### PITCHING MATCH-UP

Bollinger: Making his first appearance in affiliated ball since 2013 with Kannapolis (CWS system)

**LEADING OFF:** Scranton/Wilkes-Barre shut out Columbus 9-0 on Monday night. Erik Kratz hit his second home run of the year in the second inning; a solo shot for a 1-0 edge. Two batters later, Ryan McBroom hit a solo home run to extend the lead. The RailRiders added runs on a bases loaded walk in the third and a solo home run by Cody Asche in the fourth. Josh Rogers cruised through seven scoreless innings, striking out seven, and the offense added five more runs between the sixth and eighth innings. Kratz went 4-4, Mike Ford added three hits and Shane Robinson scored three times to help Scranton/Wilkes-Barre even its record on this homestand and go back to a game over .500 overall this season.

**SILENT NIGHT:** Monday's combined shutout effort was the first by Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this season. The RailRiders pitching staff recorded 10 for pitching coach Tommy Phelps last season and a remarkable 23 during Phelps first year running the staff in 2015.

**FLOATING THROUGH:** Columbus is in town for three games; the only series between the RailRiders and the Clippers in Moosic this season. The Clippers were the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate from 1979-2006, but have been with Washington and Cleveland since the Yankees shifted to Northeast Pennsylvania. The Clippers lead the all-time series 155-121.

**NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?** Ryan Bollinger makes his Yankees organizational debut tonight, after being signed as a Minor League Free Agent on 12/16/17. Selected in the 47<sup>th</sup> round of the 2009 MLB Draft by the Philadelphia Phillies as a first baseman, Bollinger transitioned to the mound in 2010, where he has a 35-32 career record with a 4.14 ERA in 554.2 IP. The well-traveled southpaw also pitched for three seasons in the Chicago (AL) system (2011-13), for four independent teams in three leagues, and split the 2017 campaign overseas with the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League and the Munich-Haar Disciples of the German 1. Baseball-Bundesliga, where he set a league record for strikeouts and won the Pitcher of the Year Award. The club was at 24 active, so no countermove was required.

**FOUR!** Erik Kratz went 4-4 last night with a walk and his second home run of the season. It was the catcher's second four-hit game at any level during his 17-year professional career. Kratz's only other four-hit game was in the International League during the 2014 season; June 28, 2014, against Syracuse while playing for Buffalo.

**WADE AT THE TOP:** Tyler Wade was optioned to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Monday. He was batting .086 for New York this season with three hits over 35 at bats. Wade appeared in 85 games for the RailRiders last season, batting .310 with seven home runs and 31 runs batted in. MiLB.com tabbed Wade as an end-of-season Yankees Organizational All-Star for his efforts with the RailRiders. The utility man hit in the leadoff spot for the RailRiders Monday.

**25-1-2+1: Joe Harvey** was promoted from Trenton on Sunday, putting the roster at 23 active players for the Toledo series finale. Harvey did not factor in a decision for Trenton, but did appear in five games and posted a 1.80 ERA. After Jonathan Holder (recalled Saturday, David Hale and Gleyber Torres were promoted over the weekend, the addition of Harvey put the active roster two short.

**OFF THE RAILS:** Gleyber Torres was recalled by the New York Yankees Sunday morning and made his Major League debut in the Yankees win over Toronto, going 0-4... David Hale was designated for assignment on Monday after the Yankees game. The right-hander signed a Minor League contract in January and made three starts for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, but was DFA'd to clear a 40-man roster spot for the recently acquired A.J. Cole...

**AROUND THE ORGANIZATION:** The Yankees whipped the Minnesota Twins 14-1 at Yankee Stadium as Miguel Andujar hit one of four home runs for the Bronx Bombers and Gleyber Torres collected his first big league hit... Trenton defeated Harrisburg 3-1. Erik Swanson turned in seven innings of one-run ball, striking out 11... Tampa scored four in the top of the seventh to defeat Bradenton 6-4... Charleston's game with Columbia was postponed.
