LAST TIME OUT: Bradenton snagged the opening game of the series on Friday night, as the Marauders defeated the Daytona Tortugas, 5-1, at LECOM Park...The Marauders were led by 1B **Mason Martin** (3-4, 3 R, 2 HR, 3 RBI) who clocked a game-tying solo home run in the 1st and a go-ahead solo blast in the 3rd...LF **Lucas Tancas** (2-2, 2B, 2 BB) and C **Deon Stafford** (2-4, 2 RBI, SO) also registered multi-hit games for Bradenton...2B **Alejo López** (3-5, R, SO) collected a game-high-tying 3 hits for Daytona...DH **Bruce Yari** (1-3, 2B, RBI, BB, SO) drove in the Tortugas' only run with a double in the 1st...RHP **Nick Economos** (6.0 IP, 5 H, R, ER, BB, SO) did not allow a run over his final 5.0 innings of work, earning his 6th win...Daytona's RHP **Mac Sceroler** (7.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO) tossed a season-high 7.0 innings in a quality start, but was saddled with his 4th defeat.

TONIGHT'S MARAUDERS STARTER: Bradenton is slated to send RHP **Gavin Wallace** to the bump in the 2nd game of the series on Saturday evening...Suffered his 3rd-straight defeat in his last start on Sunday afternoon at Lakeland (4.2 IP, 9 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 4 SO)...Has pitched in relief twice against Daytona this season...Last appearing on June 4 (4.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, SO)...Overall has a 1.80 ERA (1 ER in 5.0 IP) and 2 strikeouts...In 11 starts this season, the 23-year-old has accrued a 3-5 mark and a 3.94 ERA (27 ER in 61.2 IP)...In 17 outings out of the bullpen, Wallace is 1-3 with a 4.71 ERA (19 ER in 36.1 IP)...Has pitched much better at home than on the road, compiling a 2-3 clip and a 3.26 ERA (17 ER in 47.0 IP) in 15 outings (5 starts) at LECOM Park...In visiting parks, Wallace is 2-5 with a 5.12 ERA (29 ER in 51.0 IP) over 13 appearances (6 starts)...Split the 2018 campaign between Low-A West Virginia and Bradenton...Began the year with the Power and accumulated a 6-2 record with a 3.69 ERA (31 ER in 75.2 IP) in 14 starts...Was on the disabled list from April 27-May 5...Transferred to Bradenton on July 3 and tallied a 3-4 mark with a 6.32 ERA (40 ER in 57.0 IP) in 10 starts for the Marauders...Selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 15th round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Fairfield (Conn.) University...Signed for \$80,000...Brother, Mike, also pitched at Fairfield and in the Pirates' organization from 2015-18.

THE JACK RUSSELL MARATHON: Thursday afternoon's slugfest between Daytona and the Dunedin Blue Jays resulted in a final score that was more like a contest on a football gridiron than a baseball diamond...That day's 4-hour and 12-minute ballgame featured: 25 total runs scored, 32 combined hits, 23 men left on base, 21 free passes (18 walks and 3 hit batters), 408 total pitches (210 for Daytona; 198 for Dunedin), 10 different pitchers used (6 for Daytona; 4 for Dunedin), and only 1 batter that did not record a hit (Dunedin SS Hugo Cardona; all players reached base at least once)...The 14-run outburst for Daytona marked the most runs they had scored in a single-contest this season...Their previous high was 10 tallies on May 6 vs. Palm Beach and on May 3 at Clearwater...Additionally, the 14 runs scored were the most for the Tortugas since they accomplished the feat in a 14-3 win at Jupiter on April 27, 2017...The Tortugas' 17-hit performance also marked the team's highest output since a 10-inning, 14-13 loss to the Blue Jays at Dunedin Stadium on April 21, 2018...The 4-hour, 12-minute affair marked Daytona's longest game since that 5-hour affair at Dunedin Stadium on the same date...The ballgame was Daytona's longest 9-inning contest since the MLB stat portal began prior to the 2005 campaign...The victory also marked the first time Daytona had won a game where their opponent scored 10+ runs since the franchise rebranded prior to the 2015 season...The last time that occurred was when the then-Daytona Cubs ousted the Palm Beach Cardinals, 16-10, at Jackie Robinson Ballpark on July 24, 2009...That contest featured future MLBers Josh Harrison, Starlin Castro, Brandon Guyer, Marwin González, and Tommy Pham (PMB).

YOUNG, WILD (CARD), & FREE: Entering Saturday's contest with Bradenton, the Tortugas are 1-0 game behind the Clearwater Threshers and Lakeland Flying Tigers for what would be the final playoff spot in the Florida State League North Division with 9 games remaining in the 2019 regular season...Clearwater holds the tiebreaker over Daytona as a result of winning the season-series (4-8), but Daytona has the tiebreaker over Lakeland (11-1)...The wild card comes into play if the Dunedin Blue Jays—who won the first-half crown—wins both halves...Right now, Dunedin is tied with the Lakeland Flying Tigers for 1st in the second-half standings...The wild card is determined by the team with the 2nd-best overall record in the division throughout the entire 2019 regular season...The Fort Myers Miracle were the first-half champions in the South Division, while the Charlotte Stone Crabs' magic number to win the second half title is down to 2...Daytona has not won a second-half crown since the franchise rebranded prior to the 2015 season...The last time the organization emerged on top in the season's second half was in 2014 when they finished 41-27, 3.5 games ahead of the then-Tampa Yankees...The Tortugas have only once earned a wild-card bid to the playoffs...That came in 2015 when Clearwater won both halves...Daytona was 77-58 overall that season and beat out Tampa by 12.5 games for the playoff spot.

SUMMER WINDS BLOWING IN: Although the month of August has been unkind to Daytona record-wise, there have still been several key performers through the final month's first 22 games...SS **José García** has been scalding hot, accumulating a .359 average (28-78) and slashing .359/.412/.513 in 20 games...The 21-year-old has added 12 runs scored, 9 doubles, a home run, and 8 RBI to go along with 4 steals and 5 hit-by-pitches...OF **Drew Mount** has caught fire, too, tallying a .349 mark (15-43) with 4 runs scored and 4 RBI in 13 games...IF **Alejo López** has been solid, entering Saturday hitting at a .325 clip (26-80) with 11 runs scored, a double, 2 triples, and 6 RBI in 21 contests...1B **Bruce Yari** is tallying a .305 mark (18-59) with 9 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, 11 RBI, 17 walks, and a .461 OBP in 18 games...Out of the bullpen, RHP **Michael Byrne** has regained his All-American form...The 22-year-old holds a 1-0 mark with a perfect 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 10.0 IP) and 3 saves...Byrne has issued just 3 hits (.091 BAA) with 11 strikeouts and just 1 walk in his 8 relief outings.

THROUGH THE WIRE: The Tortugas have played a plethora of tight games throughout the course of the 2019 season...Coming into Saturday's showdown, Daytona has played in 50 1-run games during the campaign (39.1%)...In those contests, the Tortugas are even, accumulating a 25-25 record...As expected, Daytona is 17-11 in 1-run contests at home and 8-14 on the road...In 2018, the Tugas battled in 41 contests decided by a run and went 21-20...The Tortugas have official surpassed the most 1-run games played in franchise history, outdoing the 2006 campaign when the then-Cubs embarked in 48 of them (27-21)...The Tortugas have also contested in 21 games that have been decided by exactly 2 runs (14-7)...Overall, 55.5% (71-of-128) of Daytona's games this season have been decided by 2-runs-or-less.

FOUR-MIDABLE: Daytona's lucky number on offense this season has been 4...Entering Saturday's ballgame, when the Tortugas score 4-or-more runs in a contest they hold an impressive 53-16 record (.768)...However, when opposing pitching holds them to 3-or-fewer tallies, Daytona's team record dips to 9-50 (.153)...August 14th's 2-1 triumph over Charlotte was just the 2nd time Daytona had won a 9-inning contest when scoring less than 3 runs since a 2-1 win in Fort Myers on July 9...Prior to a 7-4 win on August 11 over St. Lucie, Daytona had not scored 4+ runs in a 9-or-fewer inning game since they were victorious at Florida, 8-1, in the 1st game of a twinbill on July 26 (15 G)...Additionally, the Tortugas have scored more than 4 runs in a contest just 6 times in their last 28 games going back to that date.

SOUTHERN DISCOMFORT: The Tortugas have seen vastly different results depending on which division they go up against...Against fellow North Division squads, Daytona enters Saturday with an impressive 40-28 record...They are 20-10 in true road games against North Division opponents, excluding the 3-game series against Dunedin that was moved to Daytona due to ballpark renovations at Dunedin Stadium...However, against the South Division, the Tortugas hold just a 22-38 clip...Daytona has hit much better against in-division pitching, tallying a .263 average (594-2255) against the North and just a .237 clip (477-2016) vs. the South...The Tortugas average 4.78 runs, 8.74 hits, 3.10 walks, and 8.34 strikeouts per contest (68 G) against their division rivals...Versus the South, Daytona's averages dip to 3.17 runs, 7.95 hits, 2.80 walks, and 7.70 strikeouts a game (60 G)...The Tortugas' pitching staff has fared slightly better against the South...Against cross-division opponents, Daytona has a 3.88 ERA (227 ER in 526.2 IP) and yield 8.47 hits, 4.27 runs, 3.10 walks, and 8.12 strikeouts per contest...Taking on the North, the Tortugas hold a 4.04 ERA (266 ER in 592.2 IP) with 8.69 hits, 4.40 runs, 2.85 walks, and 8.66 strikeouts in the average affair.

TOP-RANKED 'TUGAS: Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders through their first 128 games...OF **Andy Sugilio** enters Saturday 3rd in the league in hits (128) and batting average (.295), as well as tied for 5th in stolen bases (23), and tied for 9th in runs scored (56)...After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, SS **José García** has been an extra-base hit machine and currently leads the FSL in that category (43) and doubles (36)...He is also 3rd in hit-by-pitches (16), 6th in slugging (.417), 7th in OPS (.753), and tied for 10th in total bases (160)...OF **Lorenzo Cedrola** is in a tie for 5th in the circuit in triples (7) and tied for 8th in hit-by-pitches (12)...INF **Jonathan India**—who was sent to Double-A Chattanooga on July 22—is 6th in OPS (.756), 9th in slugging (.410), and 10th in OBP (.346)...INF **Alejo López** is 2nd in the circuit in hits (132), 2nd in runs scored (64), 5th in batting average (.290), tied for 5th in hit-by-pitches (13), and 7th in on-base percentage (.358)...1B **Bruce Yari** has been patient at the plate, as he is 2nd in walks (64) and 3rd in pitches seen (1,973)...He is also tied for 8th in triples (6)...C **Mark Klotzswary** has the 4th-most hit-by-pitches (15)...C **Hendrik Clementina** enters the day tied for 8th in home runs (12)...RHP **Austin Orewiler** has the FSL-lead in starts made (24) and is tied for the most double plays induced (15)...He is also tied for 6th in innings pitched (119.1) and tied for 7th in the league in wins (8)...RHP **Mac Sceroler** is 3rd in strikeouts (119), 7th in batting average against (.235) and 7th in WHIP (1.15)...RHP **Ryan Lillie** is 5th in BAA (.233), 9th in WHIP (1.17), and 10th in ERA (3.35)...RHP **Ryan Nutof** is still 2nd in the FSL in saves (9) despite a promotion to Chattanooga in mid-June...LHP **Andy Cox** is tied with the Michigan alum for the 2nd-most saves...The southpaw is tied for the most saves in the league since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
