**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve open up a six-game set with the Harrisburg Senators, Altoona is 10-8 against the Senators this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve hammered four home runs in a 6-1 getaway day victory. **Jared Triolo** led off the game with a solo shot for the second time in the series, **Blake Sabol**, **Andres Alvarez** and **Endy Rodriguez** each homered later in the game.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Altoona swatted a season-best 5 home runs in the Curve's 11-1 win over Binghamton on Wednesday, August 10. Overall Altoona homered 12 times in the 6-game series at Binghamton, the most by the team in a single series since the schedule format began in 2021. **Jared Triolo** hit a pair of lead-off homers becoming just the 9th player in franchise history to hit multiple lead-off homers. The Curve have now hit 5 lead-off home runs this season matching the franchise record set in 2014.

Altoona's 16 homers in August are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League behind Somerset (20).

**THE NEW GUYS RAKE:** Altoona's newest additions, Endy Rodriguez and Malcom Nuñez, each have made significant impacts since joining the Curve. Rodriguez has a hit in each of his first five games with the Curve including 1 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI and 2 BB while Nuñez has also picked up 5 hits and 1 HR with 3 RBI to lead Altoona to five wins last week in Binghamton.

**SHACK ATTACK:** **Aaron Shackelford** homered in four consecutive games for the Curve from August 7-12, all of which were two-run shots. Altoona's franchise record for consecutive games with a home run stands at 6 when **Brad Eldred** homered in each game from 4/26-5/2 in 2005. With his 22 homers on the season, Shackelford is the 10th player in franchise history to homer 20 times in a season, **Mason Martin** hit 22 homers in 2021 for the Curve. Martin was also the most recent Curve batter to homer in 4 straight games when he did so from 7/3-6 in 2021.

**IMMACULATE AGAIN:** Right-hander **Luis Ortiz** fired the fourth immaculate inning in franchise history on Tuesday, August 9 in Altoona's 6-0 win over Binghamton. Ortiz became the first pitcher in franchise history to throw two immaculate innings. With his 13 strikeouts across two starts at Binghamton, Ortiz now has 108 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since **Taylor Hearn** in 2018. Should he stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 6 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (**Ian Snell**, 2004: 142). He would need to average 6 strikeouts per start the rest of the way to lock down the mark.

**ENDY'S TIME:** Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB.com, **C Endy Rodriguez**. Named the South Atlantic League's Player of the Month in July after he batted .373/.489/.773 with 6 2B, 8 HR, and 21 RBI in 21 G, Rodriguez ranked highly in several categories in the South Atlantic League at the time of promotion: 7th in BA (.302), 8th in HR (16), 5th in OBP (.392), 2nd in SLG% (.544), 2nd in OPS (.936), 4th in H (96), T-2nd in 2B (23), T-2nd in XBH (42), 3rd in R (63). Rodriguez has picked up at least one hit in each of his first five games with the Curve, including a key insurance run single in the 9th inning on August 11.

**STOLEN HEARTS:** The Curve have stolen 139 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 40 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, **Jared Triolo** (22), **Liover Peguero** (21) and **Andres Alvarez** (20), with 20 stolen bases for the first time since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL:** Altoona pitchers have surrendered 115 home runs across 66 of their 108 games played this season. Altoona allowed a home run in a season-high 8 straight games from July 26 - August 3, falling shy of the franchise record of 11 (5/19-29, 2013).

**THE MEN FROM THE SENATE:** Managed by Tripp Kiester, Harrisburg recently received a some reinforcements via trades at the deadline with the additions of OF Trey Harris (Ehrie Adrianza/Atlanta) and OF Robert Hassell III (Juan Soto/San Diego). With other younger prospects like INF Darren Baker, OF Yasel Antuna and C Isreal Pineda; Harrisburg features a more balanced roster from the veteran-filled one that has played against Altoona 18 times already this year.

**THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER:** Luis Reyes takes the ball for his fourth start against Altoona this year, he struck out 7 in 6.2 IP on July 22 at FNB Field. Reyes is 1-2 with a 9.60 ERA (16 ER / 17.0 IP) against Altoona this year. Reyes also made 5 starts for Triple-A Rochester this year where he allowed 23 runs in 13.1 IP to begin the season. Reyes first made his way to Harrisburg in 2018, going 5-6 with a 5.18 ERA in 12 starts. He spent the 2019 season in Potomac going 5-5 with a 4.81 ERA in 31 games, seven starts, in which he struck out 78 batters in 76.2 innings pitched. Reyes signed as an 18-year-old for \$85,000 from the Dominican Republic.

**2022:** Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Threw 8.2 scoreless innings to start the season, holding opponents to a .077 batting average against before allowing 6 runs on 6 hits, including 2 HR (4 total) in the second inning of his third start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/29 at Akron pitching in front of dozens of family and friends. Canal Park is just 35 minutes from his native Massillon, OH... Threw 14.2 scoreless innings in road games to start the year... His 31 strikeouts in May were tied for 6th-most by an Eastern League Pitcher (Burrows also had 31 K's in May)... Placed on IL on 6/4 (shoulder) and activated on 6/25, was the first time in his life that he's missed a start due to injury... Placed on Temporary Inactive List on 7/1 to be the Best Man in his older brother's wedding, activated on 7/6... **2021:** Made his professional debut splitting the season between High-A Beloit and Double-A Pensacola in the Marlins system... Combined to go 6-4 with a 4.18 ERA in 21 appearances, 20 starts... His father played baseball at Youngstown State... Earned his degree from Ball State in Business Administration in three years... Signed with the Marlins for a bonus of \$1,129,700...
