### LAST TIME OUT

The Pelicans finished the series strong with a 7-1 win over the Down East Wood Ducks after the game was called in the top of the eighth due to rain. **1B Liam Spence** hit a two-run home run in the top of the second and **CF Kevin Alcantara** logged a three-hit game with an RBI. **RHP Yovanny Cabrera** pitched two shutout innings in relief to earn the win and **RHP Angel Gonzalez** picked up the save by getting the final out of the seventh. The Birds fell in the series 4-2 for their third straight series loss.

### FIRST HALF CHAMPS

With a 47-19 record, the Pelicans clinched the Carolina League South Division First Half championship for their season-worst losing streak at four consecutive, and have dropped 12 of their last 18 games. In the 18 games in August, the Pelicans have a team ERA of 5.19, 8th in the league. Their 100 walks in 18 games are the third most in the league. For the second half, the ERA of 4.63 is seventh in the league after a league-leading 3.03 ERA in the first half. The hitting has cooled off as well with a team batting average at .242, seventh in the league. Their average in the first half was .250, ranking second in the league. Despite the recent struggles, their winning percentage (.614) is the second-best percentage in MiLB and they have the second-most wins at 70. Myrtle Beach's run differential is third in MiLB at +158.

### SECOND HALF STRUGGLES

After going 47-19 in the first half, the Pelicans have a 23-25 second half record. They just broke out of their season-worst losing streak at four consecutive, and have dropped 12 of their last 18 games. In the 18 games in August, the Pelicans have a team ERA of 5.19, 8th in the league. Their 100 walks in 18 games are the third most in the league. For the second half, the ERA of 4.63 is seventh in the league after a league-leading 3.03 ERA in the first half. The hitting has cooled off as well with a team batting average at .242, seventh in the league. Their average in the first half was .250, ranking second in the league. Despite the recent struggles, their winning percentage (.614) is the second-best percentage in MiLB and they have the second-most wins at 70. Myrtle Beach's run differential is third in MiLB at +158.

### UNHITTABLE

The Pelicans have thrown two combined no-hitters during the 2022 season. Three Pelicans combined to throw a no-hitter against the Columbia Fireflies on May 1, 2022 in Myrtle Beach. **Walker Powell**, **Adam Laskey**, and **Jake Reindl** tossed the third nine-inning no hitter in franchise history. It was the first no-hitter for the Pelicans at home, and their second in 10 months. On July 17, 2022, the Pelicans once again threw a no-hitter in Myrtle Beach, this time against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers. **RHP Tyler Schaffer**, **LHP Luis Rodriguez**, **RHP Gregori Montano**, **LHP Angel Hernandez**, and **RHP Alfredo Zarraga** combined to strike out 16 batters and throw the fourth nine-inning no-hitter in team history, and second at home. **C Ethan Hearn** has been behind the plate for both historic games.

### AWARDS SZN

This season, the Pelicans have racked up a total of eight awards from MiLB and the Cubs. Most recently, **LHP Luke Little** grabbed the Cubs MiLB Pitcher of the Month award for July with a 1.15 ERA in 15.2 IP and 25 strikeouts to five walks. **RHP Tyler Santana** was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for July after holding a 1.29 ERA and 24 strikeouts across 27.1 innings. **OF Ezequiel Pagan** was named the Cubs Minor League Player of the Month for June after hitting .367 and posting an OPS of 1.069. **RHP Luis Devers** was awarded the Cubs MiLB Pitcher of the Month for May after holding a 1.48 ERA and 28 strikeouts in the month. **RHP Porter Hodge** also won Cubs Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA with 21 strikeouts through his four starts. Before being promoted to High-A South Bend on May 30, **OF Pete Crow-Armstrong** won the Cubs MiLB Player of the Month for April after hitting .375. **Crow-Armstrong** was also named the Carolina League Player of the Week on May 4. **LHP Riley Martin** also won the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on April 25th following the series at Delmarva.

### BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2022 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his fifth year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021, and will be coaching his 16th season in the Cubs organization. During his first three years with the Pelicans, Bailey recorded 216 wins, three half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,272. Bailey moved past Johnny Lipon for fourth place on the MiLB all-time wins list with a 6-5 walk-off win over Charleston on August 10, 2021 for his 2,186th victory. Bailey is the winningest active manager in MiLB, as 2022 will be his 34th season as a minor league manager.

### PELICAN POINTS

Currently, the Pelicans roster holds three of the Cubs top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. **OF Kevin Alcantara** leads the Birds as the No. 91 overall prospect and No. 3 in the Cubs system. **INF James Triantos** ranks No. 11 in the system, with **C Moises Ballesteros** ranking as the No. 15 Cubs prospect.

### BIRD DROPPINGS

- The Pelicans won the Carolina League South Division First-Half championship with a record of 47-19 to clinch their first playoff appearance since 2017
- The 12-game winning streak for Myrtle Beach from 5/14-5/27 was the longest in recorded history for the franchise
- As a team, the Pelicans have gone 293-1153 (.254) with runners in scoring position
- The Pelicans have scored in double figures 19 times through 114 games after scoring in double figures 10 times last season
- Through the first six home games, the Pelicans walked-off winners in three of them
- The 24 runs scored on 5/4 at Salem were the most in a game since at least 2005 for the Pelicans, and the most in a Minor League game this season
- The Pelicans have the second-best winning percentage in MiLB (.614) and the second-most wins at 70
- The Pelicans have fallen 4-2 in three straight series against Lynchburg, Columbia, and Down East
- Myrtle Beach has 11 shutout victories this season, tied for the most in the Carolina League
