INTRODUCTION

The following pages should be considered an addendum to the overall Butler University brand guidelines, which can be found at Butler.edu/Marketing.

While the University and the Athletic Department utilize the same Bulldog Head logo and primary brand colors, there are certain differences between the two styles, most notably in usage of secondary colors and font.

The marks cannot be used in any color combinations other than those specifically noted in this guide. Some color variations are acceptable for retail products; however, prior approval must be given by Butler Athletics.

Use of these marks for commercial purposes require permission from Butler University Athletics. PRIMARY LOGO









The full color logo is always preferred.



If a one color logo must be used, it should appear with a double line when printed on white and as all white with a single line on any other color.

Treatments, such a fading or use of glitter or metalics is permitted at retail only with permission from Butler Athletics.

Black may be used instead of navy blue in the one color logo on white.

WORDMARK & LOCK-UP



In instances where the primary logo cannot be used, the wordmark is allowed.

The wordmark alone may be used on any color background, with the navy version preferred for light backgrounds and the white preferred for dark.

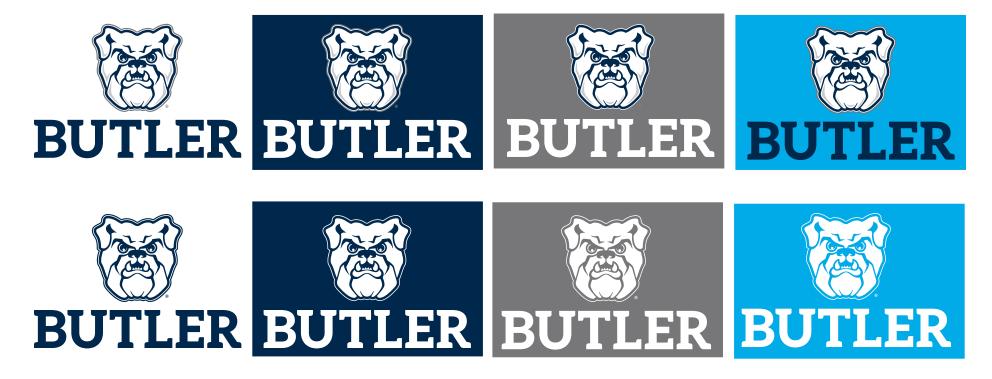


The bulldog head and wordmark may be combined horizontally





WORDMARK & LOCK-UP



The bulldog head and wordmark may also be combined vertically. This version is most often used as the base for sport-specific marks as shown on the next page.

The Bulldog head alone is the preferred mark and should be used whenever possible.

SPORT-SPECIFIC MARKS



BUTLER "B"

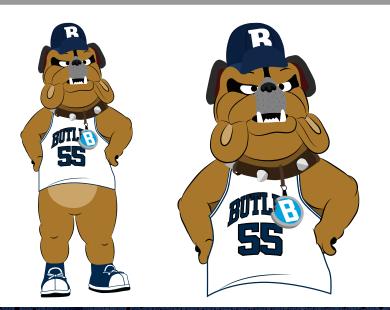
A stylized B has been created as a secondary mark.

At retail, it must be used with another Butler identifier.

It is available in a three-color blue with white and gray outline, two-color blue and white, and one-color all white.

THROWBACK GAMES

Three marks visually represent Butler's iconic home, historic Hinkle Fieldhouse. These marks are avaiable upon request.

The mark for Butler's student athletic support group, Dawg Pound, is available for internal use only.

It must always appear in blue and white. Color alterations are not permitted.
