### LAST TIME OUT...

**DURHAM, NC (June 16, 2019)** -- The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders beat the Durham Bulls 7-3 on Sunday at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. Erik Kratz homered twice as the RailRiders salvaged the series finale and finished their first six-game road trip 3-3.

In the top of the second against opener Cole Sulser, Thairo Estrada singled and Tyler Wade worked an 11-pitch walk. With one out, Logan Morrison singled in Estrada for the RailRiders first lead of the series. Erik Kratz walked to load the bases and Billy Burns followed with a sacrifice fly. Aaron Judge, playing his third game with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on an Allied Integrated Health Systems rehab assignment, singled to left-center to extend the RailRiders advantage to 3-0. Kratz drilled a 2-2 pitch off the top of the right field wall and into the seats, extending the RailRiders lead to 4-2. It was his first home run during the catcher's second stint with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

Durham threatened in the fifth, loading the bases to knock RailRiders starter Chance Adams out of the game. J.P. Feyereisen induced a flyout from Scranton native Joe McCarthy to end the inning and preserve the lead. The Bulls put the tying run on against Feyereisen in the seventh, but Danny Coulombe took over and struck out McCarty on three pitches to end the inning.

Kratz's second home run of the game extended the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre lead to 7-2; a three-run drive to the right field seats with Wade and Ryan McBroom on. Kratz entered without a hit over four games and seven at bats with the RailRiders this year but went 3-for-3 with the two home runs, a single, a walk and four batted in on Sunday.

### NEWS & NOTES

#### INHERITED RUNNERS

**SHUTOUTS:** For just the second time all season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders were shutout Saturday night in front of a Durham Bulls Athletic Park record crowd of 12,000 fans. Five pitchers- including one of the top prospects in the Tampa Bay Rays system, Brendan McKay- combined to hold the RailRiders to a season-low two hits in the effort. The only other game this season in which the RailRiders had been shutout was Game 2 of a doubleheader May 17th @ Toledo in a 5-0 loss. In the 18 innings played in Durham so far this weekend, the team is 10-for-63 (.159 AVG) with 2 2B and a HR (.238 SLG) with the three runs scored coming on just one swing from Giancarlo Stanton in the 3rd inning Friday night.

**RAILREHABBERS:** It was announced early Friday afternoon that OF Giancarlo Stanton and OF Aaron Judge are both rehabbing with the RailRiders and in the lineup beginning Friday night. In three rehab games this season with the Tampa Tarpons- including two earlier this week- Stanton had gone 5-for-10 with 4 HR, 5 RBI and 3 K before homering in his second at-bat Friday night. It was outlined by Aaron Boone that Stanton is expected to complete his rehab assignment and rejoin the Yankees Tuesday. Judge, recovering from a strained oblique, had not yet played in a rehab game before going 0-for-4 with 3 K Friday night in the first game on his road to recovery that will likely overlap with the start of the RailRiders homestand at PNC Field. Stanton and Judge join INF Didi Gregorius and OF Aaron Hicks on the list of Yankees rehabbers for the RailRiders this season. A year ago, SWB had 10 different Yankees play games with them: Greg Bird (INF), A.J. Cole (P), Brandon Drury (INF), Clint Frazier (OF), Aaron Hicks (OF), Tommy Kahnle (P), Billy McKinney (OF), Gary Sanchez (C), Masahiro Tanaka (P), Adam Warren (P).

**HIT STREAKS/ON-BASE STREAKS:** With his 1-for-4 performance Thursday, INF/OF Ryan McBroom has extended his hitting streak to 11 games (15-for-35, .429 AVG) and his on-base streak to 20 games before his streak came to an end Friday night. It is the fourth hitting streak of 10+ games this season for the RailRiders with Breyvic Valera's 14-game streak from 5/23 - 6/7 (24-for-52, .462 AVG) the longest. It is also the second hitting streak of 11 games for McBroom this year, where he hit in 11 straight games 4/27 - 5/14 (19-for-48, .396 AVG). A season ago, only OF Zack Zehner had a hit streak of 10 games, a 10-game streak from 8/16/2018 - 8/26/2018. McBroom's 20-game on-base streak is also the fourth such streak this year by a RailRider, and a season ago the only streak longer than 20 games was INF Brandon Drury's franchise record 32-game streak -- that streak was the longest by anyone in the International League last season.

**POWER STEERING:** INF Mike Ford has shown off a number of hitting tools this season for the RailRiders, prompting his MLB debut earlier in the year. One thing that has taken a big step forward has been his power totals. With a home run in Wednesday's win over the Norfolk Tides, Ford matched his season total from all of last year -- 2019: 42G, 152 AB, 15 HR (10.1 AB/HR) // 2018: 102G, 367 AB, 15 HR (24.5 AB/HR).

**HIGH-WATER MARK:** The RailRiders knocked off the Norfolk Tides 7-6 Wednesday night to improve to 38-25 (.603) and stay percentage points ahead of the Durham Bulls (39-26, .600) for the best record in the league. The RailRiders enter the second game of the weekend series in Durham by trailing the Bulls by a half game in the overall IL Standings. The RailRiders have dropped three consecutive games since getting to the season-best 13 games above .500.

**2018:** Went 0-1 with a 7.04 ERA (7.2 IP, 8 H, 6 ER) in 3G/1GS over three stints with the Yankees (8/4-8/8, 8/22 and 9/12-9/30)... Made his MLB debut on 8/4 at Boston, recording the loss after allowing 3 ER in 5.0 IP (3 H, 2 HR, BB, 2 K) -- Struck out Mookie Betts in the third inning for his first career strikeout... Signed to a MLB contract prior to the game... Became the second player from the Yankees' 2015 draft class to reach the Majors, and the first to make it as a Yankee -- Beaten to the MLB by three days by RHP Cody Carroll, who was traded to Baltimore in the Zach Britton deal 7/24 and made his MLB debut 8/1 with the Orioles at Yankee Stadium... Went 4-5 with a 4.78 ERA (113.0 IP, 60 ER) in 27G/23GS with the RailRiders... Ranked 6th in the International League (min. 100.0 IP) with a 9.00 K/9.0IP ratio (113 K)... Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 6-of-final-9 Triple-A starts after 6/24... Made one relief appearance in the I.L. postseason, tossing a perfect ninth to record the save in Game 1 of the semifinals vs. Lehigh Valley (2 K)... Named as the No. 13 prospect in the NYY organization following the season by *Baseball America*...

**2017:** Combined at Double-A Trenton & Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 15-5 with a 2.45 ERA (150.1 IP, 104 H (.193 BAA), 45R/41ER, 58 BB, 135 K, 11 HR) in 27G/27GS... Made his first six starts of the season with Trenton, going 4-0 with a 1.03 ERA (35.0 IP, 23 H, 6R/4ER, 15 BB, 32 K)... 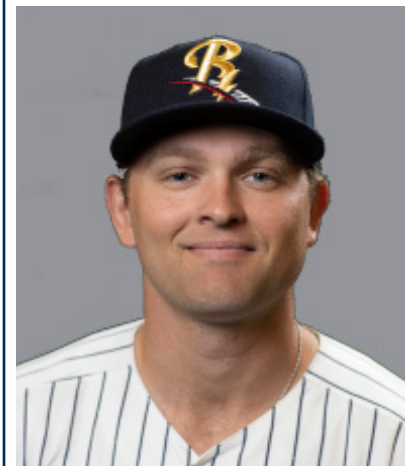
