LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, PA (April 27, 2019) -- The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders split action with the Syracuse Mets on Saturday at PNC Field, winning a suspended game 7-6 in ten innings and falling 3-2 in a seven-inning nightcap. Cliff Pennington's walk-off home run in game one capped a RailRiders rally over the Mets, while a late comeback fell short in Saturday's regularly scheduled game.

The RailRiders continued Friday evening's suspended game against the Mets Saturday after 3:05 worth of delays Friday night in which the two teams played one half inning. Friday, Danny Espinosa homered early in the first for the Mets on a line drive to left field during the first inning Friday night.

As play resumed Saturday afternoon, the RailRiders tied the game 1-1 with a run in the bottom of the 2nd. In the top of the third, Carlos Gomez singled on a ground ball to left fielder Zack Zehner. Gregor Blanco and Espinosa both scored, bringing the tally to 3-1. In the bottom of the inning, Zehner singled to right field scoring Ryan Lavanway to bring the RailRiders back to within a run, 3-2.

The tally remained the same until the top of the seventh when Espinosa doubled on a fly ball to center fielder Matt Lipka. Tomas Nido and Blanco scored for Syracuse extending their lead to 5-2. In the bottom of the seventh, the RailRiders rallied to tie the game. Lipka singled on a line drive to left fielder Tim Tebow and Gosuke Katoh scored to cut into the lead and make it 5-3 Syracuse. The next batter was Brad Miller, and the left-hander drilled a home run over the Budweiser RailHouse in right field that cascaded off some branches off trees perched on the mountain- some 482 feet away- evening the score 5-5 and setting up the heroics.

NEWS & NOTES

A MODEST STRETCH: INF/OF Ryan McBroom enters the series against the Syracuse Mets with a 5G hitting streak, looking to track down INF Mike Ford and his season-best 9G hitting streak at some point during this homestand. Over the 5G, McBroom has one hit in each, going 5-for-18 (.278 AVG) raising his average from .261 to .266. As McBroom's streak ended with an 0-for-1 in Game 1 of the twinbill, Gosuke Katoh hit safely in both ends of the doubleheader. He's now at a 6G hitting streak in which he has batted 12-for-22 (.545 AVG) which has raised his season average to .364 which is 8th in the International League. Thanks to his team-best 5 HR and ability to walk, he's also 8th in the league in OBP (.435) and 4th in slugging (.673) which gives him the 2nd best OPS in the league at 1.108 -- just a few points behind Indianapolis' Brian Reynolds (1.181) for the league lead.

TRIPLE THE DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders did not play a single game to completion over the weekend in Buffalo against the Bisons and just had their series-opener against the Syracuse Mets suspended after a half inning Friday night. They entered last weekend's series with a scheduled doubleheader set for Saturday at 1:05 p.m. which was supposed to be the second one of the young season and now they will officially be playing in their second doubleheader Saturday against the Mets. The three postponements against the Bisons are all on the schedule for three dates later in the year when the two teams lock antlers June 3, June 5 and June 27.

MANIA ON MANIA: As the ripples of Vladimir Guererro Jr.'s arrival at PNC Field finally subsided on the banks of Lake Scranton (with his heroics Friday night in Toronto for his MLB debut) and the excitement of Tim Tebow has now descended upon NEPA. The 31-year old former Heisman Trophy winner and NFL QB made his Triple-A debut with the Syracuse Mets earlier in the season. He enters Friday's series opener batting .164 (9-for-55) with 3 2B, 5 RBI and 6 BB (.246 OBP) -- still in search for his first Triple-A home run. Tebow did not play the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, but went 0-for-5 in the first game with a pair of strikeouts and is now batting .150.

RUNNING LIKE CRAZY: Last season's version of the RailRiders recorded 49 SB on 79 tries (62.0%) which was 11 fewer SB than any other team in the league (Lehigh Valley & Gwinnett: 60 SB), and by percentage was the second worst in the league (Louisville, 60.0%). That said, last April was a strong month for SWB on the base paths, going 14-for-15 in SB but only 35-for-64 (54.6%) over the final 115G of the season (1 SB every 3.3G from May 1st onward). The 2019 RailRiders are off to a torrid start, having gone 19-for-22 (86.3%) over the first 18G of the year, including 2 more SB Thursday. Leading the way is OF Billy Burns who is 7-for-7 SB which puts him 1 SB off the IL lead.

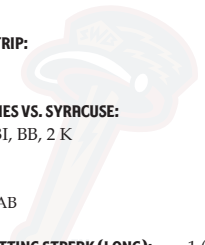
