LAST TIME OUT...

With Josh Rogers, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders didn't need much in the way of offense en route to a 3-1 win over the Pawtucket Red Sox before a crowd of 5,500 screaming schoolkids on Education Day.

Rogers had his start bumped back and hadn't pitched in a week, but he showed no signs of the extra layoff in his start Thursday morning. He tossed 6.1 innings and scattered four hits while striking out six men. The only run he allowed was after exiting with the bases loaded and one out.

J.P. Feyereisen did well entering in back of Rogers, inheriting a sticky situation from his starting pitcher. But left to his own devices, the right-hander combined with Cale Coshow for a scoreless 2.2 innings out of the bullpen. Coshow fired a scoreless, perfect 9th inning on just 14 pitches to notch his second save of the season.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre opened the scoring in the top of the first off Paw Sox starting pitcher Justin Haley. Tyler Wade singled and advanced to second on a wild pitch. Greg Bird, appearing in his fourth game with the RailRiders on a Major League rehab assignment, singled to right, driving in Wade for a 1-0 advantage. The RailRiders added a run in the third when Wade doubled in LJ Mazzilli for a 2-0 edge and extended their lead to three runs with three straight base hits in the sixth.

NEWS & NOTES

GOOD IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD: RailRiders LHP Josh Rogers tossed 6.1 innings of one-run baseball Thursday morning, good for his 5th quality start of the season. He has made 9 starts (tied with Chance Adams for most on the team) and has as many quality starts (5) and outings of 6.0+ IP (6) as the rest of his teammates in the other 36 games combined.

IMPRESSIVE ARMS: The bullpen has been a point of strength for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders this season, having posted a 14-9 record and a 2.71 ERA over 159.2 IP with 180 K (10.1 K/9). There are seven bullpen-exclusive arms on the roster for the RailRiders at the moment- minus Nestor Cortes (6G/4GS)- and they all have ERA's under 3.10 this season. POWERING UP: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders approach the end of the month of May riding a power surge. In May SWB has played 22 games and has gone 11-11 compared with a 10-13 April. With some room still to improve, the power numbers have turned on in a big way for the lineup with 24 HR in the month compared to 15 HR in 23G in April.

MORE BIG LEAGUE HELP: INF Greg Bird, OF Billy McKinney and RHP Tommy Kahnle were on the roster for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders Wednesday and Thursday in their back-to-back wins over the Pawtucket Red Sox. They are the 4th, 5th and 6th big leaguers to rehab injuries with SWB this season trying to make it back to the majors. Earlier this season OF Aaron Hicks (3G), INF Brandon Drury (11G) and OF Clint Frazier (2G) have all played game for the RailRiders as MLB rehabbers.

SHEFFIELD-ING GOOD: In his Triple-A debut, the Pawtucket Red Sox scored twice off of LHP Justus Sheffield in the first few batters and had a 2-0 lead with two outs in the 1st inning. Including Wednesday night's four scoreless innings the lefty is up to 11.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run: 11.2 IP, 5 H (5-for-40, .125 BAA), 0 R, 6 BB, 14 K.
