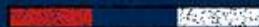

PROFESSIONAL RUGBY IN WASHINGTON, DC

Old Glory DC is a professional rugby team based in the District of Columbia and officially joined Major League Rugby (MLR) in 2018 and entered its first season in 2020. Playing its home games at Segra Field in Leesburg Virginia, Old Glory will compete in MLR's Eastern Conference against teams from Atlanta, New England, New Orleans, New York, and Toronto, as well as play games against Western Conference teams Austin, Dallas, Houston, San Diego, Seattle, and Utah.

The Old Glory ownership team is led by DC natives and life-long rugby players Paul Sheehy and Chris Dunlavy and includes the Scottish Rugby Union, represented on Old Glory's board by the SRU's COO Dominic McKay. The organization seeks to grow the sport of rugby in the region through community engagement, by promoting an alternative path for personal development through sport, embracing the unique values of rugby: respect, determination, diligence, teamwork, and commitment.

WHY OLD GLORY DC?

Old Glory is a nickname for the flag of the United States. The original "Old Glory" was a flag owned by the 19th-century American sea captain William Driver (March 17, 1803 – March 3, 1886), who flew the flag during his career at sea and later brought it to Nashville, Tennessee, where he settled. Driver greatly prized the flag and ensured its safety from the Confederates, who attempted to seize the flag during the American Civil War. In 1922, Driver's daughter and niece claimed to own the original "Old Glory," which became part of the collection of the Smithsonian Institution, where it remains at the National Museum of American History.

After considering hundreds of options proposed by our fans and advisors, we have selected a name and logo that speak to our region's patriotism and the unique role of our home city as the nation's capital. Old Glory DC will be known for valuing the traditions of rugby, but also for our appreciation of the strong connections between the Mid-Atlantic rugby community and our military personnel and their families. Beyond that, our name is a nod of respect to so many of our corporate partners, whose missions are to serve the people and agencies who serve all Americans.

"The response to our Name the Team challenge was incredible, with close to 1,000 fans participating," Co-owner Paul Sheehy said. "We had so many great names to choose from, but in the end, we felt we had to choose a name that could only really work in Washington, and that is inclusive of all of the diverse members of our community."

"And we think our fans will see the deeper meaning," Co-owner Chris Dunlavey added. "Yes, it's a flag, but Old Glory has been places. It's battle-scarred. It's weather-beaten. But still it flies proud. It symbolizes all the strength, resilience, commitment, and substance over style that are the hallmarks of rugby and, for that matter, the American character."

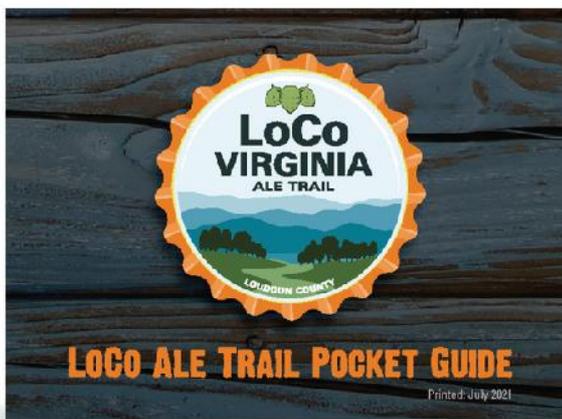

TASTE WHAT'S *Brewing*

With so much fertile farmland producing fresh fruit and grain, it's no surprise Loudoun has become a vibrant craft beer destination.

More than 30 breweries make up the county's LoCo Ale Trail, in a variety of locales – trendy urban taprooms, Piedmont farm beer gardens, mountaintop tasting rooms – few regions can match.

While many breweries incorporate local ingredients, some are inspired by the old European "land beer" ethos requiring beer be made solely with regional ingredients. **Wheatland Spring Farm + Brewery** in Waterford leads the way producing, in 2021, the first all-Loudoun grown beer – the crisp, citrusy Loudoun Grown Farmhouse Ale – in which every ingredient came from the farm or county.

Vanish Farmwoods Brewery in Lucketts uses hops from its five-acre hops field, while **Dirt Farm Brewing** in the Blue Ridge makes fruit-forward seasonal IPAs using peaches, strawberries and cherries from their own orchards.

As with all creative subcultures, Loudoun brewmasters constantly innovate. You'll find everything from crisp lagers and hoppy ales to malty barrel-aged stouts fused with herbs, honey, flower petals, coffee, wine or whiskey, many made with obscure yeast strains at Sterling science lab Jasper Yeast.

Just as the scene gets more refined, restaurants add local craft beers to menus, notably **1836 Kitchen & Taproom** in Lovettsville and **Tuscarora Mill** in Leesburg, the latter of which hosts beer pairing dinners.

Salad Days

Nothing heralds the arrival of spring like the bright flavors of crisp, crunchy salads. Take a gander at some of our favorites and toss up something fabulous.

As any food lover knows, salad is so much more than a mound of greens on a plate. Depending on the ingredients, salads can serve as appetizers, main courses, and when made with fruit, dessert. They're the ideal creative medium for cooks who delight in nutritious foods—and especially satisfying for those of us who grow our own vegetables. In fact, perhaps more than with any other recipe, fresh produce matters when you're making salads, and if you can get to your local farmers' market to buy your ingredients, all the better.

POACHED EGG SALAD WITH LEEKS AND MUSTARD VINAIGRETTE

This simple recipe ingeniously pairs sous vide eggs (the best way to cook eggs, we think!) with steamed leeks. It also calls for homemade croutons made from a sourdough bread and a simple Dijon mustard vinaigrette. To serve, combine the leeks with fresh radish (for a hit of crisp zestiness) and top with the eggs and croutons. Sophisticated and absolutely delicious.

WOOD SKIN HALIBUT & CHICKPEA SALAD

A main course dish that's light and flavorful, this recipe conjures up a Middle Eastern mood thanks to fiery harissa and fresh lemon. You'll need cedar paper for this recipe, soaked in white wine and placed with the halibut in a sous vide bath for 17 minutes. The fish is then quickly seared on a non-stick pan. Chickpeas, first soaked overnight, also get the sous vide treatment, and are later tossed with cucumber, fresh parsley, mint, and a harissa vinaigrette. The combination of ingredients is delightful.



MICHEL RICHARD'S TUNA & COMPRESSED WATERMELON SALAD

Pay tribute to the late, great Michel Richard with this inventive salad. Here, compressed watermelon (you'll need a vacuum sealer) is paired with raw tuna for a simply elegant presentation. These main ingredients shine bright on the palette thanks to a yuzu vinaigrette. All ingredients for the vinaigrette dressing are commonly found in the pantry, with the exception of yuzu juice and xanthan gum. Garnish with scallions, sesame seeds, Bibb lettuce, and green tobiko for next-level wow.



GRILLED SALAD WITH BEER-HONEY VINAIGRETTE AND GOUDA SPREAD

Impress your taste buds—and any guests—with this flavorful salad. Belgian endive, romaine lettuce, and fennel are prepared to perfection thanks to 45 minutes in a sous vide circulator and 6 minutes on a grill. Served with a fantastic beer-honey vinaigrette and a homemade Gouda spread—that's also prepared through sous vide—it's a winning salad that works any time of year.

EQUIPMENT

Sous vide circulator
Sous vide pouches

INGREDIENTS HONEY LIMONCELLO

10 organic lemons
2 C sugar
1 C clover honey
1 liter vodka
3 C water

COCKTAIL

1 ½ fl oz sous-vide honey limoncello
1 ½ fl oz vodka
1 fl oz fresh lemon juice
1 fl oz canned low-sodium chickpea liquid, strained
Angostura bitters

DIRECTIONS FOR THE HONEY LIMONCELLO

1. Preheat water bath to 140°F (60°C).
2. Wash and peel lemons, trimming off any of the white pith from the peels. Juice the lemons and reserve.
3. In a large sous vide pouch, combine the lemon peels with the rest of the ingredients. Chill liquid to 37°F (3°C) or colder, then seal the pouch.
4. Cook in water bath for 3 hours, gently shaking once or twice to make sure the sugar is evenly dissolved. Remove the pouch from the water and strain the limoncello, while still warm, through a coffee strainer.
5. Chill, then transfer to a bottle or lidded container. Makes two liters.

TO BUILD

Place all ingredients in a cocktail shaker and shake for about 20 seconds. Remove shaker lid and fill with ice, then cover and shake well for another 20 seconds. Strain into a chilled martini glass. Garnish the top of the drink with a few drops of bitters, running a toothpick through the drops to create a swirled effect.

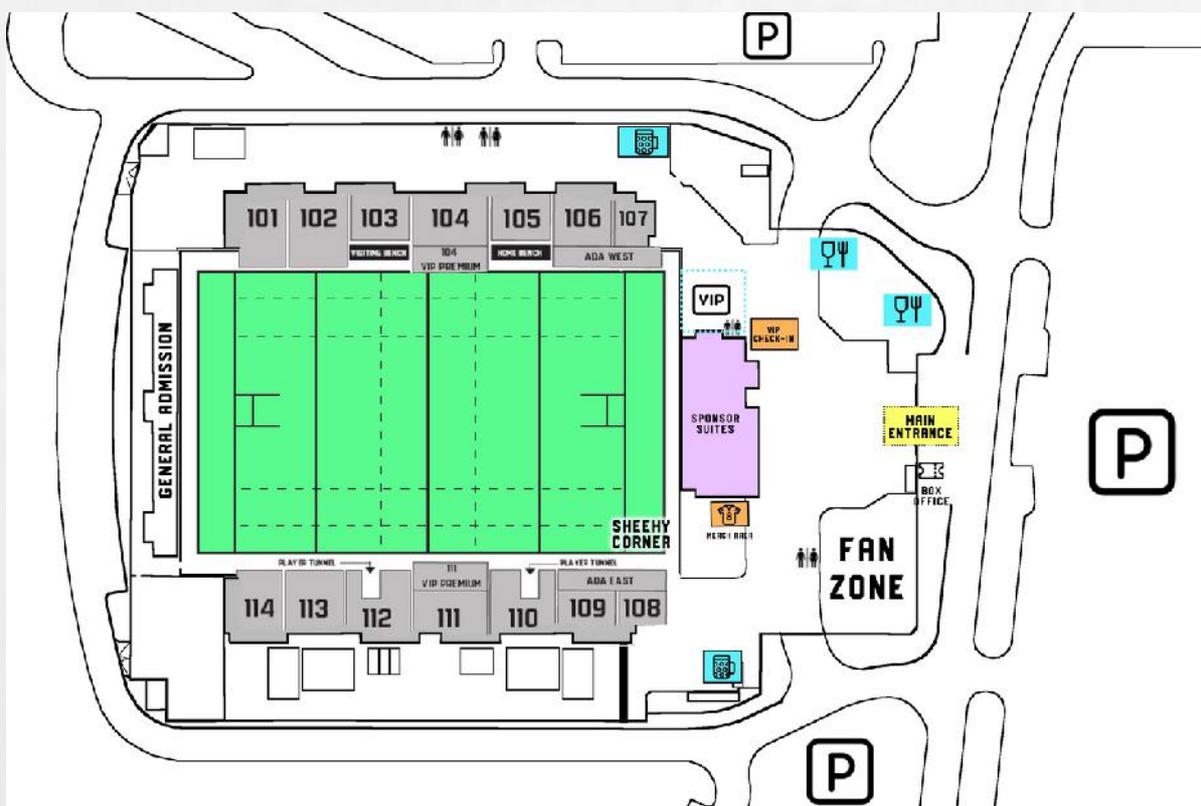

Old Glory Aims to be Spoilers in New York's Playoff Run

A Stark Defeat in NOLA

Although Old Glory DC has been eliminated from the MLR playoffs, this Sunday's final home game at Segra Field against Rugby New York has immense postseason implications. New York is tied with Rugby ATL for second place in the Eastern Conference and has Toronto nipping at their heels in fourth. Old Glory's early April match marked a resurgence for the club as it played a tight, physical match and only lost by four points. DC will attempt to be spoilers in New York's postseason ambitions and show the Old Glory faithful what's to come in the future. Tickets are available at Ticketmaster for Sunday's 2:30 pm kickoff, which will also be broadcast live on NBC Sports Washington and the Rugby Network.

Sunday is Military Appreciation Day at Segra Field. Old Glory will honor those who have served with a limited-edition military-themed kit, which will be auctioned off with proceeds donated to Veterans Moving Forward.

Additionally, the team will launch the Tries for Troops campaign that will dedicate tries scored by both sides to military members of the Old Glory community on our social media and website.

Adding to the festivities, Old Glory has a host of guests planned throughout the day. The organization welcomes back OGDC and Springbok legend, Tendai "Beast" Mtawarira, for a Meet and Greet at the Veterans Moving Forward tent from 11:45-12:00 pm. On the concourse, the Premier Rugby Sevens, a domestic professional sevens league for men and women, will be on hand to promote their tournament stop at Audi Field in Washington, D.C. on Saturday, July 16.

For the curtain-raiser, Young Glory U23 will take on the NY Foundry, Rugby New York's U23 squad, at noon. Finally, at halftime of the MLR match, NOVA Women's Rugby will be celebrated for winning their second consecutive D1 Club National Championship.

Fireworks Expected for New York Rematch

For the penultimate test of the year, the coaching roster has shaken up the rotation. There are four new starters in the forwards, with Stan South taking over for a suspended Api Naikitini at lock, Kyle Stewart returning to tighthead, Luke Campbell back at eight-man, and Felix Kalapu at blindside flanker. In addition, Jack Iscaro and Mo Katz return to the front row, along with Tevita Naqali at second row and Cory Daniel at flanker.

In the backs, the halfback tandem of Danny Tusitala and Rohan Saifoloi are back for their seventh straight pairing together. William Talatana, who scored a pair of tries against Houston, will be joined by Doug Fraser in the centers. Junior Sa'u and his seven tries move to the wing to partner with the elusive Peni Lasaga (tied for fifth in the MLR with eight tries) and the Super Saiyan blue-haired Renata Roberts-Te Nana in the back three.

Coach Osborne will go for the 6-2 split in the reserves with Rob Irimescu, Jake Innicki, Will Vakalahi, Dom Bailey, Josh Brown, Dacoda Worth in the forwards, and John Rizzo and John Lefevre in the backs.

A Lot to Play for on Sunday

When Rugby New York comes to Segra Field on Sunday, there will be a ton on the line. New York has their playoff lives at stake and has to keep pace with the two other contenders in the hunt. Old Glory finds itself in the role of spoiler with nothing to lose in the last games of the season.

Before last weekend's 38-3 loss to Atlanta, New York was on a three-game roll with wins over NOLA, Toronto, and Seattle. Atlanta won the physicality battle with an aggressive, stout defense and took advantage of their opponent's mistakes with quick ball on offense. Old Glory will attempt to replicate that strategy and punish NY upfront in the forwards.

The game in New York in early April was the first step in Old Glory's resurgence and the team hopes to tap into that energy, minus the discipline issues that plagued that match and last Saturday.

"We changed it all up and decided to play fast and aggressive footy [in April]," Roberts-Te Nana said. "It showed in that game, and similar to Houston, discipline didn't help us in the end, -

but we were there against them. ATL paved the blueprint for us to follow. If we bash them upfront, our backs will have a field day. They have some world-class backs, but just how ATL showed, it doesn't matter whom they have on paper. It's about who shows up on the day."

One of the biggest strengths of New York is its back three of Ed Fidow, Andrew Coe, and former All-Blacks' Nehe Milner-Skudder and Waisake Naholo.

"They got two All Blacks and a Samoan international on the wings and fullback," Head Coach Nate Osborne said. "If they are not winning the middle, not getting good go-forward ball, and we disrupt their lineout and scrum, their boys aren't going to touch the ball. So it's going to be a battle up front and whichever team can take the ascendancy through the tight five... We have to start fast, and we got to understand that as soon as that whistle blows, it's that mindset of not giving them anything."

Time to Show the Real Old Glory at Segra

With only two games left, players are playing not just for the win on Sunday but for all those who have supported them in the good times and bad. Everyone knows change is expected in the offseason, and the team wants to show that potential for the future.

"We all know we can beat any team," Roberts-Te Nana stated. "We got the capability within our squad to do it, and we've shown it in glimpses. The margin for error is getting smaller every year. We need to take a good look in the mirror from 1 to 15 to 23 everyone in the office. If we want to do a good job, we need to be on the same page."

"It's been a tough year," Roberts-Te Nana concluded. "To watch it all season, from me and all of us at Old Glory, we do appreciate all the support everyone gives us week in, week out. We might not often deserve it, but behind the scenes, we are trying as hard as we can. We don't plan to lose. This is our last home game, and we are going to give everything left in the tank and look forward to putting on a great performance."

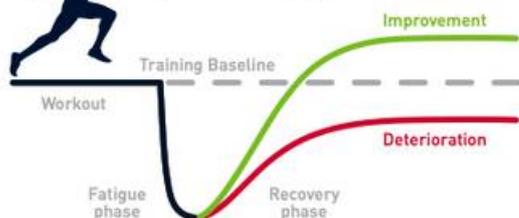
