LAST TIME OUT...

The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell to the Syracuse Chiefs 10-3 on Saturday afternoon at PNC Field. Adam Warren made a rehab start walking two batters, hitting another two, and allowing a Jason Wilson bases clearing triple before recording an out. Warren threw 30 pitches and was relieved after completing 0.2 innings by Cale Coshow, but the Chiefs had grabbed a 4-0 lead.

The RailRiders responded with a run of their own in the bottom of the first when Clint Frazier bashed a one-out triple and Brandon Drury knocked him in with an RBI single cutting the deficit to 4-1.

Erik Swanson took over for Coshow, throwing 5.0 innings allowing two unearned runs on four hits, one walk, and one strikeout. The runs came home following a bases-empty, two-out error to extend the inning. It was Swanson's second outing since being called up from Double-A Trenton last week.

In the bottom of the third Scranton/Wilkes-Barre loaded the bases thanks to a one-out walk by Frazier and singles by Drury and Ford. A sacrifice fly to deep left field from Kyle Higashioka scored the second RailRiders run. Syracuse added four runs to their total in the top of the ninth on an RBI double by Yadiel Hernandez, a groundout by Gosewisch, and a two-run homerun by Gonzalez. Chris Smith, Josh Edgin, and Jimmy Cordero finished off the win in relief for the Chiefs, combining to throw 3 innings, allowing one run on two hits.

NEWS & NOTES

GOOD IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD: RailRiders LHP Josh Rogers tossed 6.1 innings of one-run baseball Thursday morning, good for his 5th quality start of the season. He has made 9 starts (tied with Chance Adams for most on the team) and has as many quality starts (5) and outings of 6.0+ IP (6) as the rest of his teammates in the other 38 games combined.

IMPRESSIVE ARMS: The bullpen has been a point of strength for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders this season, having posted a 14-9 record and a 3.03 ERA over 175.1 IP with 193 K (10.1 K/9). There are eight bullpen-exclusive arms on the roster for the RailRiders at the moment- minus Nestor Cortes (7G/4GS)- and 7-of-8 have ERA's under 3.10 this season. POWERING UP: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders approach the end of the month of May riding a power surge. In May SWB has played 24 games and has gone 11-13 compared with a 10-13 April. With some room still to improve, the power numbers have turned on in a big way for the lineup with 25 HR in the month compared to 15 HR in 23G in April.

MORE BIG LEAGUERS: INF Greg Bird, OF Billy McKinney and RHP Tommy Kahnle were on the roster for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders Wednesday and Thursday in their back-to-back wins over the Pawtucket Red Sox, and RHP Adam Warren got the ball to start Saturday for SWB. He will be the 7th big leaguer to rehab injuries with SWB this season trying to make it back to the majors. Earlier this season OF Aaron Hicks (3G), INF Brandon Drury (11G) and OF Clint Frazier (2G) have all played game for the RailRiders as MLB rehabbers.

SHEFFIELD-ING GOOD: In his Triple-A debut, the Pawtucket Red Sox scored twice off of LHP Justus Sheffield in the first few batters and had a 2-0 lead with two outs in the 1st inning. Including Wednesday night's four scoreless innings the lefty is up to 11.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run: 11.2 IP, 5 H (5-for-40, .125 BAA), 0 R, 6 BB, 14 K.

Allowed three runs on two hits over 5.2 IP in 4/22 no-decision against Toledo... Only two runs allowed 5/4 vs. PAW were a pair of solo HR by Michael Ohlman...

2017: Combined at Double-A Trenton & Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 15-5 with a 2.45 ERA (150.1 IP, 104 H (.193 BAA), 45R/41ER, 58 BB, 135 K, 11 HR) in 27G/27GS... Led NYY MiLB in wins, 3rd in ERA and 3rd in K... Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 22-of-27 GS... First six starts of the season with Trenton: 4-0 with 1.03 ERA (35.0 IP, 23 H, 6R/4ER, 15 BB, 32 K)... Promoted to SWB 5/13 and went 11-5 with a 2.89 ERA (115.1 IP, 81 H, 39R/37ER, 43 BB, 103 K) in 21G/21GS... Recorded the lowest BAA in the International League (.197), 4th in WHIP (1.08) and 5th in ERA (2.89)... Attended Yavapai College (Prescott, AZ) for two years before transferring to Dallas Baptist University... Yavapai College was crowned 2016 NJCAA National Champions June 4th when the RoughRiders secured a 5-2 win over San Jacinto in the NJCAA World Series held in Grand Junction, CO... Other notable alumni from Yavapai College: Kyle Blanks, Kole Calhoun, Ken Giles, Curt Schilling... Went 7-1 with a 1.98 ERA (59.0IP, 13ER) in 23 relief appearances in his only season with Dallas Baptist (Missouri Valley Conference)... No. 1 seed as a host in the Dallas Regional, but knocked off by (4)VCU 7-2 in the opener and lost again four games later as (4)VCU advanced to the Super Regionals before being swept by No. 5 overall national seed, Miami (FL)... Notable alumni from Dallas Baptist University: Vic Black, Lew Ford, Ryan Goins, Les Lancaster, Jason LaRue, Freddy Sanchez, Ben Zobrist... Also had interest from University of Tennessee, University of Louisiana-Monroe and Vanderbilt University... Made the NCAA Tournament in the 11 years leading up to his arrival (2003-2011) and in the two years since (2016-2017), including finishing this regular season ranked No. 11...
