts a game (42 G)...The Tortugas' pitching staff, however, has faired slightly better against the South...Against cross-division opponents, Daytona has a 3.52 ERA (146 ER in 373.2 IP) and yield 8.05 hits, 3.93 runs, 2.95 walks, and 8.17 strikeouts a R17 strikeouts against the South...Against cross-division opponents, Daytona has a 4.05 ERA (206 ER in 458.0 IP) with 8.90 hits, 4.50 runs, 2.90 walks, and 8.87 strikeouts in the average affair.

SWIPER NO SWEEPING: The Tortugas avoided being swept for the 3rd time this season with a 4-2 win vs. Jupiter on Thursday night...Daytona was swept for just the 2nd time this season as a result of their 4-3 loss to the St. Lucie Mets on July 7 at First Data Field...The Tortugas had not been swept until they dropped all 3 affairs to the Dunedin Blue Jays at Jackie Robinson Ballpark from June 28-30...Prior to that, the 'Tugas hadn't been swept in a series of 3+ games at home since they dropped 4 in-a-row to Lakeland from July 7-10, 2017...Entering that ffair, Daytona had only gone into 2 contests this season on the verge of being swept...Their ballgame on June 9 in Daytona against Clearwater was cancelled due to rain...On June 23, the 'Tugas staved off a sweep in Clearwater with a 7-5 victory...Before the Dunedin series in late June, the Tortugas had not been swept since they lost all 4 games against the Lakeland Flying Tigers at Joker Marchant Stadium from August 13-16, 2018...The Tortugas themselves have completed 6 sweeps this season.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: With 43 games remaining in the 2019 regular season, Daytona remains in the thick of the playoff race in the Florida State League North Division...Entering Friday's matchup with Lakeland, the Tortugas hold a 13-16 mark in the season's second half...They are currently tied for 3rd with the Tampa Tarpons and are a game back of the Clearwater Threshers for 2nd place...The Dunedin Blue Jays currently lead the way with an 18-11 mark and are 5.0 games up on the "Lugas...Since Dunedin captured the first-half crown in the North, the playoffs could come down to a wild-card berth given to the team with the second-best overall record in the division...Entering the day, Daytona is 48-46 overall, which is good for 3rd place in the overall North Division standings...The Tortugas are 11.0 games behind Dunedin for the best total mark in the division...However, Daytona trails Clearwater by just 1.5 contests for 2nd place in the total standings...The Fort Myers Miracle were the first-half champions in the South Division, while the Charlotte Stone Crabs currently have a 4.0-game lead over the St. Lucie Mets in the 2nd half race...Daytona has not won a second-half crown since the franchise rebranded prior to the 2015 season...The least time the organization emerged on top in the season's second half was in 2014 when they finished 41-27, 3.5 games ahead of the then-Tampa Yankees...The Tortugas have only once earned a wild-card bid to the playoffs...That came in 2015 when Clearwater won both halves... Daytona was 77-58 overall that season and beat out Tampa by 12.5 games for the playoffs spot.

ANDY'S HIT COLLECTION: OF Andy Sugilio continues to pepper the ball across the diamond for the Tortugas...The 22-year-old had a season-high 10-game hitting streak snapped on July 7...Dating back to the beginning of the recent homestand on June 25 vs. Tampa, Sugilio had accumulated a. 429 average (18-42) with 9 runs scored, a double, a triple, 4 runs batted in, 3 walks, and 2 stolen bases...During that time, Sugilio slashed .429/.467/.500 with an .967 OPS and a .500 BABIP...The Dominican native has picked up a base-hit in 15-of-his-last-19 games entering Friday...In that time, he has tallied a .329 average (25-76) with 12 runs scored, a double, 3 triples, a home run, 5 RBI, 3 walks, a hit-by-pitch, and 3 stolen bases...Since the beginning of May, the Reds' No. 21 prospect per MLBPipeline.com is 2nd in the Florida State League in batting average (.315) and hits (74).

LEADING THE BALE: Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders through their first 94 games...OF Andy Sugilio enters Friday ranked 2nd in the league in hitting (,300), 5th in hits (92), and tied for 8th in steals (16)...After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, SS José García has been a doubles machine and currently tied for 2nd in that category (24), as well as tied for 3rd in hit-by-pitches (10), and fied for 7th in extra-base hits (30)...Ho leads the league in doubles since his debut on April 25...OF Lorenzo Cedrola is in a tie for 4th in the FSL in triples (6) and tied for 8th in steals (16)...INF Jonathan India is tied for 7th in the FSL in runs scored (47), tied for 8th in hit-by-pitches (10), and tied for 7th in triples (5)...INF Alejo López is 3rd in the circuit in hits (94), tied for 3rd in hit-by-pitches (10), tied for 5th in runs scored (48), and 5th in hitting (,284)...OF Stuart Fairchild – who is now with Double-A Chattanooga – was an extra-base hit stud with the 5th-highest slugging percentage (,440) and 8th-best OPS (,775) in FSL...1B Bruce Yari has been patient at the plate, as he is 2nd in pitches seen (1,498) and tied for 5th in walks (42)...He is also tied for 7th in triples (5)...RHP Austin Orewiler leads the league in double plays induced (14) and is tied for the most starts made (18)...He is also 5th in the league in wins (7)...RHP Ryan Nutof still paces the FSL in asves (9) – tied with Dunedin's RHP Brad Wilson (8) for the league's lead in saves since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
