What is the USC Upstate brand identity?

Since the University's founding in 1967 USC Spartanburg has become USC Upstate, Fighting Bantams became Rifles, then Spartans, and the colors have morphed from garnet and black to purple and white to green and black. The amount of change in identity in such a relatively short period of time doesn't lend itself to creating synergy or unity behind one voice.

The story of USC Upstate moving forward must pay homage to our roots, but we must have a clearly defined visual identity. This basis for our visual Identity includes consistency in utilizing our primary and secondary marks, typography, and color usage.

This document provides guidance on how to effectively depict our brand across various touch points.

THE BRAND

The USC Upstate brand is more than a logo or a tagline. It is a promise. Our brand is a reflection of everything we do and say, in person, online, in print and in broadcast. The brand functions as a lens through which every marketing message, community activity and personal interaction is filtered. The brand embodies USC Upstate's mission, energy, character and values.

In today's competitive world of higher education, strength of perception has become as critical to success as quality faculty and broad course offerings. More than ever, the first factor in attracting potential students and donors is what they think about our institution — what they clearly see and hear from us that communicates our difference. In essence, it is what they believe our brand stands for, and our ability to deliver on that promise.

WHY CONSISTENT BRANDING MATTERS

Effective branding raises awareness and leaves a lasting impression. The brand platform establishes a foundation for the institution's identity, messaging and visual presentation and serves as a framework for all internal and external communications.

- Builds its reputation, both in South Carolina and beyond
- Leverage the University's history with its bright future
- Establish a brand that is transformational for both USC Upstate and the region

Each member of the USC Upstate community is responsible for creating the brand. Every time we contact potential donors, interact with prospective students and their parents, speak with alumni, communicate with the media, develop new collateral materials, approach community partners, or talk about USC Upstate, we influence the perception of the institution and our community.

Consistent color use is one of the key components of a solid brand. The USC Upstate color palette has a primary and secondary color palette. When working with our institutional colors, always use the color values as follows to ensure uniformity and consistency.

When creating your marketing materials, it is preferred that you begin with white, adding additional primary and secondary colors thoughtfully.

LOGOS

The official Athletics logos are the primary identifiers for the University of South Carolina Upstate. They serve as the most immediate and recognizable way for University audiences to know they are interacting with USC Upstate and assist with unifying our brand across the institution.

The visual identity of USC Upstate helps to create and sustain a strong image and reputation for the University. Using the correct version of these logos and institutional identifiers is imperative in maintaining brand integrity. The standards for each version ensure that the logos and identifiers are clearly visible and integrate with the design in which they are presented.

PRIMARY LOGO

The "U-Upstate" mark serves as the primary brand mark of the athletic department and should be the first mark of choice for all programs.

WORDMARK

The "Upstate" and "Spartans" interlocking wordmarks are also highly visible extensions of the department brand. Their longevity in use by the department give these marks high brand value. The "Upstate" should be given priority, but both can be used as stand-alone images for apparel, uniforms and printed materials where the primary mark is also depicted.










CLEARSPACE

All Athletic logos and official identifiers are to be surrounded by a clear area. This is the protected area around the logos. No other graphics or words are to overprint, touch or appear in this clear area. To ensure that clear space is maintained around the logo for legibility, text and graphics must follow the standard illustrated here. This should be thought of as the minimum clear space, and when possible, should be increased to give more prominence to the brand.



MINIMUM SIZE

The minimum size for all square logos is 1 inch wide, and all rectangular logos have a minimum size of 1.5 inches wide.





TERTIARY MARKS

These marks provide certain stylistic choices or are uniquely worded, and catered toward a certain sport or department within USC Upstate Athletics.

Since the University's name change in 2004 to USC Upstate, the athletic department has used variations of the same logo style. The "Upstate" and "Spartans" wordmarks are unchanged during this time. These multiple variations have been discontinued, but hold a great part of our athletics' history.







TYPOGRAPHY

Consistent use of typography is a simple way to unify the institution's visual identity. USC Upstate's primary typefaces were chosen for clarity and flexibility in a wide range of situations.

HEADERS, SUBHEADS, & BODY COPY – HELVETICA NEUE

Helvetica Neue is USC Upstate's primary headline and body copy typeface and should be used for large display text, theme and narrative copy. A timeless sans-serif typeface, its clean, modern lines and elegant curves look best at larger sizes in our identity system.

INFORMAL HEADERS AND SUBHEADS — FUTURA PT

Futura PT is a strong, modern, and simple sans-serif typeface with a variety of weights and widths. The typeface is professional yet informal and approachable. Futura PT is best suited for informal communication such as student recruitment, campus events, and other more casual marketing efforts.

EMAIL SIGNATURE

Remember to include your full name, title, department name, email address and office phone number in your signature; recipients may also expect to see your department web address and links to departmental social media accounts. You may also want to include a disclaimer or confidentiality statement at the bottom of your signature if it is appropriate for the type of work you do.

SIGNATURE TEMPLATE

Do not include philosophical statements or inspirational quotes; this is to avoid the potential confusion that such statements represent the university's slogan, ideology or brand promise. Do not embed additional images into your signature that are not part of the automatically-generated signatures.

LICENSING

The University of South Carolina Upstate works in partnership with Affinity Licensing to protect all logos and word marks while strengthening the University's brand identity. Affinity provides licensing representation for USC Upstate in an effort to regulate University and athletic logos. Any manufacturer of products bearing any USC Upstate mark, including items not for resale, must be properly licensed before offering such goods for sale. WHAT THIS MEANS FOR THE CAMPUS COMMUNITY

University departments and groups may order merchandise and apparel from companies that are licensed vendors only. Should you order merchandise bearing University logos using an unlicensed vendor, your merchandise could be confiscated and destroyed.

If the company that you wish to do business with is not a licensed vendor, they may apply for a license at Affinity Licensing.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR VENDORS

In order to produce merchandise and apparel bearing the USC Upstate logos, you must be a licensed vendor with Affinity. To apply for a license, visit www.affinitylicensing.com/ licensing. Vendors will have access to the USC Upstate licensed marks after they have completed the licensing registration process.

Internal Usage Licenses are for companies that desire to only produce licensed products for internal use at the selected institution. No products produced under this license agreement may be sold to the general public. Most departments on campus will work with this type of vendor to order T-shirts, tote bags, etc. that will be given away to students and not re-sold to the general public. The cost for this license is \$100.

Standard Licenses are for companies that desire to produce licensed products for resale to the general public. Companies that produce items to be sold in the Bookstore or for Athletics to sell on their website must register as Standard Vendors because we are reselling that merchandise. The cost for this license is \$100.

BUSINESS SYSTEM

As USC Upstate athletics solidifies its branding behind an updated system of marks, the suite of printed items that encompasses the department's business system also receives a fresh, clean, look. The business system includes business cards, letterhead, notecards and the associated envelopes. Many of these elements will be entered into circulation as the stock of previously printed business system designs from prior years are exhausted.
