LAST TIME OUT: Daytona snapped a 4-game losing streak, as the Tortugas toppled the St. Lucie Mets, 4-3, in front of 2,063 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark on Saturday night...C Hendrik Clementina (1-4, 2 RBI, SO) put the Tugas ahead for good with a 2-run single in the bottom of the 6th...3B Bryant Flete (2-3, 2 R, HR, 2 RBI, SO) posted 2 hits, including a 2-run homer in the 3rd...SS José García (2-4, R) and RF Andy Sugilio (2-4, 2B) each compiled multi-hit games...SS Manny Rodríguez (2-3, R, 2B, HR, 2 RBI) registered the only multi-knock night for St. Lucie, adding a 2-RBI blast in the top of the 4th...RHPs Austin Orewiler (5.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO) and Michael Byrne (2.1 IP, SO), LHP Andy Cox (0.2 IP), and RHP Connor Bennett (1.0 IP, SO) combined to retire the final 17 Mets' hitters in-a-row after Rodríguez's homer..Byrne garnered his 5th win in relief, as Bennett tallied his 1st Florida State League save...Orewiler took a no-decision...St. Lucie's RHP Luc Rennie (6.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 3 ER, BB, 5 SO) accrued a quality start depite takingh is 5th loss.

TONIGHT'S METS STARTER: St. Lucie is scheduled to give the ball to RHP Joe Cavallaro in the rubber match on Sunday evening...The 24-year-old earned his 2nd-straight victory in his last start on Tuesday night vs. Palm Beach (5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, BB, 8 SO)...Holds a 2-0 mark with a 3.45 ERA (6 ER in 15.2 IP) and 18 SO in 3 starts since returning to the rotation on July 19...<u>Earned the victory in his lone appearance vs. Daytona on July 4 (4.1 P) H, BB, 2 SO).</u>...Has faired better at home than on the road in 2019...At First Data Field, Cavallaro has accumulated a 3-1 clip with a 2 48 ERA (8 ER in 29.0 IIP), 1 save, and 29 Ks in 12 appearances (2 starts)...On the road, he is 2-2 with a 5.47 ERA (16 ER in 26.1 IP), 2 saves, and 26 SO in 15 outings (1 start)...Spent time with Low-A Columbia, Double-A Binghamton, and St. Lucie in 2018...Was a South Atlantic Leaque Mid-Season All-Star with Low-A Columbia, and a subject of the start of the start

GET RUBBERY: After losing 5-straight rubber matches and 16-of-17 dating back to May 3, 2018, at Jupiter, Daytona has earned 3-straight wins in series-deciding games... The Tortugas walked-off the Tampa Tarpons on July 3, 5-4, in 10 innings and captured another win, 7-3, on the road on July 24... Daytona snapped their skid when they squeaked past Florida, 5-4, at Jackie Robinson Ballpark on June 19... In 8 series-deciding games (3-5). Daytona has only been outscored by a total of 28-26 with 6 one-run affairs (2-4)... Despite a stellar overall season in 2018, Daytonas struggled mightly in rubber matches, accruing a 3-12 record in those affairs... Prior to their triumph against the Fire Frogs, the 'Tugas had not won a series-deciding game in the regular season since a 5-1 win at Dunedin on April 22, 2018... Daytona had previously won a rubber match, 5-3, in Game 3 of the North Division Championship Series on September 6, 2018, vs. Clearwater at Jackie Robinson Ballpark.

CONNECT FOUR: Daytona's lucky number on offense this season has been 4...Entering Sunday's series finale, when the Tortugas score 4-or-more runs in a contest they hold an impressive 48-14 record (.774)...However, when opposing pitching holds them to 3-or-fewer tallies, Daytona's team record dips to 7-40 (.149)...Dating back to July 23, the Tugas have won each of their last 5 contests when they score 4+ runs...Additionally, Daytona has not won when they score less than 3 tallies since they defeated Lakeland, 2-1, in game 2 of a doubleheader on July 13...The Tortugas last 9-inning when when scoring fewer than 3 was on July 9 in Fort Myers, 2-1.

SHOT OF JAMESON: OF Jameson Hannah is Daytona's newest player, as the left-handed swinging outfielder was assigned to the Tortugas roster on Thursday...The 21-year-old went 2-for-4 with a run scored, a single, a triple, and a walk in his Tortugas and Reds' organizational debut on Friday vs. St. Lucie and is 2-for-8 to start his Daytona career. Acquired by the Cincinnati Reds on Wednesday from the Oakland Athletics in exchange for RHP Tanner Roark...Hannah enters Cincinnati's prospect list at No. 7, according to Baseball America...He is considered the organization's 10th-best farmhand by MLBPipeline.com and FanGraphs...Prior to the trade, the Flower Mound, Texas native had spent the entire season with High-A Stockton, slashing .283/341/381 in 92 games for the Ports...Hannah accrued a .283 average (106-375) with 48 R, 25 2B, 3 3B, 2 HR, 31 RBI, and 6 SB in the California League...Before the swap, the outfielder was tied for 2nd in the Cal League in doubles (25) and 4th in hits (106)...Hannah was originally selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 2nd round (60th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist University...Signed with the A's for \$1.8 million.

LORENZO'S OIL: OF Lorenzo Cedrola has been on a tear for Daytona as of late...The 21-year-old enters Sunday on a season-high 11-game hitting streak dating back to the start of the road trip against Lakeland...Since July 20, Cedrola has registered a .432 average (16-37) with a .432/488/.541 slash line...The outfielder has scored 8 runs. tallied 2 doubles, 1 triple, 4 runs driven in, 3 walks, and struck out on just 4 occassions...Cedrola has also been plunked by a pitch during that time and holds a stellar 1.028 OPS...The native of Venezuela also controls a 13-game on-base streak stretching to July 17 vs. Jupiter...He's slashed 386/.449/.477 since the outset of that run. Since the start of the second half, Cedrola has been superb, registering a .306 clip (34-111) with 14 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, 12 RBI, 7 stolen bases, and 8 walks to just 12 strikeouts in 34 games...Since the All-Star Break, Cedrola leads the squad in hitting (.306), on-base percentage (.371).

CUT YOUR LOSSES: For the most part, Daytona has avoided the bad kind of streaking in 2019...With their win on Saturday, the Tortugas snapped a season-high-tying 4-game losing streak starting on July 30 at Jupiter...During the rough patch, the 'Tugas scored only 1 run in 3-of-4 affairs and were outscored 23-6 by the Hammerheads and Mets....Daytona had previously dropped 4-consecutive contests from June 27-30 vs. Tampa and Dunedin, as well from July 4-7 at St. Lucie....Daytona has not lost more than 4 in-a-row since they dropped 5-consecutive contests from August 13-17, 2018 at Lakeland and Tampa.

SO YOU'RE SAYING THERE'S A CHANCE: With 29 games remaining in the 2019 regular season, Daytona remains in the thick of the playoff race in the Florida State League North Division...Entering Sunday's matchup with St. Lucie, the Tortugas hold a '20-24 mark in the season's second half...They are currently 4th in the North Division, but are 2.5-games behind the Dunedin Blue Jays for 1st place...Since Dunedin captured the first-half crown in the North, the playoffs could come down to a wild-card berth given to the team with the second-best overall record in the division...Entering the day, Daytona is 55-54 overall, which has them a tied with the Clearwater Threshers for 2nd place in the overall North Division standings...The Tortugas are 8.5 games behind Dunedin for the best total mark in the division...The Fort Myers Miracle were the first-half champions in the South Division, while the Charlotte Stone Crabs currently have a 35-game lead over the St. Lucie Mets in the 2nd half race...Daytona has not won a second-half crown since the franchise rebranded prior to the 2015 season...The last time the organization emerged on to the interest of the playoffs...That came in 2014 when they finished 41-27, 3.5 games ahead of the then-lampa 'Yankees...The Tortugas have only once earned a wild-card bid to the playoffs...That came in 2015 when Clearwater won both halves... Daytona was 77-58 overall that season and beat out Tampa by 12.5 games for the playoff spot.

SOUTH OF THE BORDER: The Tortugas have seen vastly different results depending on which division they go up against...Against fellow North Division squads. Daytona enters Sunday with an impressive 38-24 record...They are 19-8 in true road games against North Division opponents, excluding the 3-game series against Dunedin that was moved to Daytona due to ballpair renovations at Dunedin Stadium...However, against the South Division, the Tortugas hold a 17-30 clip...Daytona has hit much better against the Horth and just a 232 clip (369-1593) vs. the South...The Tortugas average 4.81 runs, 8.61 hits, 3.06 walks, and 8.50 strikeouts per contest (62 G) against their division rivals... Versus the South, Daytona's averages dip to 3.13 runs, 7.85 hits, 2.77 walks, and 8.21 strikeouts a game (47 G)... The Tortugas' pitching staff, however, has faired slightly better against the South...Against cross-division opponents, Daytona has a 3.66 traf. (169 Er in 415.2 IP) and yield 8.38 hits, 4.66 runs, 2.98 walks, and 8.09 strikeouts per contest... Taking on the North, the Tortugas hold a 3.98 ERA (239 ER in 540.2 IP) with 8.74 hits, 4.39 runs, 2.82 walks, and 8.56 strikeouts in the average affair.

LEADING THE BALE: Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders through their first 109 games...OF Andy Sugilio enters Sunday 2nd in the league in hits (109) and hitting (.298)...After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, SS José García has been a doubles machine and currently leads the FSL in that category (.28)...He is also tied for 5th in hit-by-pitches (11) and extra-base hits (.34)...OF Lorenzo Cedrola is in a tie for 4th in the circuit in triples (7) and 7th in hit-by-pitches (10)...INF Jonathan India – who was sent to Double-A Chattanooga on July 22 – is 7th in OPS (.75) and 8th in slugging (.410)...INF Alejo López is 3rd in the circuit in hits (108), tied for 4th in runs scored (.55), tied for 5th in hit-by-pitches (11), 6th in hitting (.281), and 9th in on-base percentage (.352)... IB Bruce Yari has been patient at the plate, as he is fied for 4th in walks (47) and 5th in pitches seen (1,566)...He is also tied for 8th in triples (5)...C Mark Kolozsvary is tied for the s7d-most hit-by-pitches (12)...RHP Austin Orewiller leads the FSL in games started (21) and is tied for the league-lead in double plays induced (14)...He is also tied for 5th in the league in wins (7) and tied for 6th in innings pitched (107.2)...RHP Ryan Nutof still paces the FSL in saves (9) – tied with Dunedin's RHP Brad Wilson – despite a promotion to Chattanooga in mid-June...LHP Andy Cox is tied with the Michigan alum for the league-lead in saves....The southpaw has the most saves in the league since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
