LAST TIME OUT: Tampa rallied for 2 in the 8th and 4 in the 9th, as the Tarpons walked-off the Daytona Tortugas, 8-7, on Monday night at George M. Steinbrenner Field... The Tarpons won it in the bottom of the 9th on a bases-loaded walk to PH Oswaldo Cabrera (0-0, R, RBI, BB), a fielding error, a fielder's choice, and a walk-off single by 2B Diego Castillo (1-5, RBI, 2 SO)... RF Leonardo Molina (2-4, 2 R, 2B, RBI) and CF Estevan Florial (2-4, R, RBI, SO) each posted multi-hit games for Tampa... RHP Kyle Zurak (2.1 IP, BB, SO) earned his 3rd win in relief for the Tarpons... Tortugas' LHP Andy Cox (0.1 IP, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 BB) suffered his 3rd blown save and defeat... Daytona's RHP Mac Sceroler (5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, BB, 5 SO) and Tampa's RHP Clarke Schmidt (5.1 IP, 2 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 6 SO) each collected no-decisions in their starts... The walk-off defeat was the 5th of the year for Daytona.

TONIGHT'S TARPONS STARTER: Tampa is scheduled to give the ball to RHP Miguel Yajure in game two of the series on Tuesday night... The 21-year-old enters the day ranked 2nd in the Florida State League in ERA (2.27). Yajure is also 7th in WHIP (1.14) and 8th in batting average against (.236)... Earned the win in his last start on Thursday night at Fort Myers (6.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 3 SO)... Took the loss in his lone start against Daytona at Jackie Robinson Ballpark on April 13 (6.0 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 2 ER, BB, 3 SO)... Yajure spent his entire 2018 campaign with Low-A Charleston... In 14 starts for the RiverDogs, the right-hander posted a 4-3 mark with a 3.90 ERA (28 ER in 64.2 IP)... Yajure struck out 56 and walked just 15... The Venezuela native missed the entire 2017 season due to injury... Signed by the New York Yankees as an international free agent on March 5, 2015 out of Cabimas, Venezuela.

AUSTIN POWERS: RHP Austin Orewiler has been as good as any pitcher in the Florida State League since he earned his first win of the season on May 10 vs. Lakeland... In 13 starts since that date, the 26-year-old has posted an impressive 7-4 record with a 2.50 ERA (19 ER in 68.1 IP)... Orewiler has yielded just 58 hits, 17 walks, and has struck out 45... The Galveston, Texas native is among the league leaders in several categories since that time frame, too... Orewiler is tied for the FSL lead in double plays induced (10), tied for 2nd in wins (7), 4th in ERA (2.50), 5th in WHIP (1.10), 6th in batting average against (.239), and 8th in innings pitched (68.1)... Entering Tuesday, the Rice University alum leads the circuit throughout the season in double plays produced (14)... He is also tied for 3rd in games started (18) and tied for 5th in wins (7)... Orewiler has also been stellar against the Tarpons, registering a 2-1 record with a 0.53 ERA (1 ER in 17.0 IP) over 3 starts.

IS THAT THE CHATTANOOGA CHOO-CHOO?: The Reds' No. 3 farmhand according to both Baseball America and MLB Pipeline.com and the No. 5 selection in the 2018 MLB Draft, INF Jonathan India was transferred to Double-A Chattanooga on Monday... India went 1-for-3 with a walk in his Double-A debut on Monday night... In 87 games with the Tortugas in 2019, the 22-year-old collected a .256 average (81-317) with 50 runs scored, 15 doubles, 5 triples, 8 home runs, and 30 runs batted in... India added 37 walks and 7 stolen bases, while slashing .256/.346/.410 at the plate... At the time of his promotion, the Coral Springs, Fla. native was tied for fourth in the Florida State League in runs scored (50), tied for 7th in triples (7), and tied for 9th in hit-by-pitches (9) and total bases (130)... India was leading Daytona in runs scored and total bases following Sunday's contest in Lakeland... The former Florida Gator was also 2nd in on-base percentage (.346), slugging percentage (.410), walks (37), and extra-base hits (28)... Additionally, India was tied for 2nd in homers (8) and triples (7), as well as 3rd in hits (81) and tied for 3rd in doubles (15)... The infielder is the 9th member of the 2019 Tortugas to be sent to Double-A at some point this season... He joins: RHP Wendolyn Bautista (5.10: 5.21), RHP Cory Thompson (5.15), RHP Jesse Stallings (5.18), LHP Packy Naughton (5.25), LHP Andy Cox (6.3), RHP Ryan Nutof (6.14), LHP Reiver Sanmartin (6.17), RHP Ryan Lillie (6.21), and OF Stuart Fairchild (6.25; 7.17)... Bautista and Cox have signed returned to the Tortugas... In a corresponding move, Daytona has added INF Bryant Flete from Double-A Chattanooga... He was 1-for-14 with the Lookouts after being signed out of the independent Frontier League's Southern Illinois Miners.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: With 38 games remaining in the 2019 regular season, Daytona remains in the thick of the playoff race in the Florida State League North Division... Entering Tuesday's matchup with Tampa, the Tortugas hold a 15-18 mark in the season's second half... They are currently tied for 3rd in the North Division and are 4.5-games behind the Dunedin Blue Jays for 1st place... Since Dunedin captured the first-half crown in the North, the playoffs could come down to a wild-card berth given to the team with the second-best overall record in the division... Entering the day, Daytona is 50-48 overall, which is good for 3rd place in the overall North Division standings... The Tortugas are 10.5 games behind Dunedin for the best total mark in the division... However, Daytona trails Clearwater by just half-a-contest (0.5 GB) for 2nd place in the total standings... The Fort Myers Miracle were the first-half champions in the South Division, while the Charlotte Stone Crabs currently have a 3.5-game lead over the St. Lucie Mets in the 2nd half race... Daytona has not won a second-half crown since the franchise rebranded prior to the 2015 season... The last time the organization emerged on top in the season's second half was in 2014 when they finished 41-27, 3.5 games ahead of the then-Tampa Yankees... The Tortugas have only once earned a wild-card bid to the playoffs... That came in 2015 when Clearwater won both halves... Daytona was 77-58 overall that season and beat out Tampa by 12.5 games for the playoff spot.

NO YELLING ON THE BUS! The Tortugas will be spending a lot of time on the bus over the next 2 weeks... Starting on Friday, July 19, Daytona will embark on a 13-game 14-day road trip, their longest of the season... The 'Tugas will play 3 games in Lakeland (July 19-21), 3 contests in Tampa (July 22-24), 4 affairs in Kissimmee against Florida (July 25-28), and finish with 3 ballgames in Jupiter (July 30-August 1)... There will also be an off day on Monday, July 29... So far on the lengthy trip, Daytona holds a 2-2 record through 4 games... Daytona has fared well on the road so far this season, tallying a 25-22 mark in official road games... In contests played in visiting ballparks, the Tortugas' clip moves to 24-20... Prior to this run, Daytona's longest road trip this season was 8 scheduled contests from July 5-11 at St. Lucie and Fort Myers... The Tortugas went 2-5 on that trip, as the final game of the Fort Myers series was cancelled due to rain... Since Minor League Baseball's stats portal began in 2005, this is the longest road trip the Daytona franchise has embarked on... The previous long was a 10-game road swing from April 25-May 4, 2017, at Jupiter, Tampa, and Fort Myers... The Tortugas went 5-5 on that trip... Daytona's next home game will not be until Friday, August 2, against the St. Lucie Mets.

THE COMPASS POINTS NORTH: The Tortugas have seen vastly different results depending on which division they go up against... Against fellow North Division squads, Daytona enters Tuesday with an impressive 34-22 record... They are 15-6 in true road games against North Division opponents, excluding the 3-game series against Dunedin that was moved to Daytona due to ballpark renovations at Dunedin Stadium... However, against the South Division, the Tortugas hold a 16-26 clip... Daytona has hit much better against in-division pitching, tallying a .259 average (.477-1844) against the North and just a .228 clip (.326-1427) vs. the South... The Tortugas average 4.77 runs, 8.52 hits, 3.13 walks, and 8.64 strikeouts per contest (56 G) against their division rivals... Versus the South, Daytona's averages dip to 3.26 runs, 7.80 hits, 2.81 walks, and 8.21 strikeouts a game (42 G)... The Tortugas' pitching staff, however, has fared slightly better against the South... Against cross-division opponents, Daytona has a 3.52 ERA (146 ER in 373.2 IP) and yield 8.05 hits, 3.93 runs, 2.95 walks, and 8.17 strikeouts per contest... Taking on the North, the Tortugas hold a 4.09 ERA (223 ER in 490.1 IP) with 8.89 hits, 4.52 runs, 2.86 walks, and 8.63 strikeouts in the average affair.

ANDY'S HIT COLLECTION: OF Andy Sugilio continues to pepper the ball across the diamond for the Tortugas... The 22-year-old had a season-high 10-game hitting streak snapped on July 7... Dating back to the beginning of a homestead on June 25 vs. Tampa, Sugilio had accumulated a .429 average (.18-42) with 9 runs scored, a double, a triple, 4 runs batted in, 3 walks, and 2 stolen bases... During that time, Sugilio slashed .429/.467/.500 with an .967 OPS and a .500 BABIP... The Dominican native has picked up a base-hit in 17-of-his-last-23 games entering Tuesday... In that time, he has tallied a .319 average (.29-91) with 13 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 triples, a home run, 8 RBI, 6 walks, a hit-by-pitch, and 3 stolen bases... Since the beginning of May, the Reds' No. 21 prospect per MLB Pipeline.com is 2nd in the Florida State League in hits (78) and 3rd in batting average (.312).

LEADING THE BALE: Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders through their first 98 games... OF Andy Sugilio enters Tuesday ranked 2nd in the league in hitting (.298) and tied for 4th in hits (96)... After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, SS José García has been a doubles machine and currently 2nd in that category (.25), as well as tied for 4th in hit-by-pitches (10), and tied for 6th in extra-base hits (31)... He leads the league in doubles since his debut on April 25... OF Lorenzo Cedrola is in a tie for 4th in the FSL in triples (6) and hit-by-pitches (10)... INF Jonathan India - who was sent to Double-A Chattanooga on Monday - is tied for 4th in the FSL in runs scored (50), tied for 9th in hit-by-pitches (9) and tied for 7th in triples (5)... INF Alejo López is 3rd in the circuit in hits (98), 5th in hitting (.282), tied for 4th in hit-by-pitches (10) and runs scored (50), and 9th in on-base percentage (.354)... OF Stuart Fairchild - who is now with Double-A Chattanooga - was an extra-base hit stud with the 6th-highest slugging percentage (.440) and 8th-best OPS (.775) in the FSL... 1B Bruce Yari has been patient at the plate, as he is 2nd in pitches seen (1,554) and tied for 3rd in walks (45)... He is also tied for 7th in triples (5)... C Mark Kolozsvary has been plunked by the 3rd-most pitches in the league (11)... RHP Austin Orewiler leads the league in double plays induced (14) and is tied for the 3rd-most starts made (18)... He is also 5th in the league in wins (7)... RHP Ryan Nutof still paces the FSL in saves (9) - tied with Dunedin's RHP Brad Wilson - despite a promotion to Chattanooga in mid-June... LHP Andy Cox is tied with the Michigan alum for the league-lead in saves... The southpaw has the most saves in the league since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
