**ABOUT LAST WEEK:** Dunedin finished the week 4-3 with a series split with Charlotte and taking two of three from the Bradenton Marauders to firm their position in the Florida State League North Division. It was the fourth week in a row Dunedin finished with a winning record.

**PUSH FOR 2,500:** Dunedin comes into the week having won four of five and nine of 13. The Dunedin organization is closing in on **2,500 wins** in franchise history. Dating back to the inception of the Dunedin organization in 1978, the Blue Jays came into play this week with a .522 winning percentage and are in need of **9 wins to reach the 2,500 mark combined between regular and post-season play.** Additionally, Dunedin is just **23** regular season wins away from 2,500 regular season victories in franchise history.

**VIEW FROM THE TOP:** The D-Jays came into play this week with a four game cushion over second place Clearwater in the FSL North Division. When the Blue Jays woke up on Monday, they were holders of the best winning percentage in all of the FSL for the first time since May of 2016 and the best overall winning percentage up and down the entire Toronto Organization.

**WINNING PORTFOLIO:** The D-Jays enter the week with the most wins (38) and highest winning percentage (61 %) in the Florida State League. Additionally, Dunedin has secured the most wins at this point in the season since June of 2012.

**ALL-STAR NODS:** This weekend the FSL All-Star game will commence in Jupiter, FL. RHPs Graham Spraker and Brad Wilson, along with LHP Nick Allgeyer and Infielder Cullen Large were selected to represent the Blue Jays as part of the North Division Squad. The All-Star festivities begin on Friday, June 14th followed by the Home-Run Derby sponsored by Tire Kingdom and the game on Saturday the 15th at 7:05 P.M. at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium in Jupiter, FL.

**WINNING MONTHS:** The Blue Jays entered the week with a winning record for the month of June. After finishing with 19 wins in May and 15 in April, Dunedin has tallied four winning months of the last six dating back to July of 2018.

**SERIES WINS:** Dating back to May 20th, Dunedin has won five of the last six series they've played, including a three game series sweep over rival Tampa and two of three to open up June over Clearwater.

**CLOSE CALLS:** Outside of the lopsided 13-7 loss on Sunday, Dunedin has played in games that have been decided by a margin of two runs or fewer in six of the last eight games entering play this week with five of those games resulting in a Blue Jays victory. Overall, the Blue Jays are 8-5 in one run games and 8-4 in games separated by two runs.

**DOMINATING ON THE HILL:** The pitching staff of the Blue Jays has notched top five rankings in key statistics in 2019. Coming into play this evening, the Blue Jays staff has posted the third best ERA (3.14), third lowest amount earned runs allowed (189), and the lowest amount of walks surrendered (156) in the Florida State League. Additionally, Justin Dillon (1st), Graham Spraker (2nd), and Nick Allgeyer (9th) all rank in the top 10 in Winning Percentage in the Florida State League.

**A WORD FROM THE SKIPPER:** Field Manager Cesar Martin-in his first season as the skipper for the Blue Jays, spoke about the team's performance from this past week---

*\* "It's not easy playing back to back South Division opponents but we played well and winning two of three this weekend puts us in a really good position going forward."*

THE WEEK THAT WAS-June 3rd-9th (4-3)

JUNE 3rd, GAME ONE vs. CHARLOTTE (L, 3-1)

Charlotte defeated Dunedin by the final of 3-1 in game one of a four game set. The pitching combination of **Paul Campbell** and **Jhonleider Salinas** held the D-Jays offense to just three hits on the evening. The right-hander **Campbell** tossed seven quality innings, walking two and striking out eight en route to his fifth win of the season.

JUNE 4th, GAME TWO vs. CHARLOTTE (W, 4-1)

Dunedin defeated the Charlotte Stone Crabs By the final of 1-0 on the strength of **RHP Justin Dillon**'s seven inning, shutout performance. Though not factoring in the decision, **Dillon** was spectacular in seven innings and managed to register six strikeouts. In the bottom of the eighth, Dunedin cracked the scoreboard when **Logan Warmoth** smacked an RBI single. **RHP Dany Jimenez** pitched two scoreless out of the pen and notched the his fourth victory of the season.

JUNE 5th, GAME THREE vs. CHARLOTTE (L, 2-0)

Charlotte held Dunedin scoreless in the ballgame en route to the 2-0 victory. Charlotte scored a run in the first and eighth innings on the RBIs from **Michael Perez** and **Taylor Walls**. **RHP Joe Ryan** secured the win on the mound, striking out eight in 5.1 innings.

JUNE 6th, GAME FOUR vs. CHARLOTTE (W, 8-7)

Dunedin defeated Bradenton by the final of 6-4. The Blue Jays won the Charlotte Stone Crabs in an afternoon affair. The Blue Jays tied and took the lead with two runs in the bottom of the fourth and added insurance with five runs in the seventh. Despite **RHP Brad Wilson** giving up three late runs, the Blue Jays held on for the victory. **Chavez Young** had a huge day at the plate with a solo homerun and three hits total. **Norberto Obeso** notches two RBI, and **Christopher Bec** registered two hits. **RHP Connor Law** picked up the victory out of the pen with two scoreless.

JUNE 7th, GAME FIVE at. BRADENTON (W, 5-4)

Dunedin defeated Bradenton by the 5-4 final in a tightly contested matchup that featured two ties and two lead changes. **Ryan Noda** smacked a solo homerun in the second to open the scoring for Dunedin. Bradenton tied the game in the bottom of the fifth on **Dylan Busby**'s RBI double. The Blue Jays reclaimed the lead in the seventh with two runs, and one more in the eighth but the Marauders ended up scoring three unanswered to knot things back up. In the top of the ninth, the Blue Jays took the lead for good when **Logan Warmoth** scored on a wil pitch. **RHP Dany Jimenez** picked up the win with a four out scoreless performance. Righty **Maximo Castillo** started and tossed six inning for the Blue Jays while Bo Bichette went 0-1 with a couple of walks in a rehab assignment.
