

#### LETTER FROM THE OWNERS

Old Glory Nation -

How very quickly time passes and things change.

Fewer than four months ago, we had no certainty that we would be able to play any of our MLR 2021 season games, or that we would be able to allow any fans to enjoy the experience with us in person. In fact, Old Glory lost our whole pre-season to COVID-related cancellations, and most of our regular season until now has been played in front of heavily restricted crowds.

Today, MLR has played every single game scheduled for the 2021 season to date, and Old Glory is hosting its home matches at Segra Field with no restrictions on capacity. We are not only playing every scheduled game and working to fill our stadium to its 5,000-seat capacity, but we have also returned to our tradition of a full event day, providing entertainment for both hard-core rugby fans and entire families new to the game, from our kids' zone games to culturally-themed events like Pacific Islanders Day, to the highest quality of rugby ever played in North America.

We must acknowledge honestly that Old Glory has experienced its challenges along the way. Following a 4-1 COVID-shortened 2020 season, we now face the final five games of the 2021 regular season standing in the lower half of the Eastern Conference table and with a playoff position distant -- but not entirely out of reach.

It is now – when we have fought our way through the worst conditions that a pandemic and economic crisis could throw at us, , as an organization and as a team – that we need our fans most. Over the last year, the sporting world has been reminded that fans are the most important ingredient to a sporting event. The game and atmosphere are not the same without you. Old Glory is known throughout MLR for is raucously supportive home crowd and the home field advantage that results. Now is when we appeal to you, for our final three home games, to come out and support us in force.

For the next three games – June 12 vs NOLA, July 10 vs San Diego, and July 17 vs Austin – come and support Old Glory. Come out and cheer your home team to victory. Return to participate in the rugby community of the Mid-Atlantic. Or perhaps come out and support a new discovery for you – the most exciting new professional sport in Greater Washington.

Help us return to Glory. We look forward to seeing you at Segra Field!



#### UPDATED MASK POLICIES

Segra Field officials have announced an update to the stadium's mask policy to align with the latest guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Virginia Department of Health.

Beginning on Sunday, May 30, guests attending any sport or entertainment event who are fully vaccinated – meaning 2 weeks after the second dose in a two-dose series, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine – will have the choice to not wear a mask. # WEEK 13 PREVIEW AGAINST NOLA GOLD

#### Old Glory in Battle for Playoff Hopes Against NOLA

With five games left in the season, Old Glory DC is under pressure to make the MLR Eastern Conference playoffs, and it all starts with NOLA Gold on Saturday. At Segra Field in Leesburg, Va., OGDC needs to put aside the disappointing results of the last two weeks and show the DC faithful the pride and glory of rugby in the Nation's Capital. The Gold is the top contender in the East and is coming off a brutal onepoint loss in their final home game of the season. Kickoff is at 5:00 pm, and the game will be broadcast live on NBC Sports Washington and the Rugby Network.

Last weekend, After falling behind versus New England on the road, Old Glory fought hard and strong for 80 minutes but, ultimately, didn't have enough to make that final connection to win the game.



"It was a kicker," Mike Dabulas said.
"A lot of opportunities that we missed out on. As it has happened all season, we started slow. We start battling, trying to figure it out, get ourselves in a hole too quickly, and have to dig out. Starting quick and fast is something we really need to do better on and then capitalizing on opportunities."

The slow start has been a focus for the team, and the solutions begin with personal accountability. "It comes back to individuals getting themselves ready for that game," head coach Andrew Douglas stated. "We're doing nothing different from what we did last year. It's individual accountability, and we have to be there ready to go when the time comes. We need to learn to switch on and be ready to play."

Part of that is the absence of key players that the coaching staff hopes to have on the pitch soon. Jamason Fa'anana-Schultz will be serving the final game of his suspension this weekend, while Mungo Mason and Thretton Palamo will be tested this week to gauge if they are gameready. Unfortunately for Doug Fraser, he left the game early against New England and is in the concussion protocol this week. S

aturday's match versus NOLA is paramount for an end-of-the-season run. At a record of 5-4-1 and fourth place in the East, the Gold is four points away from the conference semifinal. Last weekend's 8-7 loss in its final home game was a blow; however, with the remainder of their schedule on the road, NOLA will be desperate to show they can win away from the Gold Mine.

Old Glory and NOLA have a history together, starting with a 46-13 defeat last year and then a 26-26 draw to begin the 2021 campaign. The Gold has always been a difficult test for DC, but this weekend is the first time they will be at Old Glory's house.

"We had to match them physically in that first game," Douglas indicated. "It was our most physical performance, and we have to do that again. Our set-piece was pretty good last time, and we have to be conscious of that again because NOLA generates everything off their set-piece. If we take that away from them, it will certainly be easier for us. We have to start better in this game because you can't give NOLA 12 or 17 points like we did against New England and expect to come back. They are too good of a team for that."

NOLA's set-piece was efficient in its first game against DC and has only improved since. 19 of the Gold's 30 tries have been scored off of its set-piece with 17 coming from the lineout. NOLA leads the league in successful lineouts (86.2%) and is the best in the MLR with winning 97% of its scrums.

"[NOLA's] front row has been really strong," Douglas said. "The Irish hooker, Pat O'Toole, has come on and played really well lately. Matt Harmon and Dino Waldren are hurting, having been cut from the USA squad, so they will have a point to prove. Obviously, their midfield is quite dangerous with [JP] du Plessis, and the Argentinian winger (Julián Domínguez) is big and strong, and he beats a lot of people one-on-one."

When you throw in the back row of Cam Dolan, Moni Tonga'uiha, and Andrew Guerra combined with Damian Stevens, Timothée Guillemin, and Juan Cappiello in the backline, you have a potent



lineup on offense and defense.

The advantage for Old Glory this Saturday will be returning to the friendly and boisterous confines of Segra Field. NOLA is 0-2 on the road, and OGDC will need every bit of energy and confidence from the home crowd.

"We haven't had a real big crowd since last year, and we didn't lose a single home game," Dabulas said. "I think it's mainly because of that crowd. Having a big crowd at Segra this weekend is going to be massive for us."

"We got to show our fans a lot of respect because we didn't perform for them at home against New York," Douglas added. "I thought we were very poor and very disappointing to put that performance in front of our home fans. It would be nice to put on a really good performance for our fans at home and give them back the respect they deserve."

Old Glory won't say this is a mustwin game, but if it wants to celebrate victory and play meaningful rugby at the end of July, DC needs to play angry and with purpose.

"We got to play a little pissed off," Dabulas concluded. "Losing those close games is pretty frustrating, to say the least, and I think we need to play with a chip on our shoulder now. They are a top seed, it's a conference game, and we're pretty close to them. If we want to stay in this thing, we have to win this game."

#### **EQUIPMENT**

Sous vide circulator Sous vide pouches Vacuum sealer Ice cream machine Paring knife Small saucepan Baking sheet Baking rack Grill

#### INGREDIENTS HONEY LIMONCELLO

10 organic lemons 2 C sugar 1 C clover honey 1 liter vodka 3 C water

#### COCKTAIL

1 ½ fl oz sous-vide honey limoncello 1 ½ fl oz vodka 1 fl oz fresh lemon juice 1 fl oz canned low-sodium chickpea liquid, strained Angostora bitters

#### DIRECTIONS FOR THE HONEY LIMONCELLO

- 1. Preheat water bath to 140°F (60°C).
- 2. Wash and peel lemons, trimming off any of the white pith from the peels. Juice the lemons and reserve.
- 3. In a large sous vide pouch, combine the lemon peels with the rest of the ingredients. Chill liquid to 37°F (3°C) or colder, then seal the pouch.
- 4. Cook in water bath for 3 hours, gently shaking once or twice to make sure the sugar is evenly dissolved. Remove the pouch from the water and strain the limoncello, while still warm, through a coffee strainer.
- 5. Chill, then transfer to a bottle or lidded container. Makes two liters.

#### **TO BUILD**

Place all ingredients in a cocktail shaker and shake for about 20 seconds. Remove shaker lid and fill with ice, then cover and shake well for another 20 seconds. Strain into a chilled martini glass. Garnish the top of the drink with a few drops of bitters, running a toothpick through the drops to create a swirled effect.







#### **Salad Days**

Nothing heralds the arrival of spring like the bright flavors of crisp, crunchy salads. Take a gander at some of our favorites and toss up something fabulous.

As any food lover knows, salad is so much more than a mound of greens on a plate. Depending on the ingredients, salads can serve as appetizers, main courses, and when made with fruit, dessert. They're the ideal creative medium for cooks who delight in nutritious foods—and especially satisfying for those of us who grow our own vegetables. In fact, perhaps more than with any other recipe, fresh produce matters when you're making salads, and if you can get to your local farmers' market to buy your ingredients, all the better.

#### POACHED EGG SALAD WITH LEEKS AND **MUSTARD VINAIGRETTE**

This simple recipe ingeniously pairs sous vide eggs (the best way to cook eggs, we think!) with steamed leeks. It also calls for homemade croutons made from a sourdough bread and a simple Dijon mustard vinaigrette. To serve, combine the leeks with fresh radish (for a hit of crisp zestiness) and top with the eggs and croutons. Sophisticated and absolutely delicious.

#### **WOOD SKIN HALIBUT & CHICKPEA SALAD**

A main course dish that's light and flavorful, this recipe conjures up a Middle Eastern mood thanks to fiery harissa and fresh lemon. You'll need cedar paper for this recipe, soaked in white wine and placed with the halibut in a sous vide bath for 17 minutes. The fish is then quickly seared on a non-stick pan. Chickpeas, first soaked overnight, also get the sous vide treatment, and are later tossed with cucumber, fresh parsley, mint, and a harissa vinaigrette. The combination of ingredients is delightful.



#### MICHEL RICHARD'S TUNA & COMPRESSED **WATERMELON SALAD**

Pay tribute to the late, great Michel Richard with this inventive salad. Here, compressed watermelon (you'll need a vacuum sealer) is paired with raw tuna for a simply elegant presentation. These main ingredients shine bright on the palette thanks to a yuzu vinaigrette. All ingredients for the vinaigrette dressing are commonly found in the pantry, with the exception of yuzu juice and xanthan gum. Garnish with scallions, sesame seeds, Bibb lettuce, and green tobiko for next-level wow.



#### **GRILLED SALAD WITH BEER-HONEY VINAIGRETTE AND GOUDA SPREAD**

Impress your taste buds—and any guests—with this flavorful salad. Belgian endive, romaine lettuce, and fennel are prepared to perfection thanks to 45 minutes in a sous vide circulator and 6 minutes on a grill. Served with a fantastic beer-honey vinaigrette and a homemade Gouda spread—that's also prepared through sous vide—it's a winning salad that works any time of year.







# 66 IT'S LIKE A GAME OF CHESS UNDER FATIGUE.

#### Rules of Rugby 15

Two teams of 15 players have 80 minutes to advance the ball past their opponents' side of the field (pitch) and touch it to the ground for a score worth 5 points (try). Participants may only pass the ball backwards or sideways with no blocking allowed; using a variety of phases such as lineouts, mauls, rucks and scrums to retain possession during play. Rugby is unique in that play is continuous even after players are tackled on the field. Kicking is the only method by which both teams may move the ball forward.

After each try, worth 5 points, the scoring team is allowed an opportunity to kick the ball through the posts for an additional 2 points (conversion). Certain penalties also earn the non-offending team a kick through the posts, worth 3 points (penalty) if made. At the conclusion of the match, the team with the most points wins.

#### *Loose Play*

MAUL A maul occurs when a player carrying the ball is held by one or more opponents, and one or more of the ball-carrier's teammates bind on the ball-carrier.

BUCK A ruck happens when one or more players from each team, who are on their feet and in contact, close around the ball on the ground. Once a ruck is formed, players can't use their hands to get the ball, only their feet.

#### THE SET PIECE

The set piece is a means of restarting the game.

SCRUM A contest for the ball involving eight players who bind together and push against the other team's eight for possession of the ball.

LINE-CUIT Looks somewhat like a jumpball in basketball, with both teams lining up opposite each other, but one team then throws the ball down the middle of the tunnel.

#### WHY DID THE WHISTLE BLOW?

OFFSIDE Rugby's offside law restricts where on the field players can be, to ensure there is space to attack and defend. In general, a player is in an offside position if that player is further forward (nearer to the opponents' goal line) than the teammate who is carrying the ball or the teammate who last played the ball. Being in an offside position is not, in itself, an offence, but an offside player may not take part in the game until they are on-side again. If an offside player takes part in the game, that player will be penalized.

FORWARD PASS OR KNOCK ON Sometimes an attack which seems to be heading towards the try line will be stopped by the referee's whistle. If a pass has gone forwards, or a handling error has resulted in a knock-on, a scrum will have been awarded to the non-offending team.

FAILURE TO RELEASE PLAYER OR BALL After a tackle, the tackler must immediately release the ball carrier, and the ball carrier must immediately release the ball. Failure on either of these counts limits a fair contest for possession. If release does not occur within a reasonable time frame, the referee will award a penalty to the non-offending team.

FAILURE TO ROLL AWAY Any players on the ground when a ruck or maul is formed must immediately roll away from the ball, so as to allow continuity of play for the team in possession. Failure to do so will result in the award of a penalty to the non-offending team.

JOINING RUCK/MAUL FROM THE SIDE When joining a ruck or maul, all players must do so from behind the feel of the last teammate. If they join from the side, they are in an offside position and taking part in the game, then this will immediately be penalized, then a penalty will be awarded to the apposing team.


UN-PLAYABLE BALL IN RUCK OR MAUL. If the ball becomes un-playable in a ruck or maul, e.g., underneath players on the ground, but neither team is at fault, the referee will award a scrum to the team who was in possession before the ruck or maul was farmed.


