

Full color logos should be used in most applications. Be sure to use the version that provides the most contrast from the background color.









MUSTANGS LOGO USAGE



DO NOT ROTATE OR OTHERWISE DISTORT THE LOGO Keep all marks at the appropriate angle and be sure to scale all marks proportionally.



DO NOT USE COLORS OTHER THAN THE OFFICIAL COLORS The marks should never appear in non-approved colors.









DO NOT USE LOGOS FOR A DARK COLOR ON A LIGHT COLOR Be sure there is enough contrast between the logo and the background.

DO NOT USE OLD OR OUTDATED LOGOS Be sure the version of the logo is the most current version.











Do not use these versions with old colors and text highlights/shadow.
