2019-20 Season in Review

Season in Review:

NEW ERA

On November 27, 2019 David Cuniff was named the second ever General Manager/Head Coach in franchise history. It was a homecoming for Cuniff who had spent eight seasons from 2006-14 with the Worcester Sharks as an assistant and associate coach. Cuniff coached his first game as a member of the Worcester Railers on November 27, 2019 in a 4-1 loss vs. the Newfoundland Growlers at the DCU Center and picked up his first win on November 29, 2019 in a 6-4 win over the Newfoundland Growlers at the DCU Center.

LET THE HATS FLY

It took 161 games in franchise history to see the first ever regulation hat trick as Dante Salituro broke the drought on November 27, 2019 with a goal in each period in a 6-4 win over the Newfoundland Growlers. Then ten games later Shane Walsh recorded his first professional hat trick with a goal in all three periods on December 21, 2019 in a 7-3 win over the Brampton Beast, which was the most goals scored in a single game by Worcester during the 2019-20 season.

HEY SHORTY

The Railers finished the 2019-20 season 4th in the ECHL with 12 short-handed goals. The 12 short-handed goals were just one shy of the single season franchise record of 13 during the 2017-18 season. Nic Pierog led the club with five short-handed goals ranking him tied for first in the ECHL. The five short-handed goals also set a franchise record for most short-handed goals in a season which was previously held by Chris Langkow who collected four during the 2017-18 season.

GORDIE HOWE HAT TRICKS

In his Worcester Railers debut veteran forward Kyle Thomas recorded a Gordie Howe Hat Trick on Opening Night October 12, 2019 in a 5-1 victory over the Adirondack Thunder. Rookie forward Ross Olsson registered the second Gordie Howe Hat Trick of the season with two goals, an assist, and a fighting major on January 5, 2020 in a 5-3 win over the Jacksonville Icemen at the DCU Center.

COMING OVER FROM THE DARK SIDE

A year after leading the Manchester Monarchs in goals with 32, 11 of which came against Worcester, forward Nic Pierog inked a deal with the Bridgeport Sound Tigers on July 11, 2019. He led the Railers in goals (22), shots (203) which was 4th in the ECHL and was also second on Worcester with 35 points. Pierog skated 13 games for the Bridgeport Sound Tigers in the American Hockey League (AHL) where he notched his first AHL point on November 1, 2019 at Syracuse in a 5-1 loss and scored his first AHL goal on November 6, 2019 in a 1-0 win over the Springfield Thunderbirds. Pierog ended the 2019-20 season with Bridgeport registering two goals and an assist in his last four games.

IN'S AND OUT'S

During the 2019-20 season the Worcester Railers saw 45 different players don the Railers uniform, 20 of which were rookies. In the last game of the season on March 10, 2020 in a 5-4 win at Adirondack the Railers dressed 12 rookies and of the 18 players dressed that night only six were on the Opening Night roster.

IRON MAN

Rookie defenseman Justin Murray finished as the team's "Iron Man" playing in 51 consecutive games to end the season. The London, ON native skated in 59 games during his rookie campaign collecting 10 points (2-8-10) along with four fighting majors which was tied for second on the club.

AHL EXPERIENCE

Seven different players on the Railers roster made appearances in the American Hockey League this season. Kyle Thomas signed a PTO with the San Diego Gulls on December 26, 2019 and skated in two games for the Gulls before being sent back to Worcester. Nic Pierog (13, 3-2-5), Ben Thomson (5, 0-1-1), Arnaud Durandea (21, 5-3-8), Mike Cornell (25, 0-2-2), and Jakub Skarek (16GP, 3-10-1, 3.27, .888) all appeared with the Bridgeport Sound Tigers. Also playing for the Bridgeport Sound Tigers was Ryan MacKinnon (8, 0-1-1) who made his AHL debut on October 12, 2019 at Charlotte.

TOUGH GUY TURCS

For the third consecutive season Railers forward Yanick Turcotte led the Railers in penalty minutes with 153 which ranked third in the ECHL. Turcotte who was sidelined due to injury during the season played in 30 games tallying 10 points (1-8-9) which included a career long four game point streak from December 21, 2019 until January 10, 2020.

17 SECONDS

Rookie forward Ross Olsson set a franchise record on January 5, 2020 in a 5-3 win over the Jacksonville Icemen scoring a pair of goals 17 seconds apart from one another. Olsson scored his fifth goal of the season at 12:40 of the third period and then his sixth goal at 12:57 of the final frame.

CALLIN GETS HOT

Rookie forward Drew Callin was held pointless for his first ten game of the season and registered just four points (1-3-4) in his first 16 contests. Callin would finish the season with 21 points (13-8-21) in his final 38 games ranking tied for third with 14 goals highlighted by an overtime winner vs. the Maine Mariners on March 8th.

OH CAPTAIN MY CAPTAIN

In his eighth professional season Captain Barry Almeida would lead the Worcester Railers in scoring with 37 points (16-21-37). Almeida's 21 assists were first on the club as well as his 10 multi-point performances. The Springfield, MA native scored the first Railers short-handed goal of the season on November 14, 2019 vs. the Brampton Beast in a 5-2 loss and his 50th goal as a Railer on December 18, 2019 vs. the Allen Americans in a 5-4 loss. He currently ranks first all-time in franchise history in games played (192), goals (60), assists (90), and points (150).



2019-20 Game by Game Summaries

10/12/19 Adirondack 1 at Worcester 5

Jordan Samuels-Thomas scored the first goal of the Worcester Railers third season of play in front of 8,137 fans on Opening Night at the DCU Center in a 5-1 Railers victory over the Adirondack Thunder on Saturday night. Waltham, MA native Kyle Thomas registered a Gordie Howe Hat Trick in his Worcester debut while JD Dudek scored his first professional goal. 19-year-old netminder Jakub Skarek made 24 saves in net for the Railers in his North American pro debut.

10/18/19 Maine 2 at Worcester 3 (SO)

Kyle Thomas tied the score at 2-2 with just 2:09 to play in regulation and Nic Pierog scored the lone goal in the shootout while Jakub Skarek stopped all three shooters en route to the Railers second straight victory on Friday night. Tanner Pond scored his first goal as a Railer as Worcester was able to come back after going down 2-0 12:44 into the first period thanks to a pair of goals from Dillan Fox. Jakub Skarek made 24 saves in net for his second straight victory.

10/19/19 Worcester 2 at Adirondack 3

Despite having a 2-1 lead going into the third period thanks to goals from Tanner Pond and Cody Payne's first professional goal, Worcester surrendered two goals in the final frame falling 3-2 in their first road game of the season Saturday night in Glens Falls, NY. Kelly Summers provided the game winning goal for the Thunder with just 3:45 left in regulation as Eamon McAdam made 33 saves in net for Adirondack picking up the win vs. his former team.

10/25/19 Worcester 4 at Adirondack 1

Linus Soderstrom made 25 saves in net for Worcester at the Cool Insuring Arena in his professional debut on Friday night as the Railers led all game en route to a 4-1 win over the Thunder. Nic Pierog scored his first goal as a Railer at 7:33 of the middle frame and also provided the empty-netter while Barry Almeida and Ryan Hitchcock each collected two assists. Both Tanner Pond and Connor Doherty recorded fighting majors.

10/26/19 Worcester 2 at Brampton 5

In Worcester's first tip across the border they suffered a 5-2 loss on Saturday night vs. the Brampton Beast at the CAA

Centre. Rookie defenseman Justin Murray picked up his first fighting major while both goals came on the power-play for the Railers thanks to Jordan Samuels-Thomas and Cody Payne as the club finished 2-for-5 on the man advantage. Unfortunately, the Beast grabbed two power-play scores of their own, one from Chris Clapperton who finished the game with two goals and two assists.

10/27/19 Worcester 0 at Brampton 6

Worcester suffered their worst loss of the season Sunday afternoon getting thrashed by the Beast 6-0 in Brampton. The game featured 66 penalty minutes in which the Beast would go 3-for-10 on the man advantage. Kyle Thomas and Jake Bolton were the only players for the Railers to not finish with a minus.

11/1/19 Newfoundland 2 at Worcester 5

The defending Kelly Cup Champions the Newfoundland Growlers scored three goals in a span of 3:42 seconds in the middle stanza on Friday night in a 5-2 victory over the Railers at the DCU Center. JD Dudek and Barry Almeida (PPG) each scored their second goals of the season while Almeida also added an assist. Linus Soderstrom made 32 saves in net, 14 of which came in the final 20 minutes of play.

11/2/19 Adirondack 2 at Worcester 0

Worcester dropped their fourth straight game on Saturday night in front of 4,806 at the DCU Center on W6 Tribute Night 2-0 to the Adirondack Thunder. Evan Buitenhuis made 28 saves in net for the loss while Mike Szmatala scored at 8:30 and Robbie Payne at 14:24 for Adirondack in the third period.

11/8/19 Worcester 5 at Adirondack 4 (SO)

The Railers snapped their four-game losing streak with a 5-4 shootout win in Glens Falls, NY on Friday night as JD Dudek provided the shootout winner. Shane Walsh potted his first as a Railer at 10:45 of the first frame and also scored in the shootout while Evan Buitenhuis picked up his first win of the year in net making 43 saves and stopping three of the four Thunder players in the shootout. Ross Olsson scored his first goal of the year and on the same sequence picked up his second Fighting major of the season. It was a bloody affair with a total of 70 penalty

minutes as it was the fifth time the Thunder and the Railers had met in just the ninth game of the season for Worcester.

11/10/19 Worcester 2 at Adirondack 6

In front of a ruckus crowd at the Cool Insuring Arena on Sunday afternoon Worcester allowed two goals in the opening 6:30 eventually falling 6-2. Jake Linhart provided four assists for Adirondack while Cody Payne and Matt Schmalz recorded goals for the Railers. Linus Soderstrom made a career high 39 saves and defenseman Jack Stander made his Railers debut.

11/13/19 Reading 6 at Worcester 4

On Wednesday morning Worcester hosted their annual school day game in front of 6,718 and Ryan MacKinnon who had been loaned from the Bridgeport Sound Tigers that same day provided a five on three power-play goal and two assists in a 6-4 loss to the Reading Royals. Kyle McKenzie scored his first goal of the season which also happened to be his 100th professional game and Cody Payne extended his point streak to three games with an assist. Barry Almeida collected three assists for his team leading fifth multi-point game of the year.

11/14/19 Brampton 2 at Worcester 5

Cody Payne extend his point streak to four games with his fourth goal of the year while Barry Almeida scored the first short-handed goal of the season for Worcester on Thursday night at the DCU Center in a 5-2 defeat. Jackson Leef would break a 2-2 for the Beast at 7:37 of the third stanza which was followed by goals from Dan Leavens at 8:44 and David Vallorani at 16:38. The Railers allowed the Beast to just 21 shots but surrendered their third straight loss.

11/17/19 Worcester 3 at Brampton 8

Worcester allowed a season high eight goals on Sunday afternoon at the CAA Centre in a 8-3 loss to the Brampton Beast. The Railers trailed 6-1 midway through the second period and cut the deficit down to 6-3 with scores from Bo Brauer 19:54 of the second and Jordan Samuels-Thomas 15:42 of the third. Francois Beauchemin capped off a hat trick for the Beast with 1:03 to play in regulation as the Railers losing streak hit four games. Jakub Skarek was pulled

after 20 minutes allowing four goals on 12 shots. Evan Buitenhuis came in relief and made 24 saves on 28 shots. Worcester has now dropped eight of their last nine games.

11/24/19 Adirondack 4 at Worcester 1

Barry Almeida scored his fourth goal of the season but the Railers fell for the ninth time in their last ten games this time losing to the Adirondack Thunder 4-1 on Sunday afternoon at the DCU Center in front of 4,351 people. Blake Thompson put the Thunder up 2-1 at 8:55 of the third stanza and James Henry extended the lead to 3-1 with just 4:21 to play. Ross Olsson registered his third fighting major of the year scrapping Alex Carrier in the second period while Mike Cornell picked up his first fighting major of the year coming in the third period against Kelly Summers after Summers delivered a blow to Barry Almeida. Eamon McAdam recorded his second win of the year against his former club making 22 saves on 23 shots.

11/26/19 Worcester 4 at Maine 5 (OT)

Worcester recorded a point but dropped their sixth straight game on Tuesday night in Portland against the Maine Mariners in a 5-4 overtime loss. The Railers trailed 1-0, 2-1, 3-2, but took a 4-3 lead on Nic Pierog's third score of the season with just 47 seconds left in the second period. Ryan Gropp tied the game at 4-4 at 13:59 of the third frame while Alex Kile provided the game winner at 3:53 of overtime. Matt Schmalz registered a season high and a game high three points with a goal and two assists.

11/27/19 Newfoundland 4 at Worcester 1

Earlier in the morning on Wednesday, November 27, 2019 the Railers announced they had relieved GM/HC Jamie Russell and Derek Army of their duties and taking over as GM/HC would be David Cuniff. Worcester would fall in Coach Cuniff's debut 4-1 to the Newfoundland Growlers as Matt Schmalz collected his 5th score of the year tying him for first on the club and registering goals in back to back games. Barry Almeida served as an assistant coach for the first time as he was sideline due to injury.

11/29 Newfoundland 4 at Worcester 6

Dante Salituro cashed in on the first regulation hat trick in team history as

Worcester defeated Newfoundland 6-4 on Friday night at the DCU Center in front of 3,150 people for Coach Cuniff's first win behind the bench. Jordan Samuels-Thomas (1-2-3), Nic Pierog (0-2-2), and Connor Doherty (0-2-2) all recorded multi-point games while Evan Buitenhuis made 23 saves in 27 shots for his first win at the DCU center since January 12, 2019. The win snapped the Railers seven game losing skid.

11/30/19 Indy 4 at Worcester 2

Worcester wrapped up five games in a seven day stretch falling to the Indy Fuel 4-2 on Saturday night in the first ever meeting between the two franchises on Nickelodeon Night. Jordan Samuels-Thomas scored on a penalty shot at 6:39 of the second period for his team leading seventh score of the campaign. Former Manchester Monarch Charles Williams picked up the win for the Fuel making 28 saves on 30 shots as Worcester finished the month of November just 2-9-1.

12/4/19 Worcester 2 at Brampton 0

Evan Buitenhuis made 30 saves in front of 5,020 on Wednesday morning at the CAA Centre as the Railers picked up their first shutout of the year taming the Beast 2-0. Nic Pierog netted the third Railers short-handed goal of the year, his first, while Dante Slaituro added his fourth goal in five games as a Railer. Jordan Samuels-Thomas assisted on both of the scores extending his point streak to three games as he leads the club with (7-10-17).

12/6/19 Worcester 5 at Newfoundland 7

In their first game in Newfoundland of the season Worcester allowed six third period goals in a 7-5 loss to the Growlers on Friday night at the Mile One Centre. The Railers led 5-3 at 11:05 of the third period after Matt Schmalz's sixth goal of the season but the Growlers would score three goals in a 2:02 span from 12:15-14:17 of the third period, two of which were short-handed. Nic Pierog and Jordan Samuels-Thomas each scored short-handed goals for Worcester as Samuels-Thomas extended his point streak to four games. Kyle McKenzie finished a career high +5 for Worcester but Newfoundland picked up their seventh straight win on home ice as they scored two short-handed goals and two power-play goals.

12/17/19 Worcester 2 at Newfoundland 3

Worcester allowed three power-play goals on Saturday night in Newfoundland coming up short in a 3-2 loss to the Growlers. Jordan Samuels-Thomas scored extending his point streak to five games with a goal while Kyle Thomas scored the other Railers goal. Marcus Power scored twice for the Growlers and tabbed the eventual game winner at 3:19 of the third period. Evan Buitenhuis was named the number three star making 32 saves on 35 shots which included 16 stops on 16 shots in the first 20 minutes.

12/13/19 Maine 4 at Worcester 2

Barry Almeida scored his fifth goal of the year in his return after missing the last seven games due to injury, but Worcester dropped their third straight game on Friday night 4-2 at the DCU Center to the Maine Mariners. Kyle Thomas scored the other Worcester goal extending his point streak to three games. Justin Murray picked up his second fighting major of the season squaring off against Ryan Ferrill in the second stanza. Bo Brauer added two assists while Yanick Turcotte also collected an assist extending his point streak to two games.

12/15/19 Reading 1 at Worcester 4

Ian Milosz made 31 saves on 32 shots in his professional debut and was named number one star as Worcester downed the Reading Royals 4-1 Sunday afternoon at the DCU Center. Drew Callin scored his first goal of the season while Nic Pierog netted his seventh and eighth goals of the year, one which came short-handed for the Railers league leading sixth shorty of the year and his third. Cody Payne added two assists while Yanick Turcotte extended his point streak to three games with another assist. The win made it back to back wins for the Railers for just the second time all

Dante Salituro tied the game with 1:51 left in regulation and scored 1:53 into overtime giving Worcester their first overtime win of the season on Friday night at the Cool Insuring Arena 5-4 over the Adirondack Thunder. Justin Murray picked up his third fighting major of the season dropping the gloves with Alex Carrier while Cody Payne received his first professional fight against Gabriel

Verpaeslt. Shane Walsh netted a pair of goals and now has five in his last two games while Jack Stander scored his first goal as a Railer. Evan Buitenhuis made 31 saves on 35 shots in net.

12/28/19 Maine 2 at Worcester 0

In front of the third largest crowd of the year at the DCU Center, 6,419 people watched the Railers get shutout 2-0 against the Maine Mariners ending the two-game win streak. Evan Buitenhuis made 25 saves on 26 shots while Terrence Wallin scored an even strength goal with 13 seconds left in the middle frame and Alex Kile scored an empty-netter with 16 seconds left in regulation. Connor Lacouvee made 21 saves on 21 shots which is the lowest shot total of the season for Worcester.

12/30/19 Worcester 3 at Newfoundland 6

Scott Pooley scored four goals for the Growlers in their 11th straight win at the Mile One Centre on Monday night over the Railers 6-3. Nic Pierog and Barry Almeida scored power-play goals as Worcester went 2-for-7 on the man advantage. Drew Callin registered the other tally while Shane Walsh tallied three assists and now has (8-3-11) in his last nine games.

12/31/19 Worcester 3 at Newfoundland 4 OT

Zach O'Brien scored 24 seconds into overtime for the Growlers 12th straight win at the Mile One Centre in a 4-3 victory over the Railers on Tuesday night to close out 2019. Worcester led 3-1 after Drew Callin's second goal of the game at 4:14 of the second period but the Growlers received goals from Justin Brazeau 6:24 and Colt Conrad 14:09 of the third period to tie the score at 3-3. Goals from Dante Salituro 5:30 and Drew Callin 5:45 of the second period is a franchise record for quickest consecutive goals. Worcester finished 2019 29-34-6-2 and the month of December 5-7-1.

1/3/20 Worcester 4 at Reading 1

The Worcester Railers opened 2020 with 2020 vision defeating the Reading Royals 4-1 at the Santander Friday night. Ben Thomson made his ECHL debut and scored 32 seconds into the contest on his first shot while Ivan Chukarov scored his first goal of the year. Ben Thomson and Ryan MacKinnon each finished with a goal and an assist while Drew Callin scored for his third straight game. Jack

Stander played in his 100th professional game and Mike Cornell appeared in his first game for Worcester since December 4th and added an assist. Evan Buitenhuis made 30 saves on 31 shots for the victory.
