LAST GAME: 7/31 vs. KNG (W, 7-5) NEXT: 8/1 vs. KNG (6:30 ET) LAST TIME OUT: The series began with a surge of five runs in the second inning, but the Miracle would go on to score 11 unanswered runs with six in the sixth inning... Cal Stevenson's 10 game hitting streak game to an end with an 0-5 day, but he still managed to drive in a run. This is the third day in July Stevenson hasn't recorded a hit... Last night was the 10th loss for the Blue Jays when scoring more than 3 runs, their record now sits at 48-10 under those circumstances.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Graham Spraker will be going for a team tying seventh win of the season, and comes in with the team leading 2.45 ERA minimum 65.0 IP. In the second game of the doubleheader, Josh Winckowski will take the hill for the second time against Fort Myers since July 23rd. He gave up five runs on eight hits, when he took on the Miracle, and he looks for his first win since July 4th.

THE STREAK THAT WAS: When the Blue Jays went on an 11 game win streak started on June 28th with a win against the Daytona Tortugas the Blue Jays have led the league in multiple categories. The team had combined for a .287 BA, 93 runs, 22 doubles, 7 triples, 87 RBI, .385 OBP, and a .834 OPS. All of these led the Florida State League in the 11 day stretch. During the streak, Kacy Clemens lead the league in HR at 4, and had a .647 SLG percentage and 1.033 2nd behind Travis Swaggerty of Bradnton. Since the streak has ended; however, the Blue Jays are 5-14 in their last 19 games, and Dunedin is 11th in AVG. (.225), 10th in runs (73), and 12th in hits (125.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: After June 19th's postponment and Clearwater's win, the Blue Jays dropped down to second place in the FSL North Division standings for the first time all season. The Blue Jays spent a total of 67 games and 76 days in first place in the North Division. Dating back to 2005, it marks the most games and the longest amount of days in a row the D-Jays have occupied the top spot in their respective division. Dunedin spent just 12 days in second place regaining their lead on July 2nd. Over the last 30 days, the Blue Jays have been issued the most walks (98), scored the most runs (118), driven in the most runs (108), and have 51 extra-base hits. The Blue Jays were the first team to reach 60 wins in the Florida State League, and the Down East Wood Ducks and Visalia Rawhide were the only teams to reach the 60 win mark faster in High-A.

CHAMPIONS OF THE FIRST HALF: With their victory in game one of a doubleheader with the Fire Frogs on June 11th, Dunedin clinched the first half FSL North Division title and punched their ticket to the Florida State League playoffs in September. The clincher marks the sixth first half title and 15th half title overall in franchise history. The first half title also marks the first time the D-Jays have clinched in the first half since 2014. In the first half the Blue Jays compiled the best run differential at +82 and scored 299 runs with the next closest team having 286. Dunedin also gave up the 2nd fewest runs with 217 in the half.

KINGS OF THE HILL: Dunedin pitching have been dominate all season long with the third best ERA at 3.21, 314 ER in 880.1 IP (2nd). The starters have walked 121 batters while striking out 487 batters. Since coming back from the All-Star break Maximo Castillo has taken over as the ace of the staff on the mound. He has a 3.14 ERA (9th), .238 Opp. BA (10th), and 49 K (4th). Out of the bullpen Emerson Jimenez has the second most wins in the league since June 17th with five wins account for all his wins this year, and he has a 1.13 ERA in his last 11 appearances with a 1.00 WHIP. In contrast, Jimenez had a 4.08 ERA and 1.60 before the All-Star break.

ORIMOLOY-YAY: Demi Orimoloye was named June's Player of the Month for the Florida State League by Minor League Baseball. The Canadian hit a league leading .342 with 21 RBI, 5 HR, .407 OBP, 47 TB, and a 1.051 OPS. His RBI total was tied for the most in the league, and his 47 total bases were good for second. His 1.051 OPS blew away the rest of the field in the month with the next closest player being Trey Harris of the Florida Fire Frogs at .907. His success has continued into July driving in 12 runs including two home runs, and he has scored 17 runs of his own second on the team.

WRECK-IT RYAN: Ryan Noda is currently the league leader in RBI with 58 ahead of Bradenton's Cal Mitchell who has 57. In the month of July alone he has driven in 21 runs, the last player on Dunedin to do that was Demi Orimoloye who won player of the month for June. Noda has the most walks at 52, and he leads the team with 10 home runs. The 1B/OF ranks 6th in OPS (.767), and 5th in OBP (.363).

T.G.I. AUGUST: July was the first losing month of the season for the Blue Jays going 13-14. The Blue Jays had their lowest average runs per game in a month at 4.5. They had a .238 AVG. as a team (188-791), and the pitching staff gave up a 3.59 ERA, allowing 84 ER. <u>Dunedin was 10-8 against teams below .500 in July, and they were 3-6 against teams above .500</u>.
