## Charleston RiverDogs (31-18, 77-38) at Fayetteville Woodpeckers (16-33, 47-67)

**Today's Game**: The Charleston RiverDogs (affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays) make their first ever visit to Segra Stadium to battle the Fayetteville Woodpeckers (affiliate of the Houston Astros). The RiverDogs own a 4.5 game lead in the South Division second half standings, while the Woodpeckers have lost 11 consecutive games are close to elimination from postseason contention. **RiverDogs-Fayetteville Season Series in 2022: Overall:** RiverDogs 6, Woodpeckers 1. **At Segra Stadium:** RiverDogs 1, Woodpeckers 0.

Last Time Out: The RiverDogs were tested late but held on for a 5-3 win in the opening game of the series on Tuesday night. The night began with a bang as the RiverDogs got to Valente Bellozo for three runs in the top of the first. Carson Williams doubled with one out and scored on an ensuing RBI single by Junior Caminero. Willy Vasquez followed with a base hit and Blake Robertson walked to load the bases. With two down, Kenny Piper muscled a two-RBI single into shallow center for a 3-0 lead. Nick Bitsko loaded the bases in the bottom of the first with no outs but managed to escape with the lead still intact at 3-1. The RiverDogs added a pair of insurance runs as Brock Jones ripped an RBI double in the third and Daiwer Castellanos came through with an RBI groundout in the sixth. In the bottom of the sixth, Tyler Whitaker blasted his tenth home run of the season to pull Fayetteville within three. The Woodpeckers faced the same deficit in the ninth when Roel Garcia surrendered three singles to load the bases with two outs. Jack Snyder entered and allowed an RBI single to Garrett McGowan that moved the tying run to second base. However, Tommy Sacco flew out to deep right field to end the game in the next at-bat.

**Sasaki Bombs:** Outfielder Shane Sasaki is the first player to win back-to-back Carolina League Player of the Week Honors. He went 11-27 (.444) at the plate with five doubles, a triple, two home runs and four runs batted in. He also stole four bases and scored eight runs. Sasaki is hitting .460 with 15 extra-base hits over 12 games the last two weeks. He leads the league in batting average and ranks third in slugging percentage, tied for third in doubles, fourth in OPS, tied for fourth in stolen bases and eighth in on-base percentage.

**Playoff Possibilities:** After missing out on a playoff spot in the first half by just one game, the RiverDogs are working to put themselves in a position to repeat as league champions. The team needs to win the second half in order to qualify for the postseason. With 17 games remaining in the regular season, the RiverDogs lead the Columbia Fireflies by 4.5 games. Kannapolis is 6.0 games behind and Augusta is sitting 7.5 games back. The RiverDogs will end the season with six games at Columbia.

**Free Willy:** Willy Vasquez was named the Carolina League Player of the Month for July after putting together his best stretch of the season. Vasquez posted league-bests in batting average, slugging percentage and total bases during his 20 games played in the month. He finished second in hits, RBI, doubles and OPS, third in triples and fifth in runs scored. He added 12 multi-hit games and raised his season average from .206 to .249 in July. He has continued to swing a hot bat in August, batting .333 with 13 runs batted in over 16 games. He is currently in the midst of a nine-game hitting streak, his longest of the season.

These Are the Good Days: The RiverDogs lead Minor League Baseball with 77 wins this season. Over their last two seasons as an affiliate of the Tampa Rays, the RiverDogs have compiled an incredible 159-76 record and .677 winning percentage. The next winningest teams in that same stretch are also Rays affiliates. Triple-A Durham has won 152 games during that span and High-A Bowling Green 151.

**Triple Threat:** Speed is a weapon for several hitters up and down the RiverDogs lineup this season. That has been most evident in the way the team turns balls in the gap into triples at an impressive rate. RiverDogs have hit triples in consecutive at-bats on three separate occasions this season. The team leads Minor League Baseball with 51 triples, nine more than the next closest club, Augusta. 19-year-old infielder Carson Williams is tied for second in Minor League Baseball lead with 10 three-baggers.

**Prized Pups:** The RiverDogs current roster contains nine members of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Rays prospects. The highest ranked of the group is infielder Carson Williams who comes in at #3. Pitcher Cole Wilcox (#9) and infielder Willy Vasquez (#10) also sit in the top 10. The list is rounded out by outfielder Brock Jones (#12), infielder Junior Caminero (#19), pitcher Sandy Gaston (#22), pitcher JJ Goss (#27), infielder Ryan Spikes (#29) and pitcher Nick Bitsko (#30). Williams is also rated as the #86 overall prospect in baseball by the publication.

## **RIVERDOGS FIELD STAFF**

### Manager: Blake Butera

Butera returns for his second season as the manager of the RiverDogs after leading the team to the franchise's first championship in 2021. Prior to his arrival in Charleston, he led the Hudson Valley Renegades to a postseason berth in his two seasons guiding the short-season club. Butera coached with Leones del Escogido in the Dominican Winter League following the cancellation of the 2020 minor league season. At the time he received the managerial job in Hudson Valley, Butera was the youngest manager (25) in all of Minor League Baseball. The native of Metairie, Louisiana was drafted by the Rays in the 35th round of the 2015 Amateur Draft out of Boston College and appeared in 80 minor league games over two seasons. At Boston College, he was voted team captain his senior year and finished his career as the Eagles' all-time leader in walks (112) and at-bats (774). His father, Barry, reached Triple-A with the Red Sox and his brother, Barry, spent two seasons in the Astros minor league system after being selected out of Boston College in the 2009 Amateur Draft.

## Pitching Coach: R.C. Lichtenstein

Lichtenstein returns for his second year as the pitching coach for the RiverDogs and his 18<sup>th</sup> year in the Rays organization. He guided the 2021 pitching staff to the lowest earned run average and most shutouts of any Low-A team The pitching staff also led the Low-A East in strikeouts and allowed the fewest hits of any team in the circuit. Lichtenstein has served as pitching coach at several stops in the Rays farm system including Southwest Michigan (2005-06), Vero Beach (2007-08), Bowling Green (2009-11) and Double-A Montgomery (2012-19). Throughout his career in baseball, the 53-year-old has also coached in the Milwaukee Brewers organization and managed two independent squads.

### **Hitting Coach: Perry Roth**

Roth takes on his first assignment with the Rays in Charleston after coaching at the college level since 1996. He served as interim head coach at UAB in 2021 and spent 15 years with UAB's baseball program, also serving as recruiting coordinator, hitting coach and assistant head coach. Roth previously served as an assistant for two separate stints at Birmingham Southern and coached at Bradley, Illinois State and Greenville College.

## **Coach: Frank Jagoda**

Jagoda joins the RiverDogs for his first season in the Holy City. He initially joined the Rays in 2020 when he was slated to be a member of the Princeton Rays staff until the MiLB season was canceled. Jagoda was part of the 2021 FCL Rays staff that helped lead the team to the best record in the circuit and one of the top winning percentages in MiLB. He previously spent two seasons with the Minnesota Twins, serving as Rehab Coordinator in 2018 and a coach for the Fort Myers Miracle in 2019. Jagoda has also served as Director of USA Baseball and at the collegiate level for Patrick Henry Community College, Wingate University, Canisius College and Jamestown Community College.

## **Athletic Trainer: Ruben Santiago**

The 2022 season will be Santiago's seventh as an athletic trainer with the Rays. In 2021, he worked with the FCL Rays after spending the previous three seasons on the Princeton coaching staff. Santiago joined the organization from the Toros del Este in the Dominican Winter League in 2016 and spent his first two seasons with the Gulf Coast League Rays.

## **Strength Coach: Mia Salvemini**

Salvemini began the 2021 season with the FCL Rays and completed the campaign as the RiverDogs Strength and Conditioning coach. She is also a CrossFit Level One Trainer and has worked with athletes at Cressey Sports Performance. Salvemini was originally hired by the Rays in 2020 after graduating from the University of Tampa in 2019 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Human Performance with a concentration in Exercise Recreation and Leadership.
