SETTING THE SCENE: The JetHawks host the 2018 California League All-Star Game tonight at The Hangar...marks the 3rd All-Star Game hosted by Lancaster all-time and the 35th-consecutive year the Cal League has hosted or played in an All-Star Game...tonight's events begin with the Home Run Derby at 5 p.m. with the California League Hall of Fame Induction ceremony scheduled for 6:30 p.m.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The California League All-Star Game marks the halfway point of the circuit's season...the Stockton Ports finished the 1st Half with the league's best record at 44-26 to claim the North Division's 1st-Half title, their 1st since becoming an Oakland affiliate in 2005...the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes outlasted the rest of the South Division and won a tight 1st-Half race with a 35-35 record.

REPRESENT: The host JetHawks lead the South Division roster with 9 All-Star selections including 3 starters...Modesto leads the North with 9 players representing the Nuts including a league-high 4 starters.

HOMETOWN 'HAWKS: The 9 Lancaster players on the South Division roster are OF Vince Fernandez, IF Roberto Ramos, RHP Rico Garcia, RHP Alexander Guillen, RHP Heath Holder, RHP Reid Humphreys, RHP Justin Lawrence, IF Alan Trejo and IF Colton Welker.

ON THE HILL: Lake Elsinore RHP Reggie Lawson gets the start on the mound for the South Division...entered the season as the No. 28 ranked prospect in the San Diego system according to Baseball America...went 5-2 in the 1st Half and ranks 4th in the league with a 2.61 ERA...Visalia RHP Emilio Vargas starts for the North Division...enters the break leading the league with a 1.04 ERA and has amassed 89 strikeouts in 69.0 IP.

MR. MANAGERS: The Lancaster field staff led by manager Fred Ocasio is leading the South Division squad tonight...Ocasio is in his 2nd season as Lancaster's manager and his 4th season overall in the Cal League (previously managed Modesto for 2 seasons)...Mitch Canham and Modesto's field staff lead the North Division team...Canham's Modesto club swept Lancaster in the 2017 Cal League Championship Series...2018 marks Canham's 2nd season at the helm in Modesto.

MARIACHI MASHER: Lancaster IF Roberto Ramos leads the group of 5 All-Stars who are taking part in tonight's Home Run Derby...leads the league with 17 home runs and a 1.051 OPS...Quakes IF Rylan Bannon is 2nd in the league with 15 home runs...both Ramos and Bannon have recorded 3-home run games this season...Lake Elsinore IF Hudson Potts (10 HR), San Jose IF Jalen Miller (7 HR) and Stockton C Jonah Heim (6 HR) round out the derby lineup.

HALL OF FAMERS: The California League is welcoming 4 new members into its Hall of Fame this year...MLB Hall of Famer Roberto Alomar won the league's batting title (.346) with the Reno Padres in 1986 before going on to becoming one of the game's greatest second basemen...Lenn Sakata holds the record for most wins (757), championships (3) and consecutive winnings seasons (8) during a terrific run with San Jose in the 2000s...MLB Hall of Famer Joe Morgan and former MLB pitcher Larry Jackson (veteran's ballot) round out this year's inductees.

HANGAR HISTORY: The Hangar first hosted the California League All-Star Game in 1998...it hosted the California vs. Carolina League All-Star Game in 2001...last year's game was played at Visalia's Recreation Park.
