### FERRYHAWKS KICK OFF SIX-GAME ROAD TRIP IN PA

After taking the final game of a six-game homestand on Thursday against Long Island, Staten Island embarks on a week long road trip with stops at first place teams Lancaster and Gastonia. The FerryHawks pay their first visit to Clipper Magazine Stadium since the first three days of July. They'll play at Gastonia later in the week for the first time since the first road trip of the season in April.

### STATEN ISLAND STARTER: RHP Hector Guance

makes his 10th start of the season and third against Lancaster. It'll be the 27-year-old's second consecutive start against the Barnstormers, tossing five innings of three-run ball in a no-decision on 7/31. The FerryHawks have dropped four straight. Guance starts and are (2-7) in his starts this season.

**10 RUN FUN:** The FerryHawks matched a franchise best in Thursday's win, scoring 10 runs in the series finale against the Ducks. It's the second time this season Staten Island has put up a 10-spot, doing so at the Ducks on 7/27.

**TOP-HEAVY HITTING:** The first four batters in the FerryHawks lineup combined to go 8-for-16 with 6 RBI and 5 runs scored in Thursday's 10-7 win. **A. Duplantis (2), J. Monge (2), A. Aguilar (2), & D. Herrera (2)** (1-4 hitters) each had multi-hit games, while all nine starters reached base safely.

**HERRERA HEATING UP:** INF **Dilson Herrera** went 2-for-4 with a home run and 3 RBI on Thursday and now has hits in 14 of the last 15 games. He's raised his batting average from .199 to .242 in the process and leads the team with (8) multi-RBI performances.

**ALFREDO'S SAUCE:** INF **Alfredo Reyes** had at least one hit in each of the three games against Long Island, including a 3-for-4 effort on Thursday. He collected 2 RBI in the victory, garnering his first multi-RBI performance of the season.

**BARN-STREAKING:** Despite Staten Island winning four out of the first five meetings, Lancaster owns the regular season series eight games to four, having won seven consecutive against the FerryHawks.

**LANCASTER STARTER:** RHP **Erik Manoah** makes his 13th appearance (eighth start) of the season and second straight against Staten Island. On 7/30, Manoah tossed six innings with seven strikeouts and one walk. He allowed just one run on three hits in the 3-1 Lancaster win. As a starter, he's posted a (2-0, 3.79) in seven starts.

**UP NEXT:** Staten Island and Lancaster meet for the middle game of their three-game set on Saturday. RHP **Nile Ball** goes for the Barnstormers against a FerryHawks pitcher to be named. First pitch at Clipper Magazine Stadium is scheduled for 6:30 PM with the FerryHawks Pregame Show at 6:15 PM.

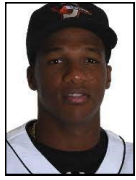
